SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: Varies
S/M/L (1X/2X)
Finished Circumference 31 (45) in. (78.5 (114.5) cm)
Finished Height 10 in. (25.5 cm)
Notes: Cowl will stretch to fit a range of sizes. Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Sep 19, 2011)

Finished Chest Circumference 31 (45) in. (78.5 (114.5) cm)

Finished Length Height 10 in. (25.5 cm)

Notes: Capelet Cowl will stretch to fit a range of sizes. Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CAPELET COWL

Cast on 33 sts. Work in Garter st (k every row) until almost 4 (5) balls of yarn have been used (at least 1 ball of yarn remains). Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew short ends together.

Trim

With crochet hook, join yarn with slip st at seam on one edge of Capelet Cowl.

Round 1: Working in ends of rows around edge of Capelet Cowl, sc in same space as join, *sk ends of next 2 rows, (tr, ch 1) 5 times in end of next row, tr in end of same row (fan made), sk ends of next 2 rows, sc in end of next row; rep from * around, skipping more or fewer row ends to end evenly; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off. Rep trim around other edge of Capelet Cowl.

Weave in ends.

MATERIALS

- 5800-530 Lion Brand Martha Stewart Crafts Glitter Eyelash: Peridot
- 5 6 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 [8 mm]
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size K-10.5
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

13 stitches = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter stitch (knit every row) with knitting needles. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.
