SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate

SIZE: One Size

Finished circumference: About 20 in. (51 cm). Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

MATERIALS

- 135-303 Lion Brand Hometown USA™ Yarn: Cambridge Tweed
1 Ball (A)
- 135-604 Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn: Cowboys
1 Ball (B)
- Brittany Birchwood Double Pointed Needles - Size 13
- Brittany Birchwood Double Pointed Needles - Size 15
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

Hometown USA® (Article #135). **Solids and Multis: 100% Acrylic
Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m)
Multis and Tweeds: 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



GAUGE:

9 sts = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd) with larger needles.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in the rnd on double pointed needles.
2. Color is changed following Stripe Sequence.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work *3 rnds with A, 6 rnds with B; repeat from * for Stripe Sequence.

HAT

With smaller needles and A, cast on 44 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles (11 sts per needle). Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Work in St st (k every rnd), changing color following Stripe Sequence until piece measures about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from beg. Change to larger needles and continue in St st and Stripe Sequence until piece measures about 12 in. (30.5 cm) from beg.

Decrease Rnd: Continuing in Stripe Sequence, (k2tog) around - 22 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
