

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Martha Stewart Crafts™ Extra Soft Wool Blend Modern Raglan Cardigan Pattern Number: L10124



The classic lines of this cardigan give it a flattering, chic look. Raglan shoulder shaping makes the sweater both elegant and simple to construct.

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: Small, Medium, Large, 1X, 2X

Finished Bust 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) in. (94 (104, 114.5, 124.5, 134.5) cm), including front bands **Finished Length** 21 1/2 (22, 22 1/2, 23, 23 1/2) in. (54.5 (56, 57, 58.5, 59.5) cm), including hem

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Oct 28, 2012)

LEFT SLEEVE

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Neck Shaping

Next Row (RS): Knit.

Next Row (WS): Bind off 4 sts, p to last 4 sts, p2tog, p2 - 9 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: Bind off 3 sts, p to last 2 4 sts, p2tog, p2 - 5 sts at the end of this row.

MATERIALS

- 5400-508 <u>Lion Brand Martha Stewart Crafts Extra Soft Wool Blend: Blue Corn</u>
 67, 8, 9, 10 Balls
- · Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- · Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 6 (4.25 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long 5 buttons, 1 in. (25 mm) diameter

GAUGE:

18 sts + 25 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with larger needle.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

STITCH EXPLANATION

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog - 1 st decreased.

PATTERN STITCH

K1, p1 Rib (over an odd number of sts)

Row 1: K1, *p1, k1; rep from * to across.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib.

NOTES:

- 1. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 2. Cardigan is worked in one piece from the lower edge up to armholes, then divided for Fronts and Back.
- 3. Hems are worked along the lower edge of Cardigan body and sleeves by picking up sts across the cast-on edge and working downward.

CARDIGAN

Body

With larger needle, cast on 160 (178, 196, 214, 232) sts. Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures 13 in. (33 cm) from beg, end with a WS row. **Note:** End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row, and the next row that you are ready to work will be a RS row.

Divide for Fronts and Back

Next Row (RS):K35 (38, 43, 47, 51) for Right Front, place Right Front sts on holder, bind off next 6 (8, 8, 10, 12) sts for underarm, knit until there are 78 (86, 94, 100, 106) sts on right needle for Back, place Back sts on holder, bind off next 6 (8, 8, 10, 12) sts for underarm, k to end for Left Front.

Left Front

Working over 35 (38, 43, 47, 51) Left Front sts only, work as follows:

Raglan Armhole Shaping

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to end - 34 (37, 42, 46, 50) sts at the end of this row.

Rep last 2 rows until 19 (21, 24, 27, 29) sts rem, end with a RS row.

Shape Neck

Next Row (WS): Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, p to end - 15 (16, 18, 20, 21) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to end - 14 (15, 17, 19, 20) sts at the end of this row.

Rep last 2 rows once more - 9 (9, 10, 11, 11) sts rem.

Next Row (WS): Bind off 2 (2, 3, 4, 4) sts, p to end - 7 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to end - 6 sts at the end of this row. **Next Row:** P2tog, p to end - 5 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k1 - 4 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.


Next Row: (K2tog) twice - 2 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: P2tog. Fasten off rem st.



From WS, slip the 78 (86, 94, 100, 106) sts for Back onto needle and join yarn.

Next Row (WS): Purl.



Raglan Armhole Shaping

Next Row (RS): K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 - 76 (84, 92,

98, 104) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until 34 (40, 44, 48, 50) sts rem, end with a WS

row. Bind off.

Right Front

Note: Right Front is worked same as for Left Front, reversing

shaping, as follows:

From WS, slip the 35 (38, 43, 47, 51) sts for Right Front onto

needle and join yarn.

Next Row (WS): Purl.

Raglan Armhole Shaping

Next Row (RS): K to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 - 34 (37, 42, 46, 50) sts

at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until 19 (21, 24, 27, 29) sts rem, end with a WS $\,$

row.

Shape Neck

Next Row (RS): Bind off 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) sts, k to last 4 sts, ssk,

k2 - 14 (15, 17, 19, 20) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows once more - 9 (9, 10, 11, 11) sts rem.

Next Row (RS): Bind off 2 (2, 3, 4, 4) sts, k to last 4 sts, ssk,

k2 - 6 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: K2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 - 4 sts at the end of

this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (Ssk) twice - 2 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: P2tog. Fasten off rem st.

HEM

From RS with smaller needle, pick up and knit 1 st in each st across cast-on edge of Body.

Beg with a WS (purl) row, work even in St st for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm),

end with a RS row.

Knit 1 WS row for turning ridge.

Work even in St st for 1 1/2 in. (4 cm).

Bind off. Fold Hem to WS along turning ridge and sew bound-off sts to WS of Cardigan.

RIGHT SLEEVE

With larger needle, cast on 58 (62, 68, 72, 76) sts.

Work in St st until piece measures 12 in. (30.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row.

Raglan Shaping Next Row (RS): Bind off 3 (4, 4, 5, 6) sts, k to

end - 55 (58, 64, 67, 70) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Bind off 3 (4, 4, 5, 6) sts, p to end - 52 (54, 60, 62,

64) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 - 50 (52, 58, 60,

62) sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows until 14 sts rem, end with a WS row.

Neck Shaping

Next Row (RS): Bind off 4 sts, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 - 9 sts at

the end of this row. **Next Row:** Purl.

Next Row: Bind off 3 sts, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 - 5 sts at the

end of this row. **Next Row:** Purl.

Next Row: K1, ssk, k2 - 4 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (Ssk) twice - 2 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: P2tog. Fasten off rem st.

Cuff

From RS with smaller needle, pick up and k43 (47, 51, 53, 57)

sts evenly across cast-on edge of Sleeve.

Work in K1, p1 Rib for 1 in. (2.5 cm), end with a RS row.

Knit 1 WS row for turning ridge.

Work in K1, p1 Rib for 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Bind off.

LEFT SLEEVE

Work same as Right Sleeve to neck shaping, end with a WS row.

Neck Shaping

Next Row (RS): Knit.

Next Row (WS): Bind off 4 sts, p to last 4 sts, p2tog, p2 - 9 sts

at the end of this row.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row: Bind off 3 sts, p to last 4 sts, p2tog, p2 - 5 sts at the

end of this row.

Next Row: K2, k2tog, k1 - 4 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: Purl.

Next Row: (K2tog) twice - 2 sts at the end of this row.

Next Row: P2tog. Fasten off rem st.

Cuff

Work same as Right Sleeve cuff.

Bind off.

ui (%,6 '6',6 '6',6 '8) %.7 SLEEVE 13 (13¾, 15, 16, 17) in.

FINISHING

Sew Sleeve seams. Fold cuffs to WS along turning ridge and sew bound-off sts to WS of Sleeves. Sew raglan edges of Sleeves to Body.

Neckband

From RS with smaller needle, pick up and k18 (20, 23, 25, 28) sts evenly spaced across right front neck edge, 12 sts across top of right sleeve, 33 (39, 43, 47, 49) sts across back edge, 12 sts across top of left sleeve, and 18 (20,

23, 25, 28) sts across left front neck edge - 93 (103, 113, 121, 129) sts at the end of this row.

Work in K1, p1 Rib for 2 in. (5 cm), end with a RS row.

Knit 1 WS row for turning ridge.

Work in K1, p1 Rib for 2 in. (5 cm).

Bind off.

Fold neckband to WS along turning ridge and loosely sew bound-off sts to WS of Cardigan.

Buttonband

Note: When picking up sts for buttonband and buttonhole band, work through all thicknesses along hem edge. From RS with smaller needle, beg at top corner of left front edge, pick up and k107 (108, 111, 114, 117) sts evenly spaced along left front edge.

Next Row (WS): K1, purl to last st, k1.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 3 more times.

Knit 1 WS row for turning ridge.

Work 7 rows in St st.

Bind off. Fold buttonband to WS along turning ridge. Sew bound-off sts to WS.

Buttonhole Band

From RS with smaller needle, beg at lower corner of right front edge, pick up and k107 (108, 111, 114, 117) sts evenly spaced along right front edge.

Next Row (WS): K1, purl to last st, k1.

Next Row: Knit.

Next Row (WS): K1, purl to last st, k1.

Buttonhole Row 1: K7 (8, 10, 10, 12), *bind off next 4 sts for buttonhole, k until there are 16 (16, 16, 17, 17)

more sts on right needle; rep from * 4 more times.

Buttonhole Row 2: K1, p to last st, casting on 4 sts over each buttonhole, k1.

Work 3 rows in St st.

Knit 1 WS row for turning ridge.

Work 2 rows in St st, then rep Buttonhole Rows 1 and 2.

Work 3 rows in St st.

Bind off.

Fold buttonhole band to WS along turning ridge. Sew edges of buttonholes together. Sew bound-off edge of band to WS.

Sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.
