**SKILL LEVEL:** Advanced Intermediate

**SIZE:** One Size

About 50 in. (127 cm) at widest point

**MATERIALS**

- 860-099 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Linen  
3 Balls (A)
- 861-149 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Moonstone  
3 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**GAUGE:**

12 sts + 5 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern with one strand each of A and B held tog. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

**NOTES:**

1. Shawl begins at center back neck and is worked in rows down to lower edge.
2. Shawl is worked with 1 strand each of A and B held tog throughout the pattern.
3. A marker is placed in the center dc of the Shawl. Sts are worked in same way on both sides of center marker. Move the marker up as each row is completed.





## SHAWLETTE

With 1 strand of A and 1 strand B held tog, ch 7.

**Row 1 (WS):** (Dc, ch 3, dc) in 7th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc, ch 3).

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), turn, 7 dc in first ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, 7 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beginning ch.

**Row 3:** Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3 here and throughout), turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in top of turning ch.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, turn, 7 dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc (middle dc of 3-dc group), ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 7 dc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, 7 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc (middle dc of 3-dc group), ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 7 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 5:** Ch 6, turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc, place marker in dc just made for center dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in top of turning ch.

Move center marker up as work progresses.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, turn, 7 dc in first ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, 7 dc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to center (marked) dc, dc in center dc, \*\*7 dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp; rep from \*\* to turning ch-sp, 7 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 7:** Ch 6, turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, \*sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc; rep from \* to center dc, (dc, ch 3, dc, ch 3, dc) in center dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, \*\*sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc; rep from \*\* to turning ch, (dc, ch 3, dc) in top of turning ch.

**Row 8:** Rep Row 6.

**Rows 9-28:** Rep last 2 rows 10 more times. Do not fasten off.

## Trim

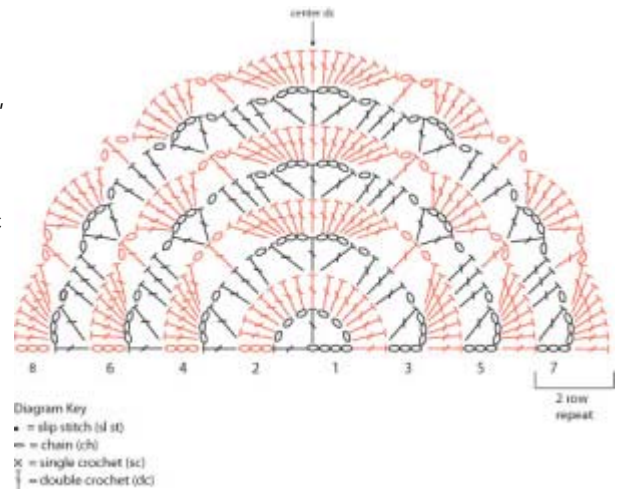
**Row 29:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 1, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc, \*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc; rep from \* to center dc, ch 1, sc in center dc, ch 1, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc, \*\*ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, (dc, in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) 3 times, dc in next dc; rep from \*\* to turning ch, ch 1, sc in top of turning ch.

**Round 30:** Turn, sl st in first sc, sc in each st to next sc, \*sl st in next sc, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp to next sc; rep from \* to center sc, sc in center sc, \*\*sc in each dc and ch-1 sp to next sc, sl st in next sc; rep from \*\* across; do not turn, work sc evenly spaced across top edge of Shawl; join with sl st in first sl st.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
