Add sparkle to a classic oversized shrug. This is a super-soft update of the <u>Curtain Call</u> Shrug.

SIZE: Adult (Multiple Sizes)

XS/S (M/L)

About 36 (38) x 34 (44) in. (91.5 (96.5) x 86.5 (112) cm), before folding and seaming

About 36 (38) x 34 (44) in. (91.5 (96.5) x 86.5 (112) cm), before folding and seaming **Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

· LION BRAND® VANNA'S GLAMOUR™ (Art. #861) #170 Topaz 4 (6) balls or color of your choice

PATTERN STITCH

K1, p1 Rib (worked over an even number of sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * across.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

SHRUG

Cast on 216 (228) sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures 2 in. (5 cm) from beg.

Change to St st (k on RS, p on WS) and work until piece measures 24 in. (61 cm) 32 (42) in. (81.5 (106.5) cm) from beg.

Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures $\frac{26 \text{ in.}}{66 \text{ cm}}$ 34 (44) in. (86.5 (112) cm) from beg. Bind off.

FINISHING Fold piece in half, bringing cast-on and bound-off edges together, to measure $36 (38) \times 13 (22)$ in. (91.5 (96.5) $\times 33 (56)$ cm). Place markers on each of the 13 (22) in. (33 (56) cm) sides, 7 in. (18 cm) below fold for armholes. Seam each side from marker down to lower edge. Weave in ends.

MATERIALS

- 861-170 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour: Topaz</u> 4 6 Balls
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- · Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 5 (3.75 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

GAUGE:

24 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH


K1, p1 Rib (worked over an even number of sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * across. **Row 2:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

NOTES:

Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.



SHRUG

Cast on 216 (228) sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures 2 in. (5 cm) from beg.

Change to St st (k on RS, p on WS) and work until piece measures 32 (42) in. (81.5 (106.5) cm) from beg. Work in K1, p1 Rib until piece measures 34 (44) in. (86.5 (112) cm) from beg. Bind off.

FINISHING

Fold piece in half, bringing cast-on and bound-off edges together, to measure 36 (38) x 17 (22) in. (91.5 (96.5) x 43 (56) cm). Place markers on each of the 17 (22) in. (43 (56) cm) sides, 7 in. (18 cm) below fold for armholes. Seam each side from marker down to lower edge. Weave in ends.
