**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

- 640-304 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Gemstone  
6 6, 7, 7, 8 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Stitch Holders
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials  
3 buttons, about 1 in. (25 mm) diameter  
Sewing needle and thread

#### GAUGE:

10 sts + 14 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**M1L (make 1 - left slanting)** An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles from front to back and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop - 1 st increased.

**M1R (make 1 - right slanting)** An increase worked by inserting right needle into side leg of st one row below the next st on left needle, place the loop on left needle and knit it through the back loop - 1 st increased.

**skp** Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 1, pass slip stitch over knit stitch - 1 st decreased.

#### **yo (yarn over)**

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

#### PATTERN STITCH

**Sl st Pattern (worked over 4 sts)**

**Row 1 (RS):** P1, k2, p1.

**Row 2 (WS):** K1, sl 2 wyif, k1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for SI st pattern.

## NOTES:

1. Jacket is worked in 5 pieces: Back, Left Front, Right Front, and 2 Sleeves.
2. The collar and front bands are worked as one with each of the Fronts.
3. The lower edge of the Back and Fronts is worked in Garter st (k every row) with columns of 4 sts worked in SI st pattern. After 10 rows, the Garter st changes to St st (k on RS, p on WS) and the columns of SI st pattern are continued.
4. Markers are used to define the sides of the columns of the SI st pattern and the front bands. If you can "read" your work, you may not need the markers for the SI st pattern.
5. Back and Fronts are shaped with increases at sides.
6. Decs and compensating incs are worked along the edges of the SI st pattern. These will not change the st count, but they will cause the SI st pattern sts to shift diagonally across the Jacket.
7. When you see "work even" in the instructions, this means to continue on in the pattern st you have established without changing the st count by increasing, decreasing, or binding off.
8. With yarn in front (wyif) refers to the side of the work facing you as you work the row. To move yarn from front to back or back to front, bring yarn between needles. Taking care not to wrap yarn over a needle.

## BACK

Cast on 37 (40, 42, 45, 48) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K10 (10, 10, 11, 12), place marker (pm), work Row 1 of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, pm, k9 (12, 14, 15, 16), pm, work Row 1 of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, pm, k10 (10, 10, 11, 12) sts.

**Rows 2-10:** Work in Garter st (k every row) to first marker, slip marker (sm), work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, work in Garter st to next marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, work in Garter st to end of row.

### Shape Sides

**Note:** Garter st sections now change to St st (k on RS, p on WS).

**Row 11 (Inc Row) (RS):** K1, M1R, k to first marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, M1R, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to last st, M1L, k1 - 41 (44, 46, 49, 52) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 12:** P to first marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

**Note:** On Row 13, each inc is matched with a dec, the st count will not change.

**Row 13:** K to 2 sts before first marker, k2tog, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, M1R, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, skp, k to end of row.

**Row 14:** Rep Row 12.

**Row 15 (Inc Row):** K to first marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, M1R, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row - 43 (46, 48, 51, 54) sts.

**Row 16:** Rep Row 12.

**Rows 17-24:** Rep Rows 13-16 twice - 47 (50, 52, 55, 58) sts.

**Rows 25 and 26:** Rep Rows 13 and 14.

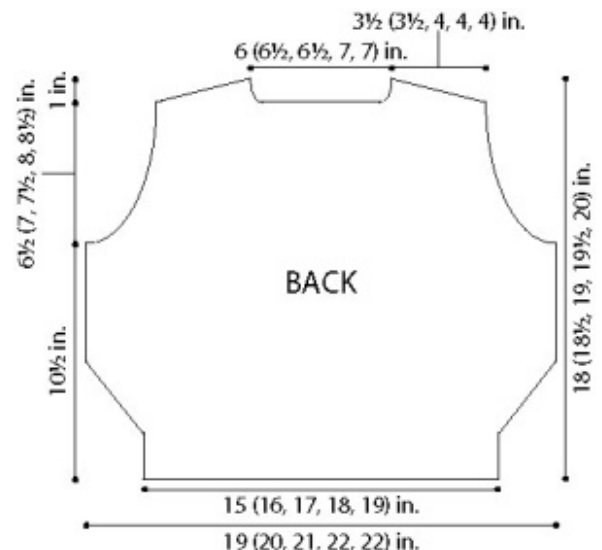
**Row 27:** K to first marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end.

**Row 28:** Rep Row 12.

**Rows 29-40:** Rep last 4 rows 3 times, removing markers as you work the last row.

For all sizes, piece should measure about 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm) from beg.

### Shape Armholes



**Note:** Beg with the next row, piece is worked in St st only.

**Next Row (RS):** Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, k to end of row - 44 (47, 49, 51, 54) sts.

**Next Row:** Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, p to end of row - 41 (44, 46, 47, 50) sts.

**Next Row:** Bind off 2 sts, k to end of row - 39 (42, 44, 45, 48) sts.

**Next Row:** Bind off 2 sts, p to end of row - 37 (40, 42, 43, 46) sts.

**Next Row:** K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 - 35 (38, 40, 41, 44) sts.

**Next Row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 2 (3, 3, 3, 4) times - 31 (32, 34, 35, 36) sts.

Work even in St st until armholes measure about 6 1/2 (7, 7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2) in. (16.5 (18, 19, 20.5, 21.5) cm), end with a WS row as your last row.

### Shape Neck and Shoulders

**Next Row (RS):** Bind off 3 sts (1 st rem on right needle), k6 (6, 7, 7, 7), join a 2nd ball of yarn and bind off center 11 (12, 12, 13, 14) sts for neck, k to end of row.

Work both sides at the same time using separate balls of yarn.

**Next Row:** On first side, bind off 3 sts, then p to end of side; on 2nd side, p to end - 7 (7, 8, 8, 8) sts on each side.

**Next Row:** On first side, bind off 3 sts, k to end of side; on 2nd side, bind off 2 sts, k to end of row.

**Next Row:** On first side, bind off 3 sts, p to end of side; on 2nd side, bind off 2 sts, p to end of row - 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) sts on each side.

**Next Row:** On first side, bind off rem sts; on 2nd side, k to end of row.

Bind off all sts on rem side.

### LEFT FRONT

Cast on 22 (23, 24, 26, 27) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K10 (10, 10, 11, 12), pm, work Row 1 of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, pm, k3 (4, 5, 6, 6), pm, p1, k4 (for buttonband).

**Row 2:** K to first marker (for buttonband), sm, k to next marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 3:** K to first marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, p1, k4 (for buttonband).

**Rows 4-10:** Rep last 2 rows 4 times, slipping markers as you come to them.

### Shape Side

**Note:** Garter st sections now change to St st.

**Row 11 (RS):** K1, M1R, k to first marker, sm, next row of work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, M1R, k to next marker, sm, p1, k4 - 24 (25, 26, 28, 29) sts.

**Row 12:** K to first marker, sm, p to next marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

**Row 13:** K to 2 sts before first marker, k2tog, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, M1R, k to next marker, sm, p1, k4.

**Row 14:** K to first marker, sm, p to next marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

**Row 15 (Inc Row):** K to first marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, M1R, k to next marker, sm, p1, k4 - 25 (26, 27, 29, 30) sts.

**Row 16:** K to first marker, sm, p to next marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

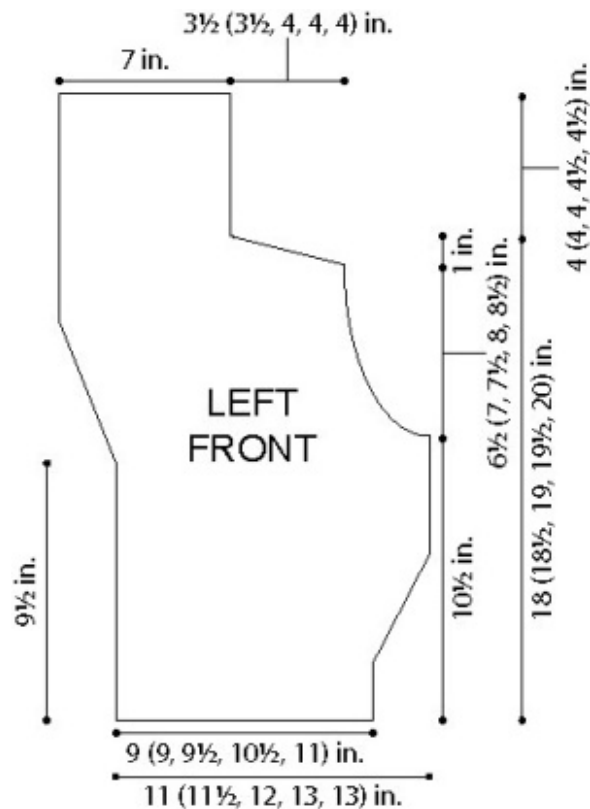
**Rows 17-24:** Rep Rows 13-16 twice - 27 (28, 29, 31, 32) sts.

**Rows 25 and 26:** Rep Rows 13 and 14.

**Row 27:** K to first marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, p1, k4.

**Row 28:** K to first marker, sm, p to next marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

**Rows 29-36:** Rep last 4 rows twice.



For all sizes, piece should measure about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from beg.

### **Shape Neck and Shawl Collar**

**Row 37 (RS):** K to first marker, sm, work Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to 2 sts before next marker, k2tog (for neck), sm, p1, M1R (for collar), k to end of row.

**Row 38:** K to first marker, sm, p to next marker, sm, work Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

**Row 39 (Inc Row):** K to first marker, sm, work Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, p1, M1R (for collar) k to end of row - 28 (29, 30, 32, 33) sts.

**Row 40:** Rep Row 38, removing all markers except the buttonband marker.

For all sizes, piece should measure about 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm) from beg.

**Notes:** Beg with the following section, you will be shaping the armhole while continuing to work the neck and collar shaping. Keep careful track of which row you are on to prevent mistakes! Beg with the next row, you will no longer be working the Sl st pattern.

### **Shape Armhole**

**Row 41:** Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts for armhole, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog (for neck), sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 25 (26, 27, 28, 29) sts.

**Row 42:** K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

**Row 43:** Bind off 2 sts, k to marker, sm, p1, M1R (for collar) k to end of row - 24 (25, 26, 27, 28) sts.

**Row 44:** Rep Row 42.

**Row 45:** K2, k2tog (for armhole), k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 23 (24, 25, 26, 27) sts.

**Row 46:** Rep Row 42.

**Row 47:** K2, k2tog (for armhole), k to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Row 48:** Rep Row 42.

**Row 49:** K2, k2tog (for armhole), k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 22 (23, 24, 25, 26) sts.

**Row 50:** Rep Row 42.

**Note:** Work the next section for your size, then proceed to ALL SIZES below.

### **Size XS ONLY**

**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 51:** K to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 23 sts.

**Row 52:** K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

**Row 53:** K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Rows 54 and 56:** Rep Row 52.

**Row 55:** K to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 24 sts.

**Rows 57-60:** Rep Rows 53-56 - 25 sts.

**Note:** Neck shaping is now complete.

**Rows 61 and 62:** Rep Rows 55 and 56 - 26 sts.

### **Sizes S (M) ONLY**

**Row 51:** K2, k2tog, k to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Row 52:** K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 53:** K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Rows 54 and 56:** Rep Row 52.

**Row 55:** K to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 24 (25) sts.

**Rows 57-60:** Rep Rows 53-56 - 25 (26) sts.

**Note:** Neck shaping is now complete.

**Rows 61 and 62:** Rep Rows 55 and 56 - 26 (27) sts.

### **Size L ONLY**

**Row 51:** K2, k2tog, k to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Row 52:** K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 53:** K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Rows 54 and 56:** Rep Row 52.

**Row 55:** K to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 26 sts.

**Rows 57-60:** Rep Rows 53-56 - 27 sts.

**Rows 61 and 62:** Rep Rows 53 and 54.

**Note:** Neck shaping is now complete.

### Size XL ONLY

**Row 51:** K2, k2tog, k to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Row 52:** K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

**Row 53:** K2, k2tog, k to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 25 sts.

**Rows 54, 56 and 58:** Rep Row 52.

**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 55:** K to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row.

**Row 57:** K to marker, sm, p1, M1R, k to end of row - 26 sts.

**Rows 59-62:** Rep Rows 55-58 - 27 sts.

### ALL SIZES

**Next Row (RS):** K to marker, sm, p1, k to end of row.

**Next Row:** K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until armhole measures 6 1/2 (7, 7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2) in. (16.5 (18, 19, 20.5, 21.5) cm), end with a WS row as your last row.

### Shape Shoulder

**Next Row (RS):** Bind off 3 sts, k to marker, sm, p1, k to end of row - 23 (23, 24, 24, 24) sts.

**Next Row:** K to marker, sm, p to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows once more - 20 (20, 21, 21, 21) sts.

**Next Row:** Bind off 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) sts, remove maker, p1, k to end of row - 18 sts rem for collar.

### Collar

**Next Row (WS):** Sl 1, k to end.

**Next Row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) times.

**Last Row:** Sl 1, k to end of row.

Bind off.

### RIGHT FRONT

Cast on 22 (23, 24, 26, 27) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K4, p1 (for buttonhole band), pm, k3 (4, 5, 6, 6), pm, work Row 1 of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, pm, k10 (10, 10, 11, 12) sts.

**Row 2:** K to first marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, k to next marker, sm, k to end of row (for buttonhole band).

**Note:** On Row 3 you will begin working buttonholes.

Each of the 3 buttonholes is worked over 3 rows.

**Row 3 (First Buttonhole Row):** K2, yo, k2tog (for buttonhole), p1, sm, k to next marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 4 (Second Buttonhole Row):** K to first marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, k2, drop yo from previous row, yo (for buttonhole), k2.

**Row 5 (Third Buttonhole Row):** K2, insert needle into yo's from previous 2 rows and k tog (buttonhole complete), k1, p1, sm, k to next marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 2.

**Row 7:** K4, p1, sm, k to next marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Rows 8 and 9:** Rep last 2 rows.

**Row 10:** Rep Row 2.

### Shape Sides

**Row 11 (RS):** K4, p1, sm, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to last st, M1L, k1 - 24 (25, 26, 28, 29) sts.

**Row 12:** P to first marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 13:** K4, p1, sm, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, skp, k to end of row.

**Row 14:** P to first marker, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 15 (Inc Row):** K4, p1, sm, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work next row of SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row - 25 (26, 27, 29, 30) sts.

**Row 16:** Rep Row 14.

**Rows 17 and 18:** Rep Rows 13 and 14 once.

**Row 19 (First Buttonhole Row):** K2, yo, k2tog, p1, sm, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row - 26 (27, 28, 30, 31) sts.

**Row 20 (Second Buttonhole Row):** P to first marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, k2, drop yo from previous row, yo, k2.

**Row 21 (Third Buttonhole Row):** K2, insert needle into yo's from previous 2 rows and k tog (buttonhole complete), k1, p1, sm, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, skp, k to end of row.

**Row 22:** Rep Row 14.

**Row 23 (Inc Row):** Rep Row 15 - 27 (28, 29, 31, 32) sts.

**Row 24:** Rep Row 14.

**Rows 25 and 26:** Rep Rows 13 and 14.

**Row 27:** K4, p1, sm, k to next marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 28:** Rep Row 14.

**Row 29-32:** Rep last 4 rows once.

**Row 33 and 34:** Rep Rows 13 and 14.

**Row 35 (First Buttonhole Row):** K2, yo, k2tog, p1, sm, k to next marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 36 (Second Buttonhole Row):** P to first marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, k2, drop yo from previous row, yo, k2.

For all sizes, piece should measure about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from beg.

### Shape Neck and Shawl Collar

**Note:** On the next row you will be completing the 3rd buttonhole and AT THE SAME TIME you will beg shaping the neck and collar.

**Row 37 (Third Buttonhole Row):** K2, insert needle into yo's from previous 2 rows and k tog (buttonhole complete), k1, M1L (for collar), p1, sm, skp (for neck), k to next marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 38:** P to first marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 39 (Inc Row):** K to 1 st before first marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to next marker, sm, work SI st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row - 28 (29, 30, 32, 33) sts.

**Row 40:** Rep Row 38, removing all markers except the buttonhole band marker.

For all sizes, piece should measure about 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm) from beg.

**Note:** Beg with the next row, you will no longer be working the SI st pattern.

**Row 41:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L (for collar) p1, sm, skp (for neck), k to end of row.

**Note:** Beginning with the following section, you will be shaping the

armhole while continuing to work the neck and collar shaping. Keep careful track of which row you are on to prevent mistakes!

### **Shape Armhole**

**Row 42:** Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, p to marker, sm, k to end of row - 25 (26, 27, 28, 29) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 43:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L (for collar), p1, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 44:** Bind off 2 sts, p to marker, sm, k to end of row - 24 (25, 26, 27, 28) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 45:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, skp, k to last 4 sts, skp (for armhole), k2 - 23 (24, 25, 26, 27) sts at the end of this row.

**Row 46:** P to marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 47:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to last 4 sts, skp (for armhole), k2.

**Rows 48 and 50:** Rep Row 46.

**Row 49:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, skp, k to last 4 sts, skp, k2 - 22 (23, 24, 25, 26) sts.

**Note:** Work the next section for your size, then proceed to ALL SIZES below.

### **XS ONLY**

**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 51 (RS):** K to 1 st before maker, M1L, p1, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 52:** P to marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 53:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, skp, k to end of row.

**Rows 54 and 56:** Rep Row 52.

**Row 55:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to end of row - 24 sts.

**Rows 57-60:** Rep Rows 53-56 - 25 sts.

**Note:** Neck shaping is now complete.

**Rows 61 and 62:** Rep Rows 55 and 56 - 26 sts.

### **Sizes S (M) ONLY**

**Row 51:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to last 4 sts, skp, k2.

**Row 52:** P to marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 53:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, skp, k to end of row.

**Rows 54 and 56:** Rep Row 52.

**Row 55:** K to 1 st before maker, M1L, p1, sm, k to end of row - 24 (25) sts.

**Rows 57-60:** Rep Rows 53-56 - 25 (26) sts.

**Note:** Neck shaping is now complete.

**Rows 61 and 62:** Rep Row 55 and 56 - 26 (27) sts.

### **Size L ONLY**

**Row 51:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to last 4 sts, skp, k2.

**Row 52:** P to marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 53:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, skp, k to end of row.

**Rows 54 and 56:** Rep Row 52.

**Row 55:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to end of row - 26 sts.

**Rows 57-60:** Rep Rows 53-56 - 27 sts.

**Rows 61 and 62:** Rep Rows 53 and 54.

**Note:** Neck shaping is now complete.

### **Size XL ONLY**

**Row 51:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to last 4 sts, skp, k2.

**Row 52:** P to marker, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 53:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, skp, k to last 4 sts, skp, k2 - 25 sts.

**Rows 54, 56 and 58:** Rep Row 52.



**Note:** Armhole shaping is now complete.

**Row 55:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, skp, k to end of row.

**Row 57:** K to 1 st before marker, M1L, p1, sm, k to end of row - 26 sts.

**Rows 59-62:** Rep Rows 55-58 - 27 sts.

#### ALL SIZES

**Next Row (RS):** K to 1 st before marker, p1, sm, k to end of row.

**Next Row:** P to marker, sm, k to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until armhole measures 6 1/2 (7, 7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2) in. (16.5 (18, 19, 20.5, 21.5) cm), end with a RS row.

#### Shape Shoulder

**Next Row (WS):** Bind off 3 sts, p to marker, sm, k to end of row - 23 (23, 24, 24, 24) sts.

**Next Row:** K to 1 st before marker, p1, sm, k to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows once more - 20 (20, 21, 21, 21) sts.

**Next Row:** Bind off 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) sts, remove marker, k to end of row - 18 sts rem for collar.

#### Collar

**Next Row (RS):** Sl 1, k to end of row.

**Next Row:** Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) times.

**Last Row:** Sl 1, k to end of row.

Bind off.

#### SLEEVES (make 2)

Cast on 23 (24, 26, 28, 30) sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K5, pm, work Row 1 of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, pm, k5 (6, 8, 10, 12), pm, work Row 1 of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, pm, k5.

**Rows 2-12:** K to first marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Row 13 (Inc Row):** K to first marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, M1R, k to next marker, M1L, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row - 25 (26, 28, 30, 32) sts.

**Row 14:** P to first marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

**Row 15:** K to first marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, work next row of Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

**Rows 16-21:** Rep last 2 rows 3 times.

**Row 22:** Rep Row 14.

**Row 23:** Rep Row 13 (Inc Row) - 27 (28, 30, 32, 34) sts.

**Rows 24-53:** Rep Rows 14-23 three more times - 33 (34, 36, 38, 40) sts.

**Row 54:** P to first marker, sm, work Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to next marker, sm, work Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, p to end of row.

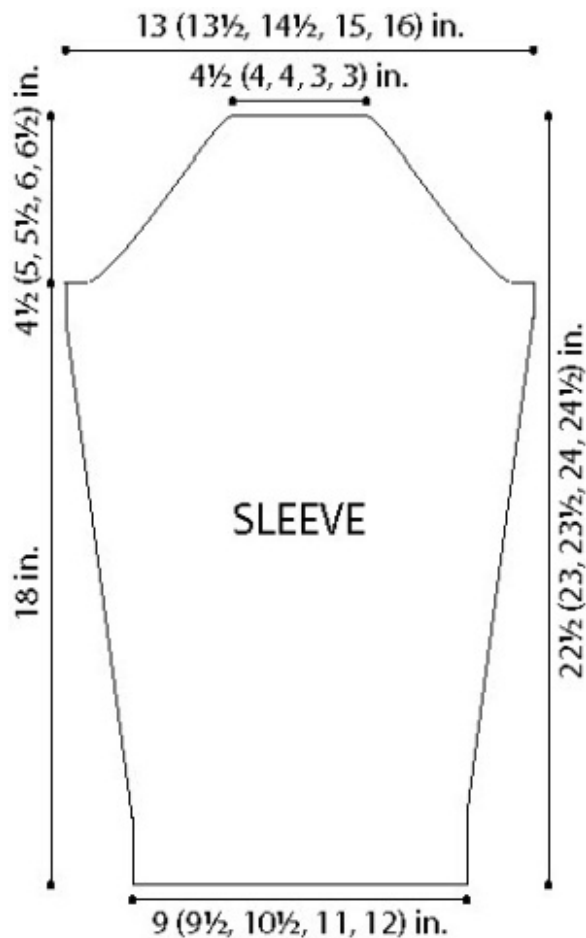
**Row 55:** K to first marker, sm, work Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to next marker, sm, work Sl st pattern over next 4 sts, sm, k to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures 18 in. (45.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as your last row, removing all markers as you work the last row.

#### Shape Sleeve Cap (top of Sleeve)

**Note:** Beg with the next row, you will no longer be working the Sl st pattern.

**Row 1 (RS):** Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, k to end of row - 30 (31, 33, 34, 36) sts.



**Row 2:** Bind off 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) sts, p to end of row - 27 (28, 30, 30, 32) sts.

**Row 3 (Dec Row):** K1, k2tog, k to last 3 sts, skp, k1 - 25 (26, 28, 28, 30) sts.

**Row 4:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 4 (5, 6, 7, 8) times - 17 (16, 16, 14, 14) sts rem.

**Next Row:** Rep Row 3 - 15 (14, 14, 12, 12) sts.

**Next Row:** P1, p2tog tbl, p to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1 - 13 (12, 12, 10, 10) sts.

**Next Row:** Rep Row 3 - 11 (10, 10, 8, 8) sts.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams. Sew bound off ends of collar together at Back neck. Lining seam of collar up with center Back neck, sew collar to neck, easing to fit. Sew in Sleeves. Sew side and Sleeve seams. With sewing needle and thread, sew buttons to buttonband, opposite buttonholes. Weave in ends.
