- LION BRAND® JAMIE® (Art. \#881)
\#200-Pink \#203 Twinkle Stripes 3 balls (C)
\#133 Peachy 1 ball 3 balls (D)


## MATERI ALS

- 881-100 Lion Brand Jamie Yarn: Angel White
4 Balls (A)
- 881-103 Lion Brand Jamie Yarn: Lullaby Pink

3 Balls (B)

- 881-203 Lion Brand Jamie Yarn: Twinkle Stripes

3 Balls (C)

- 881-133 Lion Brand Jamie Yarn: Peachy

3 Balls (D)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size F-5 (3.75 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials

Circular knitting needle size 5
( 3.75 mm ), 24 in . ( 60 cm ) long

## GAUGE:

21 sts and 29 rows $=4 \mathrm{in}$. ( 10 cm ) in Stockinette st ( $k$ on RS, p on WS).
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in . [ 10 cm ] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st but do not remove it from left needle, then $k$ through back of same st - 1 st increased.
ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog - 1 st decreased.

1. Entrelac knitting consists of Strips of Triangles and Squares. Triangles and Squares are worked in short rows over a portion of the sts in a Strip, leaving the remaining sts unworked. To work short rows, the pattern instructions will tell you to 'turn' before you reach the end of the row.
2. The Blanket begs and ends with a Strip of Triangles. Between the beg and end Strips of Triangles, Strips of Squares are worked alternately with Strips of Squares and Triangles.
3. Each Strip is worked with a single color.
4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.
5. An edging is crocheted around the outside edge of the completed Blanket.

## COLOR SEQUENCE

Work 1 Strip each with A, B, C, and then D. Rep for Color Sequence.

## BLANKET

Beg Triangle Strip
With circular needle and $A$, cast on 128 sts.
*Row 1 (WS): P2, turn, leaving rem sts unworked.
Row 2: K2, turn.
Row 3: P3, turn.
Row 4: K3, turn.
Row 5: P4, turn.
Row 6: K4, turn.
Row 7: P5, turn.
Row 8: K5, turn.
Row 9: P6, turn.
Row 10: K6, turn.
Row 11: P7, turn.
Row 12: K7, turn.
Row 13: P8, do not turn.
Rep from * until all 128 cast-on sts have been worked and there are 16 Triangles of 8 sts each on the needle. At the end of the final rep of Row 13, turn, so that you are ready to work a RS row. Cut A.

## Strip of Triangles and Squares

Note: This Strip begins and ends with a Triangle; Squares are worked between the Triangles.

## Right Hand Side Triangle

Row 1 (RS): With RS facing and B, k2, turn.
Row 2: P2, turn.
Row 3: Kfb, ssk, turn.
Row 4: P3, turn.
Row 5: Kfb, k1, ssk, turn.
Row 6: P4, turn.
Row 7: Kfb, k2, ssk, turn.
Row 8: P5, turn.
Row 9: Kfb, k3, ssk, turn.
Row 10: P6, turn.
Row 11: Kfb, k4, ssk, turn.
Row 12: P7, turn.
Row 13: Kfb, k5, ssk, do not turn.

## Center Squares

With RS facing and B, pick up and knit 8 sts along edge of next Square/Triangle of previous Strip, turn.
*Row 1 (WS): P8, turn.
Row 2: K7, ssk, turn.
Rows 3-16: Rep Rows 1 and 2 seven times, do not turn at end of Row 16.
Rep from * 14 more times.
Left Hand Side Triangle
With RS facing and B, pick up and knit 8 sts evenly spaced along edge of last Square/Triangle of previous Strip.
Row 1: P2tog, p6, turn.
Row 2: K7, turn.
Row 3: P2tog, p5, turn.

Row 4: K6, turn.
Row 5: P2tog, p4, turn.
Row 6: K5, turn.
Row 7: P2tog, p3, turn.
Row 8: K4, turn.
Row 9: P2tog, p2, turn.
Row 10: K3, turn.
Row 11: P2tog, p1, turn.
Row 12: K2, turn.
Row 13: P2tog, do not turn - 15 Center Squares and 2 Side Triangles across Strip. Cut B.

## Strip of Squares

With WS facing and C, pick up and purl 7 sts evenly spaced along edge of Side Triangle just worked, turn - 8 sts.
*Row 1: K8, turn.
Row 2: P7, p2tog, turn.
Rows 3-16: Rep Rows 1 and 2 seven times, do not turn at end of Row 16.
Pick up and purl 8 sts evenly spaced along edge of next Square/Triangle.
Rep from * across row - 16 Squares of 8 sts each at the end of this Strip. Cut C.
Keeping in Color Sequence, alternate working a Strip of Triangles and Squares with a Strip of Squares until piece measures about 36 in . 91.5 cm ) from beg, end with $D$ and a Strip of Triangles and Squares.

## End Triangle Strip

*With WS facing and A, pick up and purl 7 sts evenly spaced along edge of Side Triangle just worked, turn - 8 sts.
Row 1: K8, turn.
Row 2: P2tog, p5, p2tog, turn.
Row 3: K7, turn.
Row 4: P2tog, p4, p2tog, turn.
Row 5: K6, turn.
Row 6: P2tog, p3, p2tog, turn.
Row 7: K5, turn.
Row 8: P2tog, p2, p2tog, turn.
Row 9: K4, turn.
Row 10: P2tog, p1, p2tog, turn.
Row 11: K3, turn.
Row 12: P2tog, p2tog, turn.
Row 13: K2, turn.
Row 14: P2tog, p2tog, pass first st over second, do not turn - 1 st rem.
Rep from * across row, picking up next 7 sts evenly spaced across next Square or final Triangle until all sts have been worked - 1 st rem.
Fasten off.

## FI NISHING

Edging
NOTES

1. 148 sc are worked along one side of Blanket, but only 147 sc are worked along the opposite side. This is done to create the correct number of sts for Rnd 2.
2. Edging is meant to be a bit tighter than knit edges of Blanket - this stabilizes the edges.

Rnd 1: With RS facing and crochet hook, join A with a sl st in any st along outside edge, work 124 sc evenly spaced across both short edges, 148 sc evenly spaced across one long edge, 147 sc evenly spaced across other long edge, and 3 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first sc -555 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), (dc, ch 1, 2 dc ) in same st as join, ch 1, sk next 4 sc , * ( 2 dc , ch $1,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next sc, ch 1, sk next 4 sc ; rep from * around; join with sl st in first dc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.
