SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

SIZE: One Size

Approximately 7 in x 10 in [18 cm x 25 cm]

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

- 760-098 Lion Brand Lion Cotton: Natural
2 Skeins
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 8 [5 mm]
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8 Optional -- for attaching sides together

GAUGE:

12 sts x 22 rows (11 ridges) = 4 in [10 cm] in garter stitch BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

MITT (make 4)

With three strands together, cast on 16 sts

Rows 1-12: K

Row 13: K1fb, knit to end of row - 17 sts

Row 14: K

Rows 15-20: rep rows 13-14 - 20 sts at row 20

Rows 21-56: K

Row 57-62: K2, P2 to end

Bind off all stitches, weave in ends

Finishing

Place two pieces together, aligning the edges. Attach them to each other either by sewing with a strand of the cotton, or by using a H8 hook, two strands of cotton and single crochet around the edge (shown).

The Manicure

- 1 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 large plastic bags
- 2 rubber bands of a size to fit comfortably around your wrist

Mix the salt and oil. Rub the mixture well into your hands as if washing them -- the salt is mildly abrasive and feels oh-so-good. Rinse your hands in cool water just enough to remove the salt, leaving the oil on your hands. Place a plastic bag over each hand and secure with a rubber band. Run tap water until it is hot and soak the mitts in the hot water until they are thoroughly wet. Remove the mitts from the water and squeeze to dry slightly. Pop your hands into the warm mitts and enjoy the wonderful feeling as the warmth spreads through your hands. When the mitts are cool, remove them and the plastic bags as well. You'll find that there is very little oil left on your hands -- gently remove any remaining with a soft cloth or tissue.
