SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: 3-6 mos, 12 mos, 18 mos, 24 months (2 yrs), Child 3 **Finished Chest** 22 (24, 26, 28, 30) in. (56 (61, 66, 71, 76) cm)

Finished Length 10 1/4 (10 3/4, 11 1/4, 11 3/4, 12 1/4) in. (26 (27.5, 28.5, 30, 31) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 823-174 <u>Lion Brand Baby Wool Yarn: Sprout</u> 3 4, 4, 5, 5 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 8 [5 mm]
- Lion Brand Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
 buttons, 1 in. (25 mm) diameter

GAUGE:

16 sts + 32 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.


STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st - 1 st increased.

 ${\bf sk2p}$ Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over - 2 sts decreased.

NOTES:

- 1. Cardigan body is knit sideways, from right sleeve to left sleeve.
- 2. The body is divided vertically to shape the neck and horizontally to create the front opening.
- 3. Side triangles are knit separately, then inset into each side of Cardigan.



CARDIGAN

Right Sleeve

Beginning at wrist edge, cast on 22 (26, 28, 28, 28) sts. Work in Garter st (k every row) for 4 (6, 8, 10, 12) rows. Next (Inc) Row: K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k last st - 24 (28, 30, 30, 30) sts at the end of this row.

Next 3 (5, 7, 9, 11) Rows: Knit.

Next Row: Rep Inc Row - 26 (30, 32, 32, 32) sts. Rep last 4 (6, 8, 10, 12) rows 8 (6, 5, 5, 5) more times - 42

sts when all incs have been completed. Note: Piece should measure about 5 (6, 7, 8 3/4, 10 1/2)

in. (12.5 (15, 18, 22, 26.5) cm) from beg.

Shape Body

Next Row: Knit.

Next (Inc) Row: K1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, kfb, k last st - 44 sts.

Rep last 2 rows 9 (10, 11, 12, 13) more times - 62 (64, 66, 68, 70) sts when all incs have been completed.

Divide for Neck

Next Row (RS): K31 (32, 33, 34, 35) for right front, place remaining 31 (32, 33, 34, 35) sts on a holder for back.

Right Front

Continue on 31 (32, 33, 34, 35) right front sts only.

Next (Inc) Row (WS): K to last 2 sts, kfb, k last st - 32 (33, 34, 35, 36) sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: Rep Inc Row - 33 (34, 35, 36, 37) sts. Rep last 2 rows 7 (8, 9, 10, 11) more times - 40 (42, 44, 46, 48) sts when all incs have been completed.

Buttonhole Row (RS): K to last 12 sts, (k2tog, yo, k4 for

buttonholes) twice.

Next Row: Rep Inc Row - 41 (43, 45, 47, 49) sts. Knit 4 rows. Bind off.

Left Front

Cast on 41 (43, 45, 47, 49) sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Next (Dec) Row (RS): K1, k2tog, k to end - 40 (42, 44, 46, 48) sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 9 (10, 11, 12, 13) more times - 31 (32, 33, 34, 35) sts when all decs have been completed. Place sts on a holder.

Back

Place 31 (32, 33, 34, 35) back sts from holder onto needle, ready to work a RS row.

Next Row (RS): Knit.

Next (Inc) Row: K1, kfb, k to end - 32 (33, 34, 35, 36) sts.

Rep last 2 rows 9 (10, 11, 12, 13) more times - 41 (43, 45, 47, 49) sts when all incs have been completed.

Knit 4 rows.

Next (Dec) Row (RS): K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k last st - 40 (42, 44, 46, 48) sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 9 (10, 11, 12, 13) more times - 31 (32, 33, 34, 35) sts when all decs have been completed.

Next (Joining) Row (RS): K across left front sts on holder, then k across back sts - 62 (64, 66, 68, 70) sts.

Next (Dec) Row: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k last st - 60 (62, 64, 66, 68) sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: Rep Dec Row - 58 (60, 62, 64, 66) sts. Rep last 2 rows 8 (9, 10, 11, 12) more times - 42 sts when all decs have been completed.

Left Sleeve

Next (Dec) Row: K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k last st - 40 sts.

Next 3 (5, 7, 9, 11) Rows: Knit. Next Row: Rep Dec Row - 38 sts.

Rep last 4 (6, 8, 10, 12) rows until 22 (26, 28, 28, 28) sts rem.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last row until left sleeve is same length as right sleeve. Bind off.

SIDE TRIANGLES (make 2)

Cast on 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) sts.

Row 1 (Dec Row): K1, k2tog, k to end - 36 (40, 44, 48, 52) sts.


Rep Row 1 until 5 sts rem.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: K1, sk2p, k1 - 3 sts.

Next Row: Knit. Next Row: Sk2p - 1 st.

Fasten off.



FINISHING

Sew Side Triangles to side edges of Fronts and Back. Sew sleeve seams. Sew buttons to Left Front opposite buttonholes. Weave in ends.
