

# Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand<sup>®</sup> Wool-Ease<sup>®</sup> Thick & Quick<sup>®</sup> Buttoned Cowl

Pattern Number: L10745



Knitted in the simple garter stitch, this cowl is the ideal project for a beginner interested in making a snug, chic cowl to wear or to give away as a gift.

# NOTES:

The Cowl is knit as a simple rectangle, all in Garter stitch, with four buttonholes. Two buttons are sewed to the end of the Cowl opposite 2 of the buttonholes, allowing the Cowl to be buttoned in various creative ways. You can choose which 2 buttonholes to sew your buttons opposite from – we loved our choice of the first and the third buttonhole. The Cowl is designed with the option to button it in creative ways. You can even slip the button through 2 of the buttonholes to create a dimensional fold in the knitting.

**Next (Buttonhole) Row:** Knit 2, \*knit 3, knit 2 stitches together, yarnover, repeat from \* 3 more times (so that 4 buttonholes have been made), knit 4 5

#### **MATERIALS**

- 640-153 <u>Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Black</u>
   1 Ball
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
  - 2 large buttons, about 1 1/4 in. (3 cm) diameter Sewing needle and thread

# **GAUGE:**

About 9 stitches = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter stitch (knit every row).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

# NOTES:

The Cowl is knit as a simple rectangle, all in Garter stitch, with four buttonholes. Two buttons are sewed to the end of the Cowl opposite 2 of the buttonholes, allowing the Cowl to be buttoned in various creative ways. You can choose which 2 buttonholes to sew your buttons opposite from – we loved our choice of the first and the third buttonhole. The Cowl is designed with the option to button it in creative ways. You can even slip the button through 2 of the buttonholes to create a dimensional fold in the knitting.

# COWL

Cast on 27 stitches. Work in Garter stitch (knit every row) for 2 rows.

On the next row, you will make 4 buttonholes. Each buttonhole is made by knitting 2 stitches together, then doing a yarnover. The stitch count will not change.

**Next (Buttonhole) Row:** Knit 2, \*knit 3, knit 2 stitches together, yarnover, repeat from \* 3 more times (so that 4 buttonholes have been made), knit 5.

**Next Row:** Knit all stitches and all yarnovers. Continue in Garter stitch until all but about 1 yard (1 meter) of yarn has been used.

Bind off.

# **FINISHING**

Thread yarn ends into blunt needle and weave into the stitches of the Cowl. With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons across end of Cowl opposite 2 of the buttonholes.

\* Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool

Oatmeal, Barley, Grey Marble, Wheat: 86% Acrylic, 10% Wool, 4% Rayon

Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g

(106 yd/97 m)

Prints (Sequoia, Mesquite, Granite): 5 oz./141g (87 yd/80 m)

Metallics: 5 oz./141g (92 yd/84 m)
