# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Vanna's Glamour™ - Fun Fur 2 Color Crochet Sally Doll

**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy

SIZE: One Size

About 11 in. (28 cm) tall

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jul 14, 2011)

#### **FINISHING**

Seam sides of Body. Finished Body piece is a flat rectangle. Sew the two side edges of the rectangle together, to make a 'tube'. Flatten Body, so that seam is at center back.

#### **MATERIALS**

- 861-146 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Jewel
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 861-186 Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Bronze
  - 1 Ball (B)
- 320-151 Lion Brand Fun Fur Yarn: Sterling
  - 1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

Crochet hook size D-3 (3.25 mm)

Buttons for eyes

Fiberfill stuffing

Small amount of yarn or embroidery floss for mouth and 'eyelashes'

# **GAUGE:**

Exact gauge is not important to this project

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

**extended sc** Insert hook into next st 1 row below. Yarn over and draw up a loop to the height of the current row. Yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

### NOTES:

# **IMPORTANT NOTE**

Because of button eyes, Doll should not be given to small children. To make doll safe for children, use purchased safety eyes instead of buttons.

# **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

- 1. To change color, work last st of first color to last yarn over, yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st.
- 2. Body is worked back and forth in rows. Legs and Arms are worked in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.

#### **BODY**

Beg at lower edge of Body, with A, ch 37.

Set Up Row: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 36 sts at the end of this row.

Row 1: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Change to B.

Row 2: With B, ch 1, turn, \* sc in each of next 2 sts, extended sc in each of next 2 sts; rep from \* across.

Rows 3 and 4: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across. Change to A.

Row 5: With A, rep Row 2.

Change to B.

Row 6: With B, ch 1, turn, \* extended sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 2 sts; rep from \* across.

Rows 7 and 8: With B, rep Rows 3 and 4. Change to A.

Row 9: With A, rep Row 6.

Rep Rows 2-9 until piece measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm) from beg. Change to C.

Last 4 Rows: With C, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

## LEGS (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2-12: Sc in each st around.

Change to A.

Rnds 13-35: Sc in each st around, stuffing as you work.

Fasten off.

### ARMS (make 2)

With B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 8 sc in first ch. Place marker in first st for beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnds 2-16: Sc in each st around. Change to A.

Rnds 7-27: Sc in each st around, stuffing as you work.

Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Finished Body piece is a flat rectangle. Sew the two side edges of the rectangle together, to make a 'tube'. Flatten Body, so that seam is at center back. Sew buttons to Body for eyes. With yarn or embroidery floss, embroider a straight st mouth and 'eyelashes' above button eyes. Seam top edge of body. Stuff Body, then seam lower edge. Sew Arms and Legs to Body. Weave in ends.
