SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

SIZE: One Size

5½ in. x 8 in. [13 cm x 20 cm]

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jun 20, 2006)

Row numbering was incorrectly copied from the knit version, resulting in the wrong size for the item; pattern has been completely renumbered to obtain the correct size.

MATERIALS

- 760-153 Lion Brand Lion Cotton: Black
1 Skeins
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

5 sc = 2 inches; 8 rows = 3 inches with larger hook BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

OVEN MITT / GRILL MITT

With three strands A, Ch 10 sts, ch1 turn.

Rows 1-5 Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 6 Sc2tog sc 6 sc2 tog - 8 sts. ch1, turn.

Row 7 Sc2tog sc 4 sc2 tog - 6 sts. ch1, turn

Row 8-9 Using a single strand and smaller hook, Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 10 With three strands and larger hook, Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 11 2 Sc into first sc, sc into each sc across until 1 sc remains, 2 sc into last sc, ch1, turn – 8 st

Row 12 Sc into first sc, sc into each sc across until 1 sc remains, 2 sc into last sc, ch1, turn – 10 sts

Row 13-26 Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 27 Sc2tog sc 6 sc2 tog - 8 sts. ch1, turn.

Row 28 Sc2tog sc 4 sc2 tog - 6 sts. ch1, turn

Row 29-30 Using a single strand and smaller hook, Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 31 With three strands and larger hook, Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

Row 32 2 Sc into first sc, sc into each sc across until 1 sc remains, 2 sc into last sc, ch1, turn – 8 st

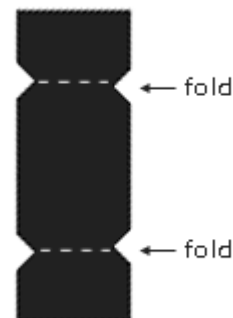
Row 33 Sc into first sc, sc into each sc across until 1 sc remains, 2 sc into last sc, ch1, turn – 10 sts

Row 34-38 Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Ch 1, turn.

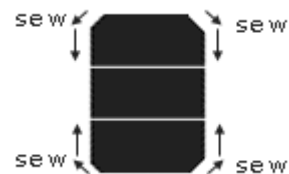
Row 39 Sc in second chain from hook and each ch across. Fasten Off

FINISHING

The rows that were crocheted with only one strand are where the mitt is folded. Laying it flat, fold the ends so that they are on top.



The folded ends will serve as pockets for the hand and thumb. Using a single strand of yarn and the large-eyed blunt needle and starting at the fold, sew each side together.
