Adult's Simple Knit Hat

Pattern Number: L20403

SKILL LEVEL: Easy

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Feb 20, 2013)

HAT

With smaller needles, cast on 100 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles, with 25 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd.

Note: Placing the same number of sts onto each needle means that when you work Rnd 1, on first needle, you will k2, p2 across to the last st, then k the last st; on the second needle k1, then continue the K2, p2 Rib.

In other words, the K2, p2 rib will not finish with a p2 at the end of each needle. This is fine! The pattern will still work perfectly.

If you prefer to have the pattern end with a p2 at the end of every needle, divide your sts as follows: 24 sts on first needle; 28 sts on second needle; 24 sts on third needle; and 24 sts on fourth needle.

MATERIALS

- 620-114 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Yarn: Denim
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 7
- Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 8
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) with larger needles.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH K2, p2 Rib (worked in the rnd over a multiple of 4 sts)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * around.

Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib worked in the rnd.

HAT

With smaller needles, cast on 100 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles, with 25 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg

of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Note: Placing the same number of sts onto each needle means that when you work Rnd 1, on first needle, you will k2, p2 across to the last st, then k the last st; on the second needle k1, then continue the K2, p2 Rib.

In other words, the K2, p2 rib will not finish with a p2 at the end of each needle. This is fine! The pattern will still work perfectly.

If you prefer to have the pattern end with a p2 at the end of every needle, divide your sts as follows:

24 sts on first needle; 28 sts on second needle; 24 sts on third needle; and 24 sts on fourth needle.

Work in K2, p2 Rib worked in the rnd until piece measures about 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) from beg.

Change to larger needles and work in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) until piece measures about 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm) from beg.

Shape Crown (top of Hat)

Next (Decrease) Rnd:: *K8, k2tog; rep from * around - 90 sts at the end of this rnd.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd:: *K7, k2tog; rep from * around - 80 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd:: *K6, k2tog; rep from * around - 70 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K5, k2tog; rep from * around - 60 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K4, k2tog; rep from * around - 50 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K3, k2tog; rep from * around - 40 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K2, k2tog; rep from * around - 30 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K1, k2tog; rep from * around - 20 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *K2tog; rep from * around - 10 sts.

Next Rnd: Knit.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through sts of the last rnd and pull to gather for top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

- Solid, Heather, Twist: 80% acrylic, 20% wool
- Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 86% acrylic, 10% wool, 4% rayon
- Glitter/Multi-colors: 78% acrylic, 19% wool, 3% polyester
- Frosts: 70% acrylic, 20% wool, 10% polyamide
- Prints: 80% acrylic, 20% wool

Solid, Heather, Twist: 3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls

Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 3 oz/85g; 197 yd/180m balls

Glitter/Multi-colors: 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls

Frosts: 2.5 oz./70g; 162 yd/146m balls

Prints: 2.5 oz/70g; 162 yd/146m balls
