• 860-151 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Charcoal Grey 1 Ball (B)

• 861-146 Lion Brand Jewel 1 Ball (C)

#### GAUGE:

19 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern with one strand of A or B, OR 2 strands of C or D.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will

be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### PATTERN STITCHES Woven Stitch (multiple of 2 sts) Notes:

With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row.
With yarn in back (wyib) refers to the side of the work that is away from you as you work the row.

3. To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn between needles. Take care not to wrap yarn over a needle, this could create an additional st.

4. All sl sts should be slipped as if to purl.

Row 1 (RS): \*K1, sl 1 wyif; rep from \* across.

**Row 2:** \*P1, sl 1 wyib; rep from \* across.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Woven st pattern.

# Seed St (over an even number of sts)

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* across the row. **Row 2:** P the knit sts and k the purl sts. Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

# NOTES:

1. Yarns C and D are each worked with 2 strands held tog. Wind C and D each into 2 separate balls before beginning.

2. Stitch markers are used to separate the border sts at both ends of each row from the Woven pattern sts.

# SCARF

With 1 strand of A, cast on 28 sts.

Work in Seed st for 1 row.

Change to 2 strands of C held tog, and work in Seed st as established for 1 row.

**Next Row:** With 2 strands of C held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, place marker (pm), work in Seed st to last 3 sts, pm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Note:** Markers have been placed to define the side borders (3 sts at beginning and 3 sts at end of each row) of Scarf. On following rows, slip markers as you come to them.

# Section 1

**Row 1:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 2:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 3:** With 1 strand each of C and D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 4:** With 1 strand each of C and D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts. Rep Rows 1-4 until section 1 measures about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4.

# Section 2

**Row 1:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm, work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 2:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 3:** With 2 strands of C held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 4:** With 2 strands of C held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

Rep Rows 1-4 until section 2 measures about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4.

# Section 3

**Row 1:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm, work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 2:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 3:** With 2 strands of D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 4:** With 2 strands of D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

Rep Rows 1-4 until section 3 measures about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4.

#### Section 4

**Row 1:** With 1 strand of B, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm, work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 2:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 3:** With 2 strands of D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 4:** With 2 strands of D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

Rep Rows 1-4 until section 4 measures about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4.

# Section 5

**Row 1:** With 1 strand of B, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm, work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 2:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 3:** With 1 strand each of C and D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 4:** With 1 strand each of C and D held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts. Rep Rows 1-4 until section 5 measures about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4.

# Section 6

**Row 1:** With 1 strand of B, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm, work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 2:** With 1 strand of A, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 3:** With 2 strands of C held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, slip marker (sm), work Row 1 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

**Row 4:** With 2 strands of C held tog, work in Seed st as established over 3 sts, sm work Row 2 of Woven st pattern across to last 3 sts, sm, work in Seed st as established over last 3 sts.

Rep Rows 1-4 until section 4 measures about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a Row 4.

# Sections 7-12

Rep Sections 1-6.

On last row of Section 12, remove markers as you work across the row.

Change to 1 strand of A and work in Seed st for 2 rows.

Change to 2 strands of C and work in Seed st for 1 row. Bind off.

# FINISHING

Weave in ends.
