#### **MATERIALS**

- 830-122 <u>Lion Brand Cotton-Ease: Taupe</u>
  - 3 4, 4, 4 Balls (A)
- 861-149 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Moonstone

22, 2, 3 Balls (B)

- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 7 [4.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size E-4
- · Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### **GAUGE:**

17 sts + 19 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with larger needles and A.

21 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) and 12 rows = 5 in. (12.5 cm) in Granny Mesh with B.

17 dc + 10 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) with B.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### KNIT STITCH EXPLANATIONS

**kfb (knit in front and back)** Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st - 1 st increased.

**ssk** (**slip**, **slip**, **knit**) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog - 1 st decreased.

#### **CROCHET STITCH EXPLANATIONS**

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

dc3tog (dc 3 sts together) Yarn over, insert hook into st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops. (Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - 2 sts decreased.

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) Insert hook into st and draw up a loop. Insert hook into next st and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

V-st (V-stitch) (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st.

#### **CROCHET PATTERN STITCH**

Granny Mesh (multiple of 4 sts + 1)

**Row 1 (WS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next 3 sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from \* across to last 4 sc, dc in last 4 sc.

**Row 2 (RS):** Ch 4, (counts as dc, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to turning ch-sp, 3 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 for Granny Mesh.

#### NOTES:

- 1. Tunic is made in 4 pieces, Back, Front, and 2 Sleeves.
- 2. Knit Back and Front are worked from the lower edge to the beg of yoke. Armhole shaping for Front begins in the knit portion, then continues into the crocheted yoke; armhole shaping for Back is worked only in the yoke.
- 3. Yokes are crocheted directly onto knit Back and Front. Sleeves are crocheted separately.
- 4. When you see 'work even' in the instructions, this means to continue in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.

#### **KNIT BACK**

With smaller needles and A, cast on 77 (85, 93, 101) sts.

**Row 1 (WS):** P2, \*k1, p1; rep from \* to last st, p1.

Row 2 (RS): K2, \*p1, k1; rep from \* to last st, k1.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 3 in. (7.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row. **Note:** End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row, and the next row that you are ready to work will be a RS row.

#### Size S ONLY

**Next Row (RS):** K7, (kfb, k6) 10 times - 87 sts at the end of this row.

#### Sizes (M, L, 1X) ONLY

**Next Row (RS):** K7, (kfb, k6, kfb, k7) twice, (kfb, k7) (6, 7, 8) times - (95,104, 113) sts at the end of this row.

#### **All Sizes**

#### Body

Change to larger needles.


Beg with a WS (purl) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 11 rows.

**Decrease Row (RS):** K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 - 85 (93, 102, 111) sts at the end of this row.

Rep last 12 rows 4 more times - 77 (85, 94, 103) sts rem. Work in St st for 9 rows.

Rep Decrease Row - 75 (83, 92, 101) sts at the end of this row. Rep last 10 rows 2 more times - 71 (79, 88, 97) sts rem. Work even in St st until piece measures 24 in. (61 cm) from

beg, end with a WS row. Bind off.



16 (18, 20, 22) in.

6 (7, 7½, 8½) in.

31/2 in.

#### KNIT FRONT

Work same as Back until piece measures 24 in. (61 cm) from beg.

#### Shape Armholes

Bind off 4 (7, 10, 13) sts at beg of next 2 rows - 63 (65, 68, 71) sts rem.

**Decrease Row (RS):** K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, ssk, k1 - 61 (63, 66, 69) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 3 more times - 55 (57, 60, 63) sts rem. Bind off.

#### CROCHETED BACK YOKE

**Note:** First row of back yoke is worked across last knit row of Back.

Place a marker in 5th (8th, 11th, 14th) st and 67th (72nd, 78th, 84th) sts of Back.

From RS of Back, with crochet hook, join B with sc in first marked st, work 72 (76, 80, 84) more sc evenly spaced across to next marked st - 73 (77, 81, 85) sc at the end of this row.

**Row 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, sk first sc, dc3tog, ch 1, sk next sc, \*dc in next 3 sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from \* across to last 4 sc, dc3tog, dc in last sc - 69 (73, 77, 81) sts at the end of this row (counting each dc and each ch-1 sp as one st).

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to last ch-1 sp, 3 dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to last ch-1 sp, dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in top of turning ch - 65 (69, 73, 77) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to last ch-1 sp, 3 dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 6:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 in this row and in all following rows), turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across, dc in top of turning ch - 63 (67, 71, 75) sts at the end of this row.

Row 7: Ch 3, turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to last ch-1 sp, 3 dc in last ch-1 sp, dc in top of turning ch - 65 (69, 73, 77) sts at the end of this row.

**Rows 8-13 (13, 13, 15):** Rep last 2 rows 3 (3, 3, 4) more times.

**Row 14 (14, 14, 16):** Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; repeat from \* across, 2 dc in top of turning ch - 65 (69, 73, 77) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 15 (15, 15, 17):** Ch 4, turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across, dc in top of turning ch - 67 (71, 75, 79) sts at the end of this row.


Row 16 (16, 16, 18): Ch 3, turn, \*3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from \* across to turning ch-sp, 3 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch - 69 (73, 77, 81) sts at the end of this row.

#### Shape Neck and First Shoulder

Row 1 (WS): Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in next ch-1 sp; leave rem sts unworked for neck and 2nd shoulder - 19 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2** Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch - 18 sts at the end of this row.

Row 3 Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, dc in 3rd



ch of turning ch - 15 sts at the end of this row.

Fasten off, leaving a 12 in. (30.5 cm) tail for sewing shoulder seam.

#### Shape Neck and 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1 (WS):** From WS, sk center 27 (31, 35, 39) unworked sts following first shoulder, join B with sl st in next ch-1 sp, ch 4, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in top of turning ch - 19 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch - 18 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 3:** Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, dc in top of turning ch - 15 sts at the end of this row. Fasten off, leaving a 12 in. (30.5 cm) tail for sewing shoulder seam.

#### **CROCHETED FRONT YOKE**

**Note:** First row of front yoke is worked across last knit row of Front.

From RS of Front, with crochet hook, join B with sc in first st at upper right edge, work 64 (68, 72, 76) more sc evenly spaced across last row - 65 (69, 73, 77) sc at the end of this row. Beg with Row 1 (WS) of pattern, work in Granny Mesh Stitch for 6 (6, 6, 8) rows.

#### Shape Neck and First Shoulder

Row 1 (WS): Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, sk next dc, dc in next dc; leave rem sts unworked for neck and 2nd shoulder - 21 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in top of turning ch - 19 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in turning ch sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, 2 dc in top of turning ch - 19 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 5:** Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 7:** Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in top of turning ch - 18 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 8:** Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 9:** Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch - 15 sts at the end of this row.

Fasten off, leaving a 12 in. (30.5 cm) tail for sewing shoulder seam.

#### Shape Neck and 2nd Shoulder

**Row 1 (WS):** From WS, sk center 23 (27, 31, 35) unworked sts following first shoulder, join B with sl st in next dc, ch 3, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, 3 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch - 21 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in top of turning ch - 19 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, turn, dc in first dc, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 5:** Ch 4, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in top of turning ch.

Row 6: Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in

turning ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of turning ch.

**Row 7:** Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in top of turning ch - 18 sts at the end of this row.

**Row 8:** Ch 3, turn, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 4 times, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 9:** Ch 4, turn, sk first ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) 3 times, dc in top turning ch - 15 sts at the end of this row. Fasten off, leaving a 12 in. (30.5 cm) tail for sewing shoulder seam.

#### **CROCHETED SLEEVES (make 2)**

With crochet hook and B, ch 62 (68, 74, 86).

**Row 1 (WS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 61 (67, 73, 85) sc at the end of this row.

**Row 2 (RS):** Ch 4 (counts as tr), turn, sk first sc, tr in each sc across.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, sk first tr, dc next tr, sk next tr, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next tr (V-st made), (sk next 2 tr, V-st in next tr) 18 (20, 22, 26) times, sk next tr, dc in next tr, dc in top of turning ch - 19 (21, 23, 27) V-sts and 2 dc at each end.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across, sc in top of turning ch.

**Row 5:** Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sc, \*tr in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from \* across to last sc, tr in last sc - 61 (67, 73, 85) sts at the end of this row.

Fasten off.

#### Shape Cap

**Row 6 (RS):** From RS, sk first 5 (8, 11, 14) sts, join B with sl st in next st, ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and in all following rows), dc in each st across to last 5 (8, 11, 14) sts; leave rem sts unworked - 51 (51, 51, 57) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each dc across to last 2 sts, sc2tog - 49 (49, 49, 55) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 8:** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2), turn, sk first 3 sts, dc in next st, \*ch 2, sk next 2 sts, dc in next st; rep from \* across - 17 (17, 17, 19) dc and 16 (16, 16, 18) ch-2 sps at the end of this row.

**Row 9:** Ch 4, turn, tr in next ch-2 sp, tr in next dc, \*2 tr in next ch-2 sp, tr in next dc; rep from \* across to last ch-2 sp, tr in last ch-2 sp, tr in 3rd ch of turning ch - 47 (47, 47, 53) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 10:** Ch 3, turn, sk first tr, dc2tog, dc in tr across to last 2 tr, dc2tog - 45 (45, 45, 51) sts at the end of this row.

Row 11: Ch 3, turn, sk first st, dc2tog, sk next st, (V-st in next st, sk next 2 sts) 12 (12, 12, 14) times, V-st in next st, sk next st, dc2tog, dc in top of turning ch - 43 (43, 43, 49) sts at the end of this row.

Row 12: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across.

**Row 13:** Ch 3, turn, sk first sc, dc in next sc, sk next sc, (V-st in next sc, sk next 2 sc) 12 (12, 12, 14) times, V-st in next sc, sk next sc, dc in next sc, dc in top of turning ch.

Row 14: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across to last 2 sts, sc2tog - 41 (41, 41, 47) sts at the end of this row.


**Row 15:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, \*ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from \* across - 20 (20, 20, 23) ch-3 sps.

**Row 16:** Ch 3, turn, sk first st, \*sc in next ch-3 sp, dc in next sc; rep from \* across - 41 (41, 41, 47) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 17:** Ch 3, turn, sk first st, dc2tog, dc in each st across to last 2 sts, dc2tog - 39 (39, 39, 45) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 18:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 19: Ch 5 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sc, \*tr in next



sc, ch 1, sk next sc; rep from \* across to last sc, tr in last sc - 20 (20, 20, 23) tr and 19 (19, 19, 22) ch-1 sps at the end of this row.

**Row 20:** Ch 3, turn, sk first st, dc2tog, dc in each tr and ch-1 sp across to last 2 sts, dc2tog - 37 (37, 37, 43) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 21:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc2tog - 35 (35, 35, 41) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 22:** Ch 3 (does NOT count as a dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next st, (sk next 2 sts, V-st in next st) 9 (9, 9, 11) times, sk next 2 sts, work dc2tog over next st and last st (sk the st between, for a double decrease) - 29 (29, 29, 35) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 23:** Ch 3 (does NOT count as a dc), turn, dc in first ch-1 sp, V-st in next 7 (7, 7, 9) ch-1 sps, dc2tog over next ch-1 sp and last dc (sk the dc between, for a double decrease) - 23 (23, 23, 29) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 24:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc2tog - 21 (21, 21, 27) sts at the end of this row. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

#### FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

#### **Neck Edging**

Rnd 1: From RS, join B with sc at either shoulder seam, along neck edge.

Work sc evenly spaced around neck edge; do not join.

**Rnd 2:** SI st in each st around.

Fasten off.

#### Sleeve Edging

Rnd 1: From RS, join B with sc on lower edge of Sleeve at seam. Work sc evenly spaced around Sleeve edge; do not join.

Rnd 2: SI st in each st around.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
