SIZE:

 $\frac{32}{35}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ x 40 in. ($\frac{81.5}{90}$ x 101.5 cm)

MATERIALS

 920-156 <u>Lion Brand Babysoft</u> <u>Yarn: Pastel Green</u>

4 Balls

- Lion Brand Size 11 [8 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

*Babysoft® (Article #920). 60% Acrylic, 40% Polyamid; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz/141g; 459 yd/420m balls,

Prints: 4 oz/113g; 367 yd/336m balls.



GAUGE:

13 1/2 sts + 18 1/2 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in checkers pattern, with 2 strands of yarn held together. EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL TO THIS PROJECT.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

- 1. Blanket is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together throughout.
- 2. Circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.

BLANKET

With 2 strands held tog, cast on 134 sts.

Rows 1-16: Knit.

Row 17: Knit 12, *purl 10, knit 10; repeat from * 4 more times, purl 10, knit 12.

Row 18: Knit 12, *knit 10, purl 10; repeat from * 4 more times, knit 22.

Rows 19-28: Repeat Rows 17-18.

Row 29: Knit 12, *knit 10, purl 10; repeat from * 4 more times, knit 22.

Row 30: Knit 12, *purl 10, knit 10; repeat from * 4 more times, purl 10, knit 12.

Rows 31-40: Repeat Rows 29 and 30.

Rows 41-148: Repeat Rows 17-40 four more times, then repeat Rows 17-28 once more.

Rows 149-164: Knit.

Bind off all sts.
