package size: 0.88oz/25.00 gr. (82yds/75m) pull skeins

SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: One Size

About 16 x 60 in. (40.5 x 152.5 cm), at longest and widest points

- 483-142 <u>Lion Brand LB</u> <u>Collection Cashmere Yarn:</u> <u>Claret</u> 4 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles-Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles (for Size 10.5 [6.5 mm] binding off)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

18 sts + 20 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Lace Pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

s2kp (slip 2 sts-knit next st-pass 2 slipped sts over)

A double decrease worked as follows:

1. Insert right needle into next 2 sts as if to k2tog, and slip these 2 sts to the right needle.

2. Knit the next st.

3. With tip of left needle, lift the 2 slipped sts (the 2nd and 3rd sts on right needle) up and over the knit st (first st on right needle) and off the needle - you have decreased 2 sts.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog - 1 st decreased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.

2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCHES Lace Pattern (worked over 8 sts)

Note: St count does not change in lace pattern.
Row 1 (RS): Knit.
Row 2 (WS): Purl.
Row 3: K1, yo, k2tog, k3, ssk, yo.
Row 4: P1, yo, p2 tog through back loop, p1, p2tog, yo, p2.
Row 5: K3, yo, s2kp, yo, k2.
Row 6: Purl.
Rep Rows 1-6 for Lace Pattern.



NOTES:

1. Shawl begins at the center back neck and is shaped by working 6 yarn over (yo) increases on every RS row.

2. Shawl consists of 3 pie-shaped sections, all worked at the same time.

3. Shawl can be worked from the written instructions or by following the charts. If working from charts, read RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right. Work Rows 1 - 64 of Chart A then and work Rows 65 - 86 by working from Charts B and Chart C simultaneously.


4. If following chart, be sure to refer to written instructions for Row 28 to place markers. The markers are meant to help keep track of your sts. On the following rows, slip markers each time you come to them unless otherwise instructed.


5. Increased sts are incorporated into Lace Pattern on RS rows when there are 9 sts between the first two markers. On these rows, one new rep of the Lace Pattern will be added before and after previously worked Lace Pattern sts.

6. The first and last 2 sts of every row are worked in Garter st (k every row).

7. Larger needles are used only for binding off.








Rep sts between red line on Chart B and red line on Chart C a total of 3 times

Work Charts B and C simultaneously.

On RS rows, work from right to left working Chart B and then Chart C. On WS rows, work from left to right working Chart C and then Chart B.

- knit on RS, purl on WS
- purl on RS, knit on WS
- yarn over
- s2kp on RS
- k2tog on RS, p2tog on WS
- ssk (slip, slip, knit) on RS, p2tog tbl on WS



Rep sts between red line on Chart C and red line on Chart B a total of 3 times

Chart C

Work Charts B and C simultaneously. On RS rows, work from right to left working Chart B and then Chart C. On WS rows, work from left to right working Chart C and then Chart B.

knit on RS, purl on WS

purl on RS, knit on WS

yarn over

s2kp on RS

k2tog on RS, p2tog on WS

ssk (slip, slip, knit) on RS, p2tog tbl on WS

SHAWL

With size 9 (5.5 mm) needles, cast on 15 sts. Rows 1 and 2: Knit. Row 3 (RS): K2, p2, (yo, k1, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 21 sts at the end of this row. Row 4 (WS): K2, (k2, p3) 3 times, k4. Row 5: K2, p2, (yo, k3, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 27 sts. Row 6: K2, (k2, p5) 3 times, k4. **Row 7:** K2, p2, (yo, k5, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 33 sts. Row 8: K2, (k2, p7) 3 times, k4. Row 9: K2, p2, (yo, k1, yo, k1, s2kp, k1, yo, k1, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 39 sts. Row 10: K2, (k2, p9) 3 times, k4. **Begin Lace Pattern Row 11:** K2, p2, (yo, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern, k1, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 45 sts. Row 12: K2, (k2, p2, work Row 2 of Lace Pattern, p1) 3 times, k4. **Row 13:** K2, p2, (yo, k1, work Row 3 of Lace Pattern, k2, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 51 sts. Row 14: K2, (k2, p3, work Row 4 of Lace Pattern, p2) 3 times, k4. Row 15: K2, p2, (yo, k2, work Row 5 of Lace Pattern, k3, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 57 sts. Row 16: K2, (k2, p4, work Row 6 of Lace Pattern, p3) 3 times, k4. Row 17: K2, p2, (yo, k3, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern, k4, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 63 sts. Row 18: K2, (k2, p5, work Row 2 of Lace Pattern, p4) 3 times, k4. **Row 19:** K2, p2, (yo, k4, work Row 3 of Lace Pattern, k5, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 69 sts. Row 20: K2, (k2, p6, work Row 4 of Lace Pattern, p5) 3 times, k4. **Row 21:** K2, p2, (yo, k5, work Row 5 of Lace Pattern, k6, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 75 sts. Row 22: K2, (k2, p7, work Row 6 of Lace Pattern, p6) 3 times, k4. **Row 23:** K2, p2, (yo, k6, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern, k7, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 81 sts. Row 24: K2, (k2, p8, work Row 2 of Lace Pattern, p7) 3 times, k4. Row 25: K2, p2, (yo, k7, work Row 3 of Lace Pattern, k8, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 87 sts. Row 26: K2, (k2, p9, work Row 4 of Lace Pattern, p8) 3 times, k4. Row 27: K2, p2, (yo, k8, work Row 5 of Lace Pattern, k9, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 93 sts. Row 28: K2, (k2, place marker (pm), p2, pm for beg of Lace Pattern, p8, work Row 6 of Lace Pattern, p8, pm for end of Lace Pattern, p1, pm) 3 times, k4.

Row 29: K2, p2, (slip marker (sm), yo, k to marker, work Row 1 of Lace Pattern across to next marker, sm, k to next marker, yo, sm, p2) 3 times, k2 - 99 sts.

Rows 30, 32 and 34: K2, (k2, sm, p to next marker, work next row of Lace Pattern across to next marker, p to next marker) 3 times, k4.

Row 31: K2, p2, (sm, yo, k to marker, work next row of Lace Pattern across to next marker, k to next marker, yo, sm, p2) 3 times, k2 - 105 sts.

Row 33: K2, p2, (sm, yo, k to marker, work next row of Lace Pattern across to next marker, k to next marker, yo, sm, p2) 3 times, k2 - 111 sts.

Rows 34-82: Repeat Rows 29 - 34 eight more times, incorporating increased sts into Lace Pattern on RS rows when there are 9 St sts (k on RS, p on WS) between first 2 markers as follows: k2, p2, (sm, yo, k1, pm, work Lace Pattern as established to next marker, remove marker, work Lace Pattern as established across to next marker, remove marker, work

Lace Pattern as established over next 8 sts, pm, k2 to next marker, yo, sm, p2) 3 times, k2. Row 83 (RS): k2 p2 (remove marker, yo, k to marker, remove marker, k to next marker, remove marker, k to next

Row 83 (RS): K2, p2, (remove marker, yo, k to marker, remove marker, k to next marker, remove marker, k to next marker, sm, yo, p2) 3 times, k2 - 261 sts.

Row 84 (WS): Knit.

Row 85: K2, p2, (*k2tog, yo, rep from * across to marker, remove marker, k1, p2) 3 times, k2. **Row 86:** Knit.

With larger needle, bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
