# Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Martha Stewart Crafts™ Alpaca Blend Modern Lace Scarf

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**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate

SIZE: One Size

About 8 1/2 x 60 in. (21.5 x 152.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- 5500-502 <u>Lion Brand Martha Stewart Crafts Alpaca Blend: Foxglove</u>
   2 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size N-13
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### **GAUGE:**

12 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

### dc3tog over 5 sts (decrease of 4 sts)

**Step 1:** Yarn over, insert hook into next sc and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook);

**Step 2:** Skip next sc, yarn over, insert hook into next sc and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops (3 loops on hook);

**Step 3:** Skip next sc, yarn over, insert hook into next sc and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through 2 loops (4 loops on hook);

**Step 4:** Yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - 4 sts decreased.

#### Lace Inc (increase of 4 sts)

Work (dc, ch 1, dc, ch 1, dc) all in same indicated st for lace inc - 4 sts increased.

## NOTES:

Each dc3tog over 5 sts (4-st dec) is paired with a lace inc (4-st inc), so stitch count will not change throughout this pattern.

# SCARF

Ch 26.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 25 sts.

Row 2: Ch 4, turn, dc in first sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc3tog over next 5 sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in ne

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across to turning ch, sc in 4th and 3rd ch of turning ch. Rep Rows 2 and 3 until almost all yarn has been used, end with a Row 3.

Fasten off.

# FINISHING

Weave in ends.
