SKILL LEVEL: [Beginner](#)

SIZE: Preemie, Preemie-to-Newborn, Newborn

Hat bottom circumference: 10½ (12, 13½) in [26.5 (30.5, 34) cm]

Hat height: 4 (5, 5½) in [10 (13, 14) cm]

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jan 7, 2013)

For full-term newborn:

Rnd 13: 1 single crochet in each of next 7 ~~8~~ single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 60 stitches.

MATERIALS

- 680-001 [Lion Brand Lion Organic Cotton Yarn: Vanilla](#)
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- Additional Materials
1/4 inch [.5 cm] ribbon for decoration
Sewing needle and thread

GAUGE:

18 sc and 16 rows = 4" (10 cm) on size I-9 (5.5 mm) hook

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

HAT

Chain 6 and close into a ring with 1 slip stitch in first chain. Place marker for beg of round.

Rnd 1: Chain 1, work 6 sc in ring, join with slip stitch to beginning chain.

Rnd 2: 2 single crochet in each single crochet around -12 stitches.

Rnd 3: 1 single crochet in next single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat to marker - 18 stitches.

Rnd 4: 1 single crochet in each of next 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat to marker - 24 stitches.

Rnd 5: 1 single crochet in each of next 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 30 stitches.

Rnd 6: 1 single crochet in each of next 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 36 stitches.

Rnd 7: 1 single crochet in each of next 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 42 stitches.

Rnd 8: 1 single crochet in each of next 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 48 stitches.

Small preemie:

Rnds 9-13: Work even in single crochet.

For large preemie:

Rnds 9-11: Work even in single crochet.

Rnd 12: 1 single crochet in each of next 7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 54 stitches.

Next 5 rnds: Work even in single crochet.

For full-term newborn:

Rnd 9: Work even in single crochet.

Rnd 10: 1 single crochet in each of next 7 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 54 stitches.

Rnds 11 and 12: Work even in single crochet.

Rnd 13: 1 single crochet in each of next 8 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; to marker - 60 stitches.

Next 6 rnds: Work even in single crochet.

For all sizes:

Next rnd: Sc in 2nd sc from hook, *ch 2, sk next sc, sc in next sc; rep from * to end. This is the eyelet row.

Next 2 rnds: Work even in single crochet.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Weave ribbon into the eyelet row (if this is an item to be donated, make sure to clear with the hospital that decoration is allowable). Tie into a bow. Secure with sewing needle and thread.
