## Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand Cotton-Ease 4th Of July Garland

Pattern Number: L0150AD

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size

Garland: About 72 in. (183 cm) long Flags: About 5 1/2 x 6 1/2 in. (14 x 16.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- 830-099 Lion Brand Cotton-Ease: Almond
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 830-148 Lion Brand Cotton-Ease: Turquoise
  - 2 Balls (B)
- · 830-113 Lion Brand Cotton-Ease: Cherry
  - 1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size G-6
- · Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### GAUGE:

14 1/2 sc + 15 rows = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

You can easily customize the size of your Garland. Simply make more or fewer Flags and a shorter or longer Chain as desired. If you opt to make more Flags and a longer Chain, you may require additional yarn.

#### FLAG (make 9 - 3 each with A, B, and C)

Row 1: Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook - 2 sc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in each st across - 4 sc at the end of this row.

Rows 3 and 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 5: Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st across to last st, 2 sc in last st - 6 sc at the end of this row.

Rows 6-23: Repeat Rows 3-5 six times - 18 sc at the end of Row 23.

Round 24: Do not turn, work sc evenly spaced around entire outside edge of Flag; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

### Chain

With A, make a ch that measures about 72 in. (183 cm) long.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. Fasten off.

Sew Flags to Chain in following color sequence: B, C, A, B, C, A, B, C, A.

Weave in ends
