# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Jiffy®

### Charming Chapeau

Pattern Number: 90669AD

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

**SIZE:** Varies

**Finished Circumference** About 20 in. (51 cm)

**Finished Height** About 9 (12, 14) in. (23 (30.5, 35.5) cm)

**Notes:** Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes. Pattern is written for shortest height with changes for longer heights in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all heights. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your height before beginning.

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Aug 27, 2012)

#### **LOWER BAND**

**Rnd 1:** Working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sc in any ch, sc in next ch, ch 4, sk next 4 ch, \*sc in next 2 ch, ch 4, sk next 4 ch; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnds 2 and 3:** Rep Rnds 3 and 4 of Hat.

**Rnd 4:** Rep Rnd 2 of Hat.

**Fasten off.**

#### **MATERIALS**

- 450-129 Lion Brand Jiffy Yarn: Citron  
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
MATERIALS OPTION  
LION BRAND JIFFY #171 Aqua or #196 Shocking Pink 1 ball

#### **GAUGE:**

2 1/2 pattern reps = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### **STITCH EXPLANATION:**

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

**sc4tog (sc 4 sts together)** Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. (Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop) 3 times. Yarn over, draw through all 5 loops on hook – 3 sts decreased.

## HAT

Ch 72. Taking care not to twist ch, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc in same st as join and each ch around; join with sl st in first sc – 72 sc at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in same st as join and in next sc, ch 4, sk next 4 sc, \*sc in next 2 sc, ch 4, sk next 4 sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc – 12 pattern reps at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** Turn, sl st in next ch-4 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-4 sp, sk next 2 sc, \*(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-4 sp, sk next 2 sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch.

**Rnd 4:** Turn, sl st in each st to next ch-2 sp, ch 1, \*2 sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 4, sk next 4 dc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rep Rnds 3 and 4 until piece measures 8 (11, 13) in. (20.5 (28, 33) cm) from beg.

**Note:** Take care when completing the next rnd. Sts are worked after the rnd is joined. This positions the work for the following rnd.

**Next Rnd:** Turn, sl st in next ch-4 sp, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-4 sp, sk next 2 sc, \*(2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in next ch-4 sp, sk next 2 sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in top of beg ch, sl st in next st, sl st in next ch-4 sp.

**Next Rnd:** Ch 1, turn, sc4tog over next 4 dc, sk next ch-2 sp, \*sc4tog over next 4 dc, sk next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first st – 12 sts at the end of this rnd.

**Last Rnd:** Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) around; join with sl st in first st – 6 sts at the end of this rnd.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through sts of last rnd and pull to gather. Knot securely.

## LOWER BAND

**Rnd 1:** Working across opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with sc in any ch, sc in next ch, ch 4, sk next 4 ch, \*sc in next 2 ch, ch 4, sk next 4 ch; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnds 2 and 3:** Rep Rnds 3 and 4 of Hat.

**Rnd 4:** Rep Rnd 2 of Hat.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
