

Free Crochet Pattern Lion Brand Lion Wool Scott The Bear

Pattern Number: justGifts



An homage to the cuddly teddies of our youth, Scott the Bear is a gift you can complete in a couple of hours. Worked entirely in single crochet, this pattern can be used as a launching point for making any creature your imagination can conjure. This pattern was designed by Kim Piper-Werker and is from the book, Lion Brand® Yarn Just Gifts.

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SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

SIZE: One Size About 4" tall [10 cm]

CORRECTIONS: None

MATERIALS

• 820-125 Lion Brand Lion Wool: Cocoa

1 Ball A

• 820-140 Lion Brand Lion Wool: Rose

1 Ball B

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size G-6
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

3/16" [5 mm] doll or bear eyes

1/4" [7 mm] bear nose (both available at craft stores in the doll-making department) Polyfill or other stuffing material

GAUGE:

About 24 single crochet = 4" [10 cm] BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES:

Rounds are not joined but are worked in a spiral. Place a marker in the first stitch of the second round to mark the beginning of the round. Remove the marker when working the first single crochet of each round, and replace it immediately into the stitch you just made.

Head

With A, chain 2.

Round 1 (RS) Work 6 single crochet into back loop only of second chain from hook, pull tail to tighten center of ring-6 single crochet.

Round 2 *2 single crochet in next single crochet, placing marker in first stitch of round; repeat from * around-12 single crochet.

Round 3 *Single crochet in next single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around-18 single crochet.

Round 4 *Single crochet in each of next 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around -24 single crochet.

Round 5 *Single crochet in each of next 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around -30 single crochet.

Round 6 *Single crochet in each of next 4 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around - 36 single crochet.

Round 7 *Single crochet in each of next 5 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around -42 single crochet.

Round 8 *Single crochet in each of next 6 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around -48 single crochet.

Rounds 9-10 Single crochet in each single crochet around-48 single crochet.

Round 11 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in each of next 6 single crochet; repeat from * around-42 single crochet.

Round 12 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in each of next 5 single crochet; repeat from * around-36 single crochet.

Round 13 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in each of next 4 single crochet; repeat from * around-30 single crochet.

Round 14 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in each of next 3 single crochet; repeat from * around-24 single crochet.

Round 15 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in each of next 2 single crochet; repeat from * around-18 single crochet.

Round 16 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around-12 single crochet.

Slip stitch in next single crochet. Fasten off, leaving a 10" [25 cm] tail.

Body

With A, chain 2.

Round 1 (RS) Work 6 single crochet in back loop only of second chain from hook, pull tail to tighten center of ring-6 single crochet.

Round 2 *2 single crochet in next single crochet, placing marker in first stitch of round; repeat from * around-12 single crochet.

Round 3 *Single crochet in next single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around-18 single crochet.

Round 4 *Single crochet in each of next 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around -24 single crochet.

Round 5 *Single crochet in each of next 3 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around -30 single crochet.

Rounds 6-7 Single crochet in each single crochet around-30 single crochet. Round 8 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in each of next 3 single crochet; repeat from * around-24 single crochet.

Rounds 9-10 Single crochet in each single crochet around-24 single crochet.

Round 11 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in each of next 2 single crochet; repeat from * around-18 single crochet.

Round 12 Single crochet in each single crochet around-18 single crochet.

Round 13 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around-12 single crochet.

Round 14 Single crochet in each single crochet around-12 single crochet. Slip stitch in next single crochet. Fasten off.

Ears-make 2

With B, chain 2.

Row 1 Work 3 single crochet in back loop only of second chain from hook. Turn-3 single crochet.

Row 2 Chain 1, work 2 single crochet in each single crochet across, changing to A with last stitch. Turn-6 single crochet.

Row 3 Chain 1, single crochet in first single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet, *single crochet in next single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * across- 9 single crochet. Fasten off, leaving an 8" [20.5 cm] tail.

Snout

With A, chain 2.

Round 1 (RS) Work 6 single crochet in back loop only of second chain from hook, pull tail to tighten center of ring-6 single crochet.

Round 2 *2 single crochet in next single crochet, placing marker in first stitch of round; repeat from * around-12 single crochet.

Round 3 *Single crochet in each of next 2 single crochet, 2 single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around -16 single crochet.

Round 4 Single crochet in each single crochet around-16 single crochet.

Slip stitch in next single crochet. Fasten off, leaving an 8" [20.5 cm] tail.

Legs-make 2

With B, chain 2.

Round 1 (RS) Work 6 single crochet in back loop only of second chain from hook, pull tail to tighten center of ring-6 single crochet.

Round 2 *2 single crochet in next single crochet, placing marker in first stitch of round; repeat from * around-12 single crochet.

Round 3 Single crochet in each single crochet around, changing to A in last single crochet-12 single crochet.

Rounds 4-5 Single crochet in each single crochet around-12 single crochet.

Round 6 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around-8 single crochet.

Rounds 7-8 Single crochet in each single crochet around-8 single crochet.

Slip stitch in next single crochet. Fasten off, leaving a 10" [25 cm] tail.

Arms-make 2

With B, chain 2.

Round 1 (RS) Work 6 single crochet in back loop only of second chain from hook, pull tail to tighten center of ring-6 single crochet.

Round 2 *2 single crochet in next single crochet, placing marker in first stitch of round; repeat from * around, changing to A with last stitch-12 single crochet.

Round 3 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet; repeat from * around-6 single crochet.

Rounds 4-6 Single crochet in each single crochet around-6 single crochet.

Slip stitch in next single crochet. Fasten off, leaving a 10" [25 cm] tail.

Tail

With A, chain 2.

Round 1 Work 6 single crochet in back loop only of second chain from hook, pull tail to tighten center of ring-6 single crochet.

Round 2 *2 single crochet in next single crochet, placing marker in first stitch of round; repeat from * around-12 single crochet.

Round 3 Single crochet in each single crochet around-12 single crochet.

Round 4 *Single crochet 2 together over next 2 single crochet, single crochet in next single crochet; repeat from * around-8 single crochet.

Slip stitch in next single crochet. Fasten off, leaving a 10" [25 cm] tail.

Finishina

Stuff the head, body, legs, arms, snout, and tail with polyfill. Lining up the slip stitches of each piece, whipstitch the head and body together using the long tail from the head, keeping the stitches matched up. Position the legs and arms as desired, and sew them to the body using the long tail of each leg. Sew on the tail so that it helps to prop the bear up in a stable sitting position. Position the snout so that the top is about halfway up the head and shape it so that it's wider across than it is tall, and sew it to the head using the yarn tail. Sew one eye on either side of the snout. Sew the nose onto the snout.
