SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X
Finished Bust $34(38,42,46,50)$ in. ( 86.5 ( $96.5,106.5,117,127$ ) cm)
Finished Length $22(221 / 2,23,231 / 2,24) \mathrm{in} .(56(57,58.5,59.5,61) \mathrm{cm})$

## MATERIALS

- 484-133 Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Mohair: Sunset

3 3, 3, 3, 4 Balls

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

Knitting needles size 3 ( 3.25 mm )
Circular knitting needle size $2(2.75 \mathrm{~mm}), 24 \mathrm{in}$. ( 60 cm ) long

## GAUGE:

24 sts +36 rows $=4 \mathrm{in}$. ( 10 cm ) in St st ( $k$ on RS, p on WS). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in . [ 10 cm ] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## STITCH EXPLANATION:


#### Abstract

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting horizontal thread lying between needles and placing it onto left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop - 1 st increased. Sp2p (Slip-p2tog-pass slipped st over) A double decrease worked on WS as follows: 1. Insert right needle as if to knit, and slip the next st from the left needle to the right needle. 2. Purl the next 2 sts together. 3. With tip of left needle, lift the slipped st (the 2 nd st on right needle) up and over the p2tog (first st on right needle) and off the needle - you have decreased 2 sts. ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog - 1 st decreased. ssp (slip, slip, purl) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; pass them back to left needle; purl them together through back loops - 1 st decreased.


PATTERN STITCHES
Daisy Eyelet Pattern (multiple of 7 sts)
Row 1 (RS): K1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k1.
Row 2: Ssp, yo, p3, yo, p2tog.
Row 3: K1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1.
Row 4: P2, yo, sp2p, yo, p2.
Rep Rows 1-4 for Daisy Eyelet Pattern.

## BACK

Cast on $102(114,126,138,150)$ sts.
Work in Garter st (k every row) for 4 rows.
Continue in St st ( $k$ on RS, $p$ on WS) until piece measures 1 in . (2.5
cm) from beg, end with a WS row. Note: End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row, and the next row that you are ready to work will be a RS row.

## Shape Sides

Next (Decrease) Row: K2, ssk, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2-100 (112,
$124,136,148$ ) sts at the end of this row.
Work even (without increasing or decreasing) in St st for 7 rows. Rep Decrease Row - $98(110,122,134,146)$ sts at the end of this row.
Rep last 8 rows 4 more times - $90(102,114,126,138)$ sts when all decreases have been completed.
Work even in St st until piece measures 7 in . ( 18 cm ) from beg, end with a WS row.
Next (I ncrease) Row: K2, M1, k to last 2 sts, M1, k2-92 (104, 116, $128,140)$ sts at the end of this row.
Work even in St st for 9 rows.
Rep Increase Row - $94(106,118,130,142)$ sts at the end of this row. Rep last 10 rows 4 more times - $102(114,126,138,150)$ sts when all increases have been completed.
Work even in St st until piece measures 14 in . ( 35.5 cm ) from beg, end with a WS row.

## Shape Armholes

Bind off $5(6,7,10,11)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows - $92(102,112,118$, 128) sts.

## Shape Raglans

Next (Decrease) Row (RS): K1, beg with Row 1 work Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, ssk, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, work Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1 - $90(100,110,116,126)$ sts at the end of this row.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next (Decrease) Row: K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, ssk, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1-88(98, 108, 114, 124) sts at the end of this row.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next Row: K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $k$ to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Rep last 6 rows $10(11,12,12,13)$ more times - $48(54,60,66,72)$ sts when all decreases are completed.

## Sizes 1X (2X) ONLY

Next (Decrease) Row: K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, ssk, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $p$ to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Rep last 2 rows once more - 62 (68) sts when all decreases are completed.

## ALL SIZES

Work even in pattern as established until armhole measures 8 ( $81 / 2$, $9,91 / 2,10) \mathrm{in}$. $(20.5(21.5,23,24,25.5) \mathrm{cm})$, end with a WS row. Bind off.

## FRONT

Work Front same as Back until piece measures 14 in . ( 35.5 cm ) from

beg (to armhole shaping), end with a WS row - 102 (114, 126, 138,
150) sts.

## Shape Armholes

Bind off $5(6,7,10,11)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows - $92(102,112,118$ 128) sts.

Place a marker at center of row - $46(51,56,59,64)$ sts on each side of the center marker.

## Shape Raglans and Neck

Next (Decrease) Row (RS): K1, beg with Row 1 work Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, ssk, k to 1 st before center marker, join a 2nd ball of yarn, bind off 2 sts, $k$ to last 10 sts, k2tog, work Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1-44 $(49,54,57,62)$ sts each side.
Work both sides at once with separate balls of yarn.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p to end of first side; on 2 nd side, p to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next (Decrease) Row (RS): K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, ssk, $k$ to last 3 sts of first side, $k 2 t o g, k 1$; on 2nd side, k1, ssk, $k$ to last 10 sts, k2tog, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1-42 (47, 52, 55, 60) sts rem each side.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $p$ to end of first side; on 2 nd side, p to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next (Decrease) Row: K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $k$ to last 3 sts of first side, k2tog, $k 1$; on 2 nd side, k1, ssk, k to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1 - $41(46,51,54,59)$ sts rem each side.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $p$ to end of first side; on 2 nd side, $p$ to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next (Decrease) Row: K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, ssk, $k$ to last 3 sts of first side, k2tog, k1; on 2 nd side, k1, ssk, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1 - $39(44,49,52,57)$ sts rem each side. Rep last 6 rows $6(7,8,8,9)$ more times - $9(9,9,12,12)$ sts rem each side.

## Sizes 1X (2X) ONLY

Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $p$ to end of first side; on 2 nd side, $p$ to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next (Decrease) Row (RS): K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, ssk, $k$ to last 3 sts of first side, $k 2$ tog, $k 1$; on 2nd side, k1, ssk, k to last 10 sts, k2tog, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1-10(10) sts rem each side.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $p$ to end of first side; on 2 nd side, $p$ to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next (Decrease) Row: K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, $k$ to last 3 sts of first side, $k 2$ tog, $k 1$; on 2 nd side, $k 1$, ssk, k to last 8 sts, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1 - 9 sts rem each side

ALL SIZES
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1; on 2nd side, p1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Next Row: K1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1; on 2nd side, k1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, k1.
Next Row: P1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1; on 2nd side, p1, work next row of Daisy Eyelet Pattern over next 7 sts, p1.
Bind off rem 9 sts on each side.


## LEFT SLEEVE

Cast on 66 (72, 78, 84, 90) sts.
Work in Garter st for 4 rows.
Continue in St st until piece measures 1 in . 2.5 cm ) from, end with a WS row.
Bind off $5(6,7,10,11)$ sts at beg of next 2 rows $-56(60,64,64,68)$
sts when all bind offs are completed.

## Shape Raglan

Next (Decrease) Row (RS): K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 54
$(58,62,62,66)$ sts at the end of this row.
Next Row: Purl.
Rep Decrease Row - $52(56,60,60,64)$ sts at the end of this row.
Work even in St st for 3 rows.
Rep last 6 rows $6(7,8,8,9)$ more times - 28 sts when all decreases are completed.
Next (Decrease) Row (RS): K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 26
sts at the end of this row.
Next Row: Purl.
Next (Decrease) Row (RS): K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 -
24 sts at the end of this row.
Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 4 WS rows - 12 sts when all bind offs have
been completed.
Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 6 WS rows.


## RIGHT SLEEVE

Work Right Sleeve same as Left Sleeve until 24 sts rem, end with a WS row.
Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 4 RS rows.
Bind off 2 sts at beg of next 6 RS rows.

## FINISHING

Sew raglan seams. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

## Neckband

From RS with circular needle, beg at back edge of Left Sleeve, pick up and k65 (67, 69, 71, 73) sts along top of Sleeve and left front neck edge, 2 sts in bound-off sts at center front neck, k65 ( $67,69,71,73$ ) sts along right front neck edge and top of Right Sleeve, and $k 38(42,46,50,52)$ sts across back neck $-170(178,186,194,200)$ sts at the end of this rnd. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.
Next Rnd: Purl.
Next Rnd: Knit.
Next Rnd: Purl.
Bind off loosely as if to knit.
Weave in ends.
