**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 18 in. (45.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

#### MATERIALS

- 640-304 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Gemstone  
1 Ball
- Brittany Birchwood Double Pointed Needles - Size 13
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Pom pom Maker
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
Circular knitting needle size 13 (9 mm), 16 in. (40.5 cm) long

*\*Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® (Article #640).  
Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool  
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon  
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon  
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)  
Prints (Sequoia, Mesquite, Granite): 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)  
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



#### GAUGE:

9 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette st worked in the rnd (k every rnd).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**kfb (knit in front and back)** Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st - 1 st increased.

#### PATTERN STITCH

**K2, p2 Rib worked in rnds (multiple of 4 sts)**

**Rnd 1:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end of rnd.

Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib worked in rnds.

#### NOTES:

1. Hat is worked from the crown (top) to the brim (bottom).
2. Hat is worked in rnds, beg with double pointed needles, then changing to circular needle after sufficient increases have been made.
3. If you prefer, the entire Hat can be worked on double pointed needles.

## HAT

With double pointed needles, cast on 8 sts. Distribute 2 sts onto each of 4 needles. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

**Rnd 1:** Knit.

**Rnd 2:** Kfb in each st around - 16 sts at the end of this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** Knit.

**Rnd 4:** \*K1, kfb; rep from \* to end of rnd - 24 sts.

**Rnd 5:** Knit.

**Rnd 6:** \*K2, kfb; rep from \* to end of rnd - 32 sts.

**Rnd 7:** Knit.

**Rnd 8:** \*K3, kfb; rep from \* to end of rnd - 40 sts.

Change to circular needle.

**Rnds 9-21:** Knit.

**Rnds 22-31:** Work in K2, p2 Rib.

Bind off in rib.

## FINISHING

Sew opening at top of Hat closed.

### Pom pom

Following package directions, make one large size pom pom. Tie pom pom to top of Hat.

Weave in ends.
