SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE:

Child (Adult) About 43 (50) in. (109 (127) cm) long.

Note: Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 910-150 Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Sterling
 - 1 Ball (A)
- 910-109 Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Royal Blue
 - 1 Ball (B)
- 910-148 Lion Brand Microspun Yarn: Turquoise
 - 1 Ball (C)
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 2 (2.75 mm), 36 in. (94.5 cm) long

GAUGE:

6 sts = about 1 in (2.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit into front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st -1 st increased.

TIE

Note: To make counting easier when casting on a large number of sts, tie a piece of contrast color yarn or insert a marker between groups of 50 sts.

With A, cast on 260 (300) sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K to last st, kfb.

Change to B. Row 3: Knit.

Change to C.

Change to C.

Row 4: K to last st, kfb.

Row 5: Knit. Change to A.

Row 6: K to last st, kfb.

Row 7: Knit.


Rows 8-11: Rep Rows 6 and 7. **Row 12:** K to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Row 13: Knit.

Rows 14-19: Rep Rows 12 and 13.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Dampen and block thoroughly to keep edges flat and even.
