136-122 Heartland: Grand Canyon 2 3 balls

## **MATERIALS**

 3 Balls

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook -</u> <u>Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch</u> <u>Markers</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6)

\*Heartland (Article #136). 100% Acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/142.00 gr. (251yds/230m) pull skeins




# GAUGE:

11 sc = 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

A large hook is used to create an open fabric that will easily stretch to fit a range of sizes.



# **SHRUG**

Ch 113.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 112 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 32 in. (81.5 cm) from beginning.

## **FINISHING**

Fold piece in half to measure 20 x 32 in  $(51 \times 81.5 \text{ cm})$ . Place markers on each of the 20 in. (51 cm) sides, 7 in. (18 cm) below fold for armholes. Seam sides from markers down to lower edge. Weave in ends.
