MATERIALS

- 860-125 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Taupe

- 860-144 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Magenta

- 860-171 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Fern
1 Ball (C)
- 860-158 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Mustard
1 Ball (D)
- 860-172 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Kelly Green
1 Ball (E)
- 860-126 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Chocolate
1 Ball (F)
- 860-145 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Eggplant
1 Ball (G)
- 860-173 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Dusty Green
1 Ball (H)

- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

12 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) over hdc worked in back loops only (Block 6).

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

dc3tog (dc 3 sts together) Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. (Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - 2 sts decreased.

FPTR (front post treble crochet) Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st 2 Rows below, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops

on hook) 3 times. Skip st behind the FPTR.

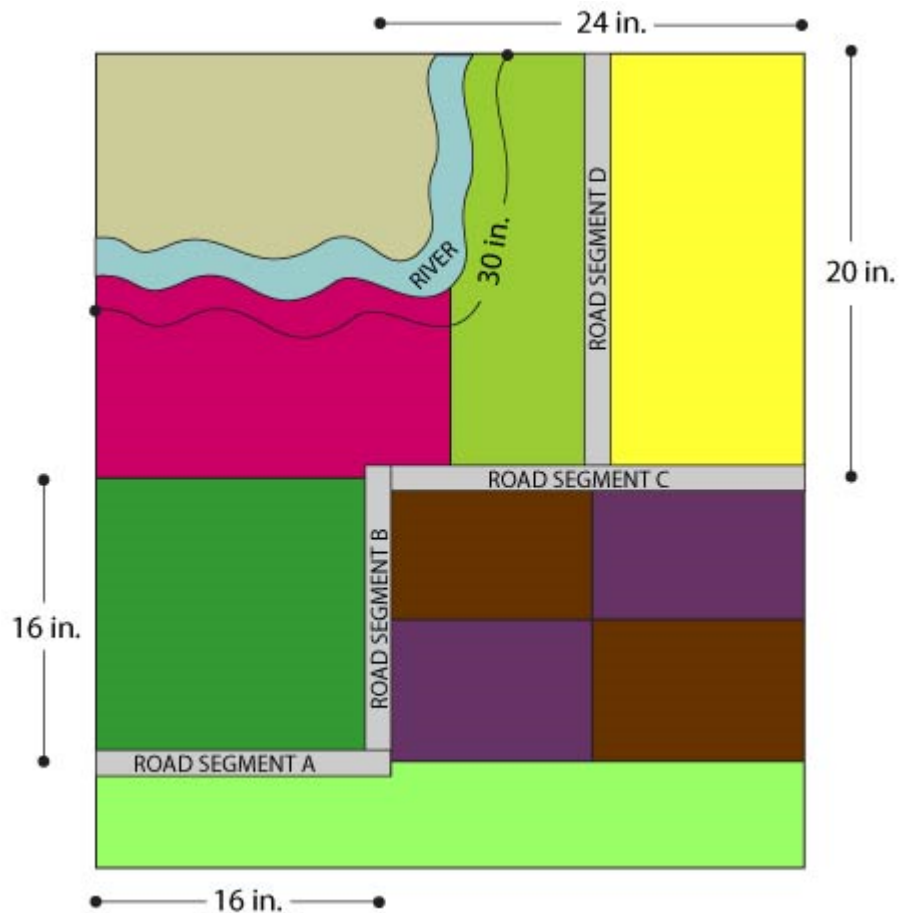
Loop st (worked on RS, all in one st) Insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop; form a loop in front of work as follows: Bring working yarn to the front; hold working yarn with finger or thumb of hand holding the hook. Leaving a loop of yarn in the front, bring working yarn to back of work. Insert hook in same st and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook). Yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook to complete the st and lock the loop in place.

Puff st (worked on WS, all in one st) (Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop) into same st 5 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Individual Blocks are crocheted, then sewn together following the Assembly Diagram.
2. Any small differences in sizes of Blocks can be eased in when sewing Blocks together.



BLOCK 1

With A, ch 57.

Row 1 (RS): Work 2 dc in 3rd ch from hook, sk next 2 ch, *(sc, 2 dc) in next ch, sk next 2 ch; rep from * across, sc in last ch - 54 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, 2 dc in first st, sk next 2 sts, *(sc, 2 dc) in next st, sk next 2 sts; rep from * across, sc in top of turning ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 2

With B, ch 57.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 56 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, tr in next st, *sc in next 3 sts, tr in next st; rep from * across to last st, sc in last st.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 4 sts, tr in next st, *sc in next 3 sts, tr in next st; rep from * across to last 3 sts, sc in last 3 sts.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Rep Rows 2-5 until piece measures 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 3

With C, ch 61.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 60 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, work a Loop St in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 4

Notes:

1. Sc2tog over next 2 sts means that you should draw up a loop in each of the indicated sts or ch-sps, then yarn over and draw through all loops on the hook to complete the sc2tog.

2. Sc2tog decreases are offset by matching ch-1 increases, so total number of sts will not change.

With D, ch 66.

Row 1: Work sc2tog over 2nd ch from hook and next ch, *ch 1, sc2tog over next 2 ch; rep from * across to last ch, ch 1, sc in last ch - 65 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog over first sc and ch-1 sp, *ch 1, sc2tog over next sc and ch-1 sp; rep from * across to last sc, ch 1, sc in last sc.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 12 in. (30.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 5

With E, ch 41.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc), dc in each ch across - 39 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 2 sts, *FPTR around next st 2 rows below, dc in next 3 sts; rep from * across.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, dc in next st, *dc in next 3 sts, FPTR around next st 2 rows below; rep from * across to last st, dc in last st.

Rep Rows 2-5 until piece measures 16 in. (40.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 6 (make 2)

With F, ch 37.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch counts as hdc) and in each ch across - 36 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each hdc across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 7 (make 2)

With G, ch 37.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc) and in each ch across - 35 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 2 sts, Puff st in next st, *sc in next 5 sts, Puff st in next st; rep from * across to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts - 6 Puff sts at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each st across.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in first 5 sts, *Puff st in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * across.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Rep Rows 2-5 until piece measures 8 in. (20.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BLOCK 8

With H, ch 109.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, *sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across - 108 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, *sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from * across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 6 in. (15 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

RIVER

Note: River is worked in a modified ripple st to create an organic shape.

With I, ch 9.

Row 1: Work dc2tog over 4th and 5th ch from hook (beg ch counts as dc), 3 dc in next ch, dc3tog over last 3 chs - 6 dc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc2tog over first 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc3tog (working over last 2 dc and beg ch).

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, working in back loops only, dc2tog over first 2 dc, 3 dc in next dc, dc3tog (working over last 2 dc and turning ch).

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures 30 in. (76 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

ROAD

Note: Road is crocheted in segments, then sewn to Throw.

Segment A

With J, ch 6.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch counts as hdc) and in each ch across - 5 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures 16 in. (40.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

Segment B

Work as for Segment A.

Segment C

Work as for Segment A until piece measures 24 in. (61 cm).

Fasten off.

Segment D

Work as for Segment A until piece measures 20 in. (51 cm).

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following Assembly Diagram, sew Blocks together. Following Assembly Diagram for placement, sew Road Segments and River to Throw, curving River as you sew. Weave in ends.
