Add interest to your loom knitting and to your winter apparel this season with this ridged cowl. Horizontal stripes of knits and purls make this textured project interesting to touch and to see. Knit this cozy cowl with the Martha Stewart Crafts Lion Brand Yarn Knit & Weave Loom Kit.

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm)

Finished Height About 9 in. (30.5 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied May 17, 2012)

NOTES

1. The instructions provided in the loom manual for casting on are the same for both flat knitting and knitting in the round (when you make a tube). These instructions are listed under the heading of SINGLE KNITTING.
2. Cowl is worked as a flat piece following instructions for SINGLE KNITTING, then seamed to make a tube.
3. Loom is configured into an oval shape to provide stability while knitting.

Insert 34 large pegs into every third hole ~~(so, cast onto one peg, leave 2 empty pegs, cast onto next peg)~~ (so insert one peg, leave the next 2 holes on the loom empty, then insert one peg into the next hole) anywhere along on loom - 34 working pegs placed.

COWL

Following loom manual directions for ~~knitting in the round~~ **SINGLE KNITTING**, cast onto all working pegs.

Row 1: Purl.

Row 2: Knit.

MATERIALS

- 5100-526 Lion Brand Martha Stewart Crafts Lofty Wool Blend: Bridle Brown
2 Balls
- Martha Stewart Crafts Lion Brand Yarn Knit & Weave Loom Kit

GAUGE:

6 stitches = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL TO THIS PROJECT.

NOTES:

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Loom Configuration

Use the following pieces: (2) 36-hole pieces and (2) 28-hole semi-circular pieces.

Connect pieces to form an oval as follows: 36-hole piece > 28-hole semi-circular piece > 36-hole piece > 28-hole semi-circle piece.

Insert 34 large pegs into every third hole (so insert one peg, leave the next 2 holes on the loom empty, then insert one peg into the next hole) on loom - 34 working pegs placed.

COWL

Following loom manual directions for SINGLE KNITTING, cast onto all working pegs.

Row 1: Purl.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Purl.

Rows 4-7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Rows 9-12: Knit.

Row 13: Purl.

Rows 14-17: Knit.

Row 18: Purl.

Rows 19-22: Knit.

Row 23: Purl.

Row 24: Knit.

Row 25: Purl.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Thread yarn ends through yarn needle provided with loom, and weave ends into the fabric of the piece.

With yarn threaded into needle provided with loom, sew ends of piece together (like a tube) to make Cowl.

Every effort has been made to have the knitting and crochet instructions accurate and complete. We cannot be responsible for variance of individual knitters and crocheters, human errors, or typographical mistakes.
