MATERIALS

- 860-144 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Magenta
 - 2 Balls (A)
- 860-158 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Mustard
 - 3 Balls (B)
- 860-107 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Sapphire
 - 3 Balls (C)
- 860-134 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Terracotta
 - 2 Balls (D)
- 860-171 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Fern
 - 2 Balls (E)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size J-10
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

1 Square = about 9 x 9 in. (23 x 23 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Note: Clusters and dc4tog are worked similarly, but take note that a cluster is worked into a single st, a dc4tog is worked over 4 sts.

CL (cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated ch-sp and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops. (Yarn over, insert hook in same ch-sp and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

dc4tog (dc 4 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 4 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

Popcorn Work 5 dc into indicated st, drop loop from hook, insert hook in first dc of 5-dc group just made, pick up dropped loop and draw it through. When working the following row, push the Popcorn to the right side of the fabric.

Note: On RS rows, insert hook from front to back in first dc of 5-dc group. On WS rows, insert hook from back to front in first dc of 5-dc group.

NOTES:

- 1. Twenty five Squares are crocheted, then sewn together following Assembly Diagram.
- 2. Squares may not match exactly in size. Any small differences in size of Squares can be eased in when sewing Squares together.
- 3. The Afghan is designed without a border.

SQUARE A (make 5) 3-dc Group Pattern

With A, ch 32.

Row 1: Do in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as first dc), sk next ch, sc in next ch, *sk next ch, 3 dc in next ch, sk next ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across to last 2 ch, sk next ch, 2 dc in last ch-Six 3-dc groups and two 2-dc groups at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sk next dc, 3 dc in next sc, sk next dc, *sc in next dc, sk next dc, 3 dc in next sc, sk next dc; rep from * across to turning ch, sc in top of turning ch-Seven 3-dc groups at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc on this row and on all the rows of this pattern), turn, dc in first sc, sk next dc, sc in next dc, sk next dc, *3 dc in next sc, sk next dc, sc in next dc, sk next dc; rep from * across to last sc, 2 dc in last sc.

Rows 4-19: Rep Rows 2 and 3 eight times.

Fasten off.

SQUARE B (make 5)

Popcorn Pattern

With B, ch 36.

Row 1 (RS): Work Popcorn in 6th ch from hook, ch 2, sk next ch, dc in next ch, *ch 1, sk next ch, Popcorn in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across-8 pattern reps at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 on this row and on all the rows of this pattern), turn, sk next ch, dc in next ch, *ch 1, sk next Popcorn, sk next ch, Popcorn in next dc, ch 2, sk next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across to last Popcorn, ch 1, sk last Popcorn, sk next ch, dc in next ch of turning ch.

Row 3: Ch 4, turn, sk next ch, Popcorn in next dc, *ch 2, sk next ch, dc in next ch, ch 1, sk next Popcorn, sk next ch, Popcorn in next dc; rep from * across to turning ch, ch 2, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

Rows 4-13: Rep Rows 2 and 3 five times.

Fasten off.

SQUARE C (make 5)

Surface Zig-Zag Pattern

With C, ch 35.

Note: When working crossed dc's, take care to work loosely enough so that square doesn't pull in.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 5th ch from hook, dc in next ch, working in front of last 2 dc made, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 crossed dc made), *sk next ch, dc in next 2 ch, working in front of last 2 dc made, dc in skipped ch; rep from * across to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch-10 pattern reps at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc on this row and on all the rows of this pattern), turn, *sk next dc, dc in next 2 dc, working behind last 2 dc made, dc in skipped dc; rep from * across to turning ch, dc in top of turning ch.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, *sk next dc, dc in next 2 dc, working in front of last 2 dc made, dc in skipped dc; rep from * across to turning ch, dc in top of turning ch.

Rows 4-15: Rep Rows 2 and 3 six times.

Fasten off.

SQUARE D (make 5)

Texture Pattern

With D, ch 30.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as first dc) and each ch across-28 dc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc on this row and on all the rows of this pattern), turn, *sc in next dc, dc in next dc; rep from * across to turning ch, sc in top of turning ch.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, *dc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from * across to turning ch, dc in top of turning ch.

Rows 4-17: Rep Rows 2 and 3 seven times.

Fasten off.

SQUARE E (make 5)

Cluster Pattern

With E, ch 32.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 3, dc4tog over next 4 ch, ch 1, sc in next ch; rep from * across-6 pattern reps at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 5, turn, sc in first dc4tog, ch 3, CL in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, *sc in next dc4tog, ch 3, CL in next ch-3 sp, ch 1; rep from * across to last sc, dc in last sc.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first CL, ch 3, CL in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, *sc in next CL, ch 3, Cl in next ch-3 sp, ch 1; rep from * across to turning ch, sc in turning ch-sp.

Row 4: Ch 5, turn, sc in first CL, ch 3, CL in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, *sc in next CL, ch 3, CL in next ch-3 sp, ch 1; rep from * across to last sc, dc in last sc.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 3 and 4 six times.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following Assembly Diagram, sew Squares together. Weave in ends.
