**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** Varies

**SIZES** 0-6 months (12-18 months, 2-3 years, 4 years)

**Finished Chest** 20 (21, 23, 25) in. (51 (53.5, 58.5, 63.5) cm)

**Finished Length** 9 1/2 (10, 11, 12 1/2) in. (24 (25.5, 28, 32) cm)

### MATERIALS

- 925-103 Lion Brand Baby's First Yarn: Fairy Tale  
3 (3, 4, 4) Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
1 button, 3/4 in. (20 mm) diameter

### GAUGE:

9 sts = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

### BACK

Ch 23 (25, 27, 29).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – 22 (24, 26, 28) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

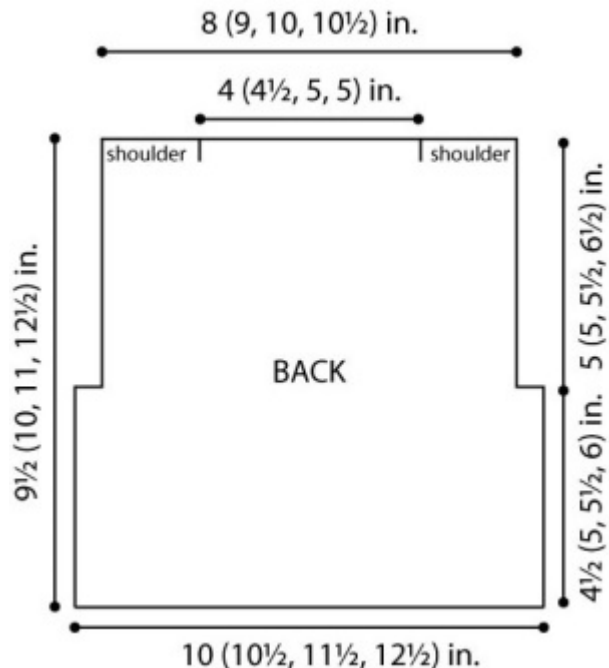
Rep last row until piece measures 4 1/2 (5, 5 1/2, 6) in. (11.5 (12.5, 14, 15) cm) from beg.

### Shape Armhole

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 2 (2, 2, 2) sts, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* to last 2 (2, 2, 2) sts; leave rem sts unworked – 18 (20, 22, 24) sts at the end of this row.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

Rep last row until piece measures 9 1/2 (10, 11, 12 1/2) in. (24 (25.5, 28, 32) cm) from beg. Fasten off.



### LEFT FRONT

Ch 15 (17, 19, 21).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – 14 (16, 18, 20) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

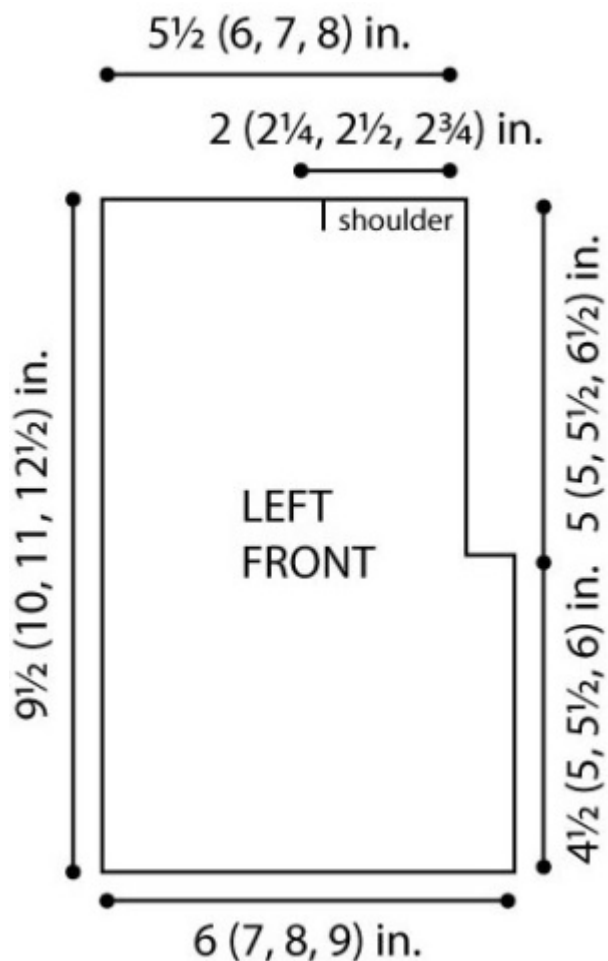
Rep Row 2 until piece measures 4 1/2 (5, 5 1/2, 6) in. (11.5 (12.5, 14, 15) cm) from beg.

### Shape Armhole

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 2 (2, 2, 2) sts, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across – 12 (14, 16, 18) sts at the end of this row.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

Rep last row until piece measures 9 1/2 (10, 11, 12 1/2) in. (24 (25.5, 28, 32) cm) from beg. Fasten off.



### RIGHT FRONT

Ch 11 (11, 13, 13).

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – 10 (10, 12, 12) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

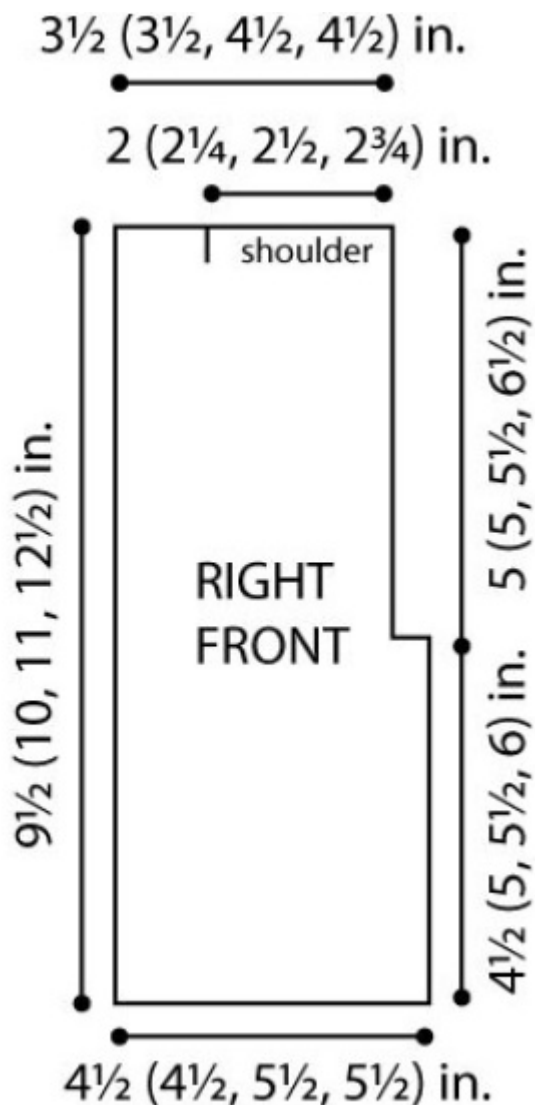
Rep Row 2 until piece measures 4 1/2 (5, 5 1/2, 6) in. (11.5 (12.5, 14, 15) cm) from beg.

### Shape Armhole

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* to last 2 (2, 2, 2) sts; leave rem sts unworked – 8 (8, 10, 10) sts at the end of this row.

**Next Row:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

Rep last row until piece measures 9 1/2 (10, 11, 12 1/2) in. (24 (25.5, 28, 32) cm) from beg. Fasten off.



### SLEEVE (make 2)

Ch 23 (23, 27, 29)

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, \*sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from \* across – 22 (22, 26, 28) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, \*sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from \* across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 7 1/2 (8, 9, 9 1/2) in. (19 (20.5, 23, 24) cm) from beg. Fasten off.

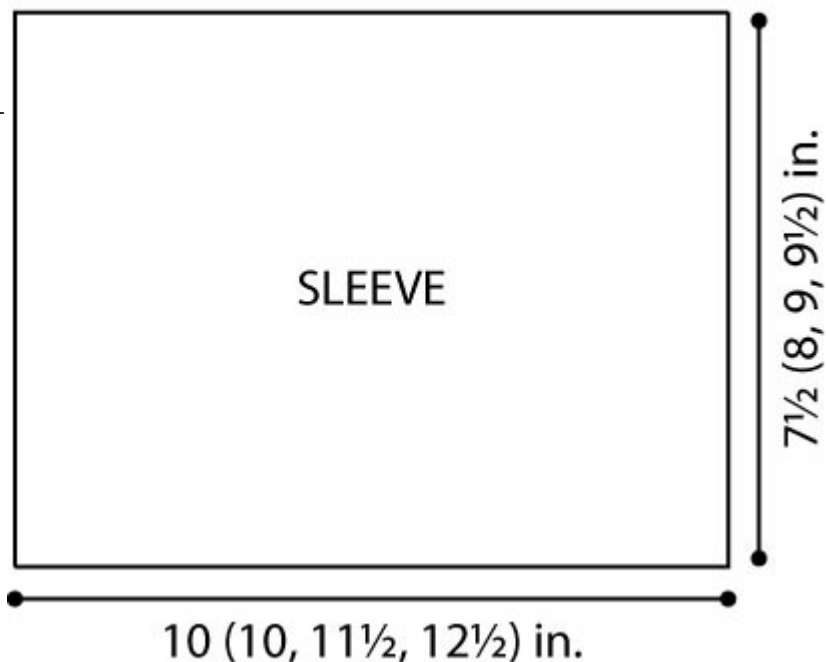
### FINISHING

Seam shoulders for 2 (2 1/4, 2 1/2, 2 3/4) in. (5 (5.5, 6.5, 7) cm); leaving 4 (4 1/2, 5, 5) in. (10 (11.5, 12.5, 12.5) cm) open for Back neck. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams. Fold about 3/4 in. (2 cm) at end of Sleeves for cuff; sew in place.

### Edging

From right side, join yarn with sl st in lower corner front corner.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced up front edge to neck, around neck, and down other front edge. Fasten off. Sew button about 5 in. (12.5 cm) below neck edge. Use space between sts as buttonhole. Weave in ends.
