**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 16 x 45 in. (40.5 x 114.5 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Dec 3, 2013)

1. Stole is worked back and forth in rows beg at center front.

2. Two different options are provided for fastening Stole.

#### **MATERIALS**

- 792-436 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Homespun Thick and</u> <u>Ouick Yarn: Claret</u>
   2 Balls
- <u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
   <u>Hook Size P-15 (10</u>
   mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

\*Homespun® Thick & Quick® (Article #792). 88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size: 8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins



### **GAUGE:**

 $5 \frac{1}{2} \text{ sts} + 4 \text{ rows} = \text{about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.}$ 

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**BPDC** (back post double crochet) Yarn over, insert hook from back to front then to back, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip st in front of the BPDC.

**FPDC (front post double crochet)** Yarn over, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip st behind the FPDC.

V-dc (double crochet V-stitch) Work (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st.

V-hdc (half double crochet V-stitch) Work (hdc, ch 1, hdc) in indicated st.

V-sc (single crochet V-stitch) Work (sc, ch 1, sc) in indicated st.

## NOTES:

Stole is worked back and forth in rows beg at center front.

#### **STOLE**

Ch 23.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 22 sts.

**Row 2:** Ch 2 (counts as first hdc), turn, BPDC around each of next 6 sc, FPDC around each of next 14 sc, hdc in last sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, sk first st, V-dc in next st, (sk next st, V-dc in next st) 4 times, sk next st, V-hdc in next st, (sk next st, V-sc in next st) twice, sk next st, V-hdc in next st, sk next st, V-dc in next st, sk next st, dc in top of turning ch - 10 V-sts, 1 dc at beg of row, and 1 dc at end of row.

**Row 4:** Ch 3, turn, V-dc in next ch-1 sp, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, V-sc in each of next 2 ch-1 sps, V-hdc in next ch-1 sp, V-dc in each of next 5 ch-1 sps, dc in top of turning ch.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, sc in next st (first st of first V-st), \*sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, sk last ch-1 sp, sc in next st, sc in top of turning ch.

Rep Rows 2-5 until piece measures about 45 in. (114.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 2 as your last row. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Fold top 5 in. (12.5 cm) of the Stole over.
