MOTIF 16 (make 7)
Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A and Rnds 2-4 with B. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 18 (make 3)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B and Rnds 2-4 with C. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 21 (make 2)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with C and Rnds 2-4 with B. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 24 (make 7)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with C and Rnds 2-4 with A. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 27 (make 3)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D and Rnds 2-4 with C. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 28 (make 2)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B and Rnds 2-4 with A. MOTIF 33 (make 5)
Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D and Rnds 2-4 with B. Fasten off.

## Strip 6

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 33, 24, 18 and 16 together.
Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Motif 2816 along long edge, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 45 dc evenly spaced along left side edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif 1633 - 46 dc. Fasten off.

## Strip 14

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 75, 16 and 24 together.
Row 1: From RS, join D with sl st in first st of Motif 3324 along top long edge, ch 3, work 33 dc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif 54 75-34 dc. Fasten off.

## GAUGE:

Motif $1=4 \times 8 \mathrm{in} .(10 \times 20.5 \mathrm{~cm})$
Motif $2=4 \times 4 \mathrm{in}$. $(10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm})$
When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## STITCH EXPLANATI ON:

rev sc (reverse single crochet) Single crochet worked from left to right (right to left, if left-handed). Insert hook into next stitch to the right (left), under loop on hook, and draw up a loop. Yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

## NOTES:

1. Car Coat is made from multiple different sized squares and rectangles, fitted and sewn together following a diagram.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. When necessary, fasten off old color. When appropriate, carry color not in use along WS of work.
3. Motifs are worked in joined rnds, with RS always facing. Do not turn at beg of rnds. Join with sl st at end of each rnd.

## MOTIF 1 (make 1)

With A, ch 23.
Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4 th ch from hook (beg 3 chs count as a dc) and in each ch across - 21 dc. Change to C, cut A.
Rnd 2 (RS): With C, ch 5 (beg ch counts as first dc, ch 2 on this rnd and on all following rnds), turn, 2 dc in first st, turn to work along side edge of Row 1, dc in side edge, turn to work along opposite side of foundation ch, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in first st, dc in next 19 ch along foundation ch to last ch, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2$ dc) in last st, turn to work along opposite side edge of Row 1, dc in opposite side edge, turn to work along Row 1, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc ) in first st, dc in next 19 sts, dc in same st as first st; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Cut C.

Rnd 3: Change to $A$, sl st to $\mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 5,2$ dc in same st, turn to work along short side, dc in next 5 dc to ch-2 sp, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-2 sp, turn to work along long edge, dc in next 23 dc , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp, turn to work along opposite short side, dc in next 5 dc , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch- 2 sp , dc in next 23 dc , dc in first ch-2 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch. Cut A.
Rnd 4: Change to $B$, sl st to $\mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 5,2$ dc in same st, turn to work along short side, dc in next 9 dc to ch-2 sp, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-2 sp, turn to work along long edge, dc in next 27 dc ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next ch-2 sp, turn to work along opposite short side, dc in next 9 dc , ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in next $\mathrm{ch}-2 \mathrm{sp}$, dc in next 27 dc , dc in first ch-2 sp; join with sl st in top of beg ch.
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 2 (make 1)

With D, ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: Work 12 sc in ring, sl st in first sc to join - 12 sC .
Rnd 2: Change to C , ch 3 (beg ch counts as first dc on this rnd and on all the rnds of this pattern), dc in same st, 2 dc in each st around, sl st in top of beg ch - 24 dC .
Rnd 3: Change to D, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 2 dc, *ch 3, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 3, sk next dc, sc in next 3 dc; rep from * twice, ch 3 , sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 3 , sk next dc, sl st in first sC.
Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, * 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in ch-3 sp, ( $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$, sc) in next dc, 3 sc in ch- 3 sp , sc in next 3 sc ; rep from * twice, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, ( $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next dc, 3 sc in ch-3 sp ; join with sl st in first sc - $44 \mathrm{sc} ; 11 \mathrm{sc}$ on each side.
Rnd 5: Change to $C$, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next sc and in each sc to ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 sp, * dc in each sc to $\mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{sp},(\mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{dc}$ ) in ch-1 sp; rep from * twice, dc in each sc to end; join with sl st in top of beg-ch - 52 dc .
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 3 (make 2)

With $D$, ch 5 ; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 15 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3-16 dc.
Rnd 2: Change to $C$, ch 1 , sc in same st, *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last st, 2 sc in last st; join with sl st in top of first sc - 24 sc .
Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts, *ch 3, sk next st, dc in next st, ch 3, sk next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * twice, ch 3, sk next st, dc in next st, ch 3, sk next st; join with sl st in first sC.
Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same st and in next $2 \mathrm{sc}, * 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in ch-3 sp, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next dc, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 sc ; rep from * twice, 3 sc in ch- 3 sp , ( $\mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1, \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next dc, 3 sc in ch- 3 sp ; join with sl st in first sc - $44 \mathrm{sc}, 11 \mathrm{sc}$ on each side.
Rnd 5: Change to $\mathrm{B}, \mathrm{ch} 3, * \mathrm{dc}$ in each sc to $\mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{sp}$, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 sp; rep from * twice, dc in each sc to first st; join with sl st in first sc - 52 dc .
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 4 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with B and working Rnds 1-2 with B, Rnds 3-4 with D and Rnd 5 with A.
MOTIF 5 (make 5)
Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-4 with A and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 6 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3 through Rnd 4, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnds 2-4 with C. Fasten off.
Row 5: Join D in first sc after ch-1 sp along one top edge, ch 3, dc in each sc across to next ch-1 sp-13 dc. Cut D.

Row 6: Change to $A$, ch 3, turn, dc in each dc across to next ch-1 sp - 13 dc. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 7 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnds 1-2 with D and Rnds 3-5 with C.

## MOTIF 8 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-4 with B and Rnd 5 with A.

## MOTIF 9 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-4 with C and Rnd 5 with A.

## MOTIF 10 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnds 1-2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with C and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 11 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 1, beg with C and working Row 1 with C, Rnd 2 with B, Rnd 3 with C and Rnd 4 with A.

## MOTIF 12 (make 1)

With $D$, ch 5 ; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: Work 12 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc - 12 sc .
Rnd 2: Change to $B$, ch 3, dc in same st, 2 dc in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 24 dC .
Rnd 3: Change to $D$, ch 3,2 dc in next st, $* d c$ in next st, 2 dc in next st; rep from $*$ around; join with sl st in top of beg ch - 36 dc .
Rnd 4: Change to $A$, ch 1 , sc in same st, *sc in next 2 sts, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, tr in next st, ch 1 , ( tr , ch 2 , tr ) in center of leg of same tr, ch 1, tr in beg of leg of same tr, ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * twice, sc in next 2 sts, dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st, tr in next st, ch 1, (tr, ch 2 , tr) in center of leg of same tr, ch 1, tr in beg of leg of same tr, ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st, sc in last st; join with sl st in first sC.
Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same st, *sc in next 3 sts, ( sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next tr) twice, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next ch-2 sp, ( $s c$ in next tr, sc in ch-1 sp) twice, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * twice, sc in next 3 sts, ( $s c$ in ch-1 sp, sc in next tr) twice, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next ch-2 sp, ( sc in next tr, sc in ch-1 sp) twice, sc in next 2 sts; join with sl st in first sc - 64 sc ; 16 sc along each side.
Fasten off.
Note: Next 6 rows are worked along 2 sides of Motif only, turning at beg of each row.
Row 6: From RS, join A with sl st in first sc after any ch-1 sp, ch 3, dc in each dc to next ch-1 sp, ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in corner ch-1 sp, dc in each dc along second side to ch-1 sp, leave rem ch-1 sps and sts unworked - $36 \mathrm{dc} ; 18 \mathrm{dc}$ along each side.
Row 7: Change to $C$, ch 3, turn, dc in next dc and in each dc to ch-2 sp, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in corner ch-2 sp , dc in each dc along second side - 40 dc ; 20 dc along each side.
Row 8: Change to $B$, ch 3, turn, dc in each dc to ch-2 sp, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in corner ch-2 sp, dc in each dc along second side - $44 \mathrm{dc} ; 22 \mathrm{dc}$ along each side.
Row 9: Change to $C$ and rep Row $8-48 \mathrm{dc} ; 24$ dc along each side.
Row 10: Change to $B$ and rep Row $8-52 \mathrm{dc} ; 26$ dc along each side.
Row 11: Change to $A$ and rep Row 8 - 56 dc; 28 dc along each side.
Note: Last Rnd will go around entire Motif.
Rnd 12: Ch $3, *$ dc in each dc to ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in corner ch-2 sp ; rep from * to last st of second side, ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in last st, turn to work along unworked side edge, dc 28 sts evenly spaced to next corner, ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in corner, dc 28 sts evenly spaced along last side to first st, ( 2 dc , ch 2, dc in same st as first st - $128 \mathrm{dc} ; 32 \mathrm{dc}$ along each side.
Fasten off.
MOTIF 13 (make 6)
Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-4 with A and Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 14 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with C and working Rnds 1-2 with C, Rnds $3-4$ with D and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 15 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with C, Rnd 2 with D and Rnds 3-5 with C.

## MOTIF 16 (make 7)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A and Rnds 2-4 with B.
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 17 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with B, Rnds $4-5$ with D, Rows 6-7 with C, Row 8 with B, Row 9 with A, Row 10 with B, Row 11 with C and Rnd 12 with C.

MOTIF 18 (make 3) Work as for Rnds $1-4$ of Motif 3, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B and Rnds 2-4
with C.
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 19 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with A and working Rnds 1-2 with A, Rnds $3-4$ with $D$ and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 20 (make 3)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with A and Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 21 (make 2)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with $C$ and Rnds 2-4 with B.
Fasten off.
MOTIF 22 (make 1)
Work as for Motif 12, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with C, Rnds $4-5$ with B, Rows 6-7 with A, Row 8 with C, Row 9 with B, Row 10 with D, Row 11 with C and Rnd 12 with C.

## MOTIF 23 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnds 1-2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with A and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 24 (make 7)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with C and Rnds 2-4 with A. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 25 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A, Rnd 2 with D and Rnds $3-5$ with A.

## MOTIF 26 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with C, Rnds $3-4$ with D and Rnd 5 with A.

## MOTIF 27 (make 3)

Work as for Rnds $1-4$ of Motif 3 , beg with $D$ and working Rnd 1 with $D$ and Rnds $2-4$ with $C$. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 28 (make 2)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with $B$ and Rnds 2-4 with A.

## MOTIF 29 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with A and working Rnds 1-2 with A, Rnds 3-4 with D and Rnd 5 with A.

## MOTIF 30 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with C, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with C and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 31 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 1, beg with A and working Row 1 with A, Rnd 2 with $C$ and Rnds $3-4$ with $B$.

## MOTIF 32 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with A, Rnd 3 with D, Rnds 4-5 with B, Row 6 with C, Rows $7-8$ with A, Row 9 with D, Row 10 with C, Row 11 with A and Rnd 12 with A.

## MOTIF 33 (make 5)

Work as for Rnds 1-4 of Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D and Rnds 2-4 with B. Fasten off.

## MOTIF 34 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with $D$ and working Rnd 1 with $D$ and Rnds 2-5 with $A$.

Work as for Motif 1, beg with A and working Row 1 with A, Rnd 2 with B, Rnd 3 with A and Rnd 4 with C.

## MOTIF 36 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with A, Rnd 3 with C, Rnds 4-5 with D, Row 6 with B, Row 7 with A, Rows $8-9$ with B, Row 10 with C, Row 11 with B and Rnd 12 with B.

## MOTIF 37 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with B and working Rnds 1-2 with B, Rnds $3-4$ with D and Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 38 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 1, beg with B and working Row 1 with B, Rnd 2 with C, Rnd 3 with B and Rnd 4 with A.

## MOTIF 39 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with C and working Rnds 1-2 with C, Rnd 3 with D, Rnds $4-5$ with B, Rows 6-7 with A, Row 8 with B, Row 9 with D, Rows $10-11$ with C and Rnd 12 with C.

## MOTIF 40 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-4 with B and Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 41 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnds 1-2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with A and Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 42 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds 3-5 with A.

## MOTIF 43 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with B, Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 44 (make 3)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with A and working Rnds 1-2 with A, Rnds 3-4 with D, Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 45 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with B, Rnds $3-4$ with D, Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 46 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnds 2-4 with A.

## MOTIF 47 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnds 1-2 with D, Rnds $3-5$ with A.

## MOTIF 48 (make 3)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnds 2-5 with A.

## MOTIF 49 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with C and working Rnds 1-2 with C, Rnd 3 with D, Rnds $4-5$ with A, Row 6 with B, Row 7 with D, Rows $8-9$ with B, Row 10 with C, Row 11 with B and Rnd 12 with B.

## MOTIF 50 (make 1)

With $B$, ch 5 ; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.
Rnd 1: Ch 3, work 7 dc in ring; join with sl st in first sc - 8 dc.
Row 2: Change to A, ch 1, turn, (sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 4 times - 12 sc .
Row 3: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), turn, sk first st, sc in next 3 sc, ch 3 , sk next sc, dc in next sc, ch 3 , sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 3, sk next sc, dc in last sc.
Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in same st, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next dc, 3 sc in ch-3 sp, sc in next $3 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in ch-3 sp, sc in $3 r d$ ch of beg ch- 6.
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 51 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with C and working Rnds $1-2$ with C, Rnds $3-4$ with D, Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 52 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with A, Rnds $3-4$ with D.

## MOTIF 53 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-4 with A.

## MOTIF 54 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A, Rnds 2-4 with C.

## MOTIF 55 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 1, beg with C and working Row 1 with C, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with C and Rnd 4 with A.

## MOTIF 56 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with A, Rnds $3-4$ with D, Rnd 5 with A.

## MOTIF 57 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with C and working Rnds 1-2 with C, Rnds $3-4$ with D, Rnd 5 with A.

## MOTIF 58 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with C, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with C, Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 59 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 1, beg with B and working Row 1 with B, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with B and Rnd 4 with C.

## MOTIF 60 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with B, Rnd 3 with C, Rnds 4-5 with D, Rows 6-7 with A, Row 8 with C, Row 9 with B, Row 10 with C, Row 11 with A and Rnd 12 with A.

## MOTIF 61 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with B and working Rnds 1-2 with B, Rnds 3-4 with D and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 62 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with C and working Rnd 1 with C, Rnds 2-5 with A.
MOTIF 63 (make 1)
Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-5 with C.

## MOTIF 64 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with C, Rnd 3 with A, Rnds 4-5 with D, Rows $6-7$ with B, Row 8 with C, Row 9 with A, Row 10 with C, Row 11 with B and Rnd 12 with B.

## MOTIF 65 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with A, Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 66 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 50, beg with A and working Rnd 1 with A, Rnds 2-4 with B.

## MOTIF 67 (make 2)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds $3-4$ with B, Rnd 5 with A.

## MOTIF 68 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 1, beg with C and working Row 1 with C, Rnd 2 with B, Rnd 3 with C, Rnd 4 with A.

## MOTIF 69 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnd 2 with A, Rnds $3-4$ with D, Rnd 5 with A.
MOTIF 70 (make 1)
Work as for Motif 2, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with D, Rnds $3-5$ with B.

## MOTIF 71 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 1 , beg with A and working Row 1 with A, Rnd 2 with B, Rnds $3-4$ with C.

## MOTIF 72 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnds 1-2 with D, Rnds 3-5 with B.

## MOTIF 73 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnd 2 with D, Rnd 3 with B, Rnds 4-5 with D, Rows 6-7 with C, Row 8 with B, Row 9 with A, Row 10 with B, Row 11 with C and Rnd 12 with C.

## MOTIF 74 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D, Rnds 2-4 with C and Rnd 5 with B.

## MOTIF 75 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3, beg with D and working Rnd 1 with D and Rnds 2-4 with C.
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 76 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 1, beg with A and working Row 1 with A, Rnd 2 with C, Rnd 3 with A and Rnd 4 with B.

## MOTIF 77 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 2, beg with D and working Rnds 1-2 with D, Rnds 3-4 with B and Rnd 5 with C.

## MOTIF 78 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 3 through Rnd 4, beg with B and working Rnd 1 with B, Rnds $2-4$ with C.
Fasten off.
Row 5: J oin $D$ in first sc after any ch-1 $s p$, ch 3, dc in each sc to next ch-1 sp-13 dc. Cut D.
Row 6: Change to A, turn, ch 3, dc in each dc across - 13 dc .
Fasten off.
Row 7: Change to B, turn, ch 3, dc in each dc across - 13 dc .
Fasten off.

## MOTIF 79 (make 1)

Work as for Motif 12, beg with B and working Rnds 1-2 with B, Rnds $3-4$ with D, Rnd 5 with A.
Rnd 6: Change to $C$, ch 3 (counts as first dc), *dc in each sc to ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 sp; rep from * 3 times, dc in each sc to end; join with sl st in top of beg-ch - 72 dc ; 18 dc each side.

Rnd 7: Change to $B$, ch 3 (counts as first dc), *dc in each st to ch-2 sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 sp; rep from * 3 times, dc in each st to end; join with sl st in top of beg ch $-80 \mathrm{dc} ; 20 \mathrm{dc}$ each side.

Note: Next 5 rows are worked along 2 sides of Motif only, turning at beg of each row.
Row 7: From RS, join A with sl st in first dc after any ch- 2 sp , ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each dc to ch-2 sp, ( 2 dc , ch $2,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in corner ch-2 sp, dc in each dc along second side to next ch-2 space - 44 dc ; 22 dc along each side.
Row 8: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each dc to ch-2 sp, ( 2 dc , ch 2, 2 dc ) in corner ch-2 sp, dc in each dc along second side - $48 \mathrm{dc} ; 24 \mathrm{dc}$ along each side.
Row 9: Rep Row 8 - 52 dc; 26 dc along each side.
Row 10: Change to $C$ and rep Row 8 - $56 \mathrm{dc} ; 28 \mathrm{dc}$ along each side.
Row 11: Rep Row 8 - $60 \mathrm{dc} ; 30 \mathrm{dc}$ along each side. Fasten off.

## Strip 1

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 4 and 17 together.
Row 1: From RS, join D with sl st in first st along left side of Motif 17, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 45 dc evenly spaced along left side edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif $4-46$ dc. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join C with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

Strip 2
Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 8 and 10 together.

Row 1: From RS, join C with sl st in first st along right side of Motif 10, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 25 dc evenly spaced along right side edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif 4-26 dc. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join D with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 3

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 17 and 34 together.
Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st along right side of Motif 17, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 45 dc evenly spaced along right side edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif $34-46$ dc. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join D with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 4

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 21, 27, 24 and 33 together.
Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st along left side of Motif 33, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 45 dc evenly spaced along left side edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif 21 - 46 dc. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 5

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 28, 27 and 16 together.
Row 1: From RS, join C with sl st in first st of Motif 28 along top long edge, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 33 dc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif $16-34 \mathrm{dc}$. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 6

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 33, 24, 18 and 16 together.
Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Motif 16 along long edge, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 45 dc evenly spaced along left side edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif 33-46 dc. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join C with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 7

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 46, 27 and 16 together.
Row 1: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Motif 16 along lower long edge, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 33 dc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif $46-34 \mathrm{dc}$. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 8

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 52, 28, 24 and 16 together.
Row 1: From RS, join D with sl st in first st of Motif 16 along lower long edge, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 45 dc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif $52-46 \mathrm{dc}$. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 9

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 21,53 and 54 together.
Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st along right side of Motif 21, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 33 dc evenly spaced along right side edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif $54-34 \mathrm{dc}$. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join D with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 10

## Shape Right Shoulder

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 38 and 49 together.
Row 1: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Motif 38 along top edge, ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 23 dc, 5 hdc, 5 sc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs to last 12 sts of Motif 49, leave rem sts
unworked - 34 sts. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 14 dc, hdc in next 5 sts, sc in next 4 sts, leave rem 10 sts unworked - 24 sts. Fasten off.
Row 3: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Row 2, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 7 sts, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 4 sts, leave rem 8 sts unworked - 16 sts. Fasten off.
Row 4: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Row 3, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next st, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, leave rem 8 sts unworked - 8 sts. Fasten off.
Row 5: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Row 4, ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 7 sts, hdc in next 10 sts, sc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 11

## Shape Back Shoulders

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 55, 56, 58, 59, 60, 61 and second Motif 58 together.
Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Motif 56 along top edge, ch 1, work 7 sc, 7 hdc, 82 dc, 7 hdc, 7 sc evenly spaced across to last st of Motif 61 - 110 sts. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, sk first 12 sc of Row 1, join B with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 5 sc, hdc in next 5 sts, dc in next 64 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, sc in next 6 sts, leave rem 12 sts unworked - 86 sts. Fasten off.
Row 3: From RS, sk first 7 sc of Row 2, join A with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 4 sts, dc in next 58 dc, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 3 sts, leave rem sts unworked - 72 sts. Fasten off.
Row 4: From RS, sk first 8 sts of Row 3, join B with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 3 sc, hdc in next 4 sts, dc in next 40 sts, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 4 sts, leave rem sts unworked - 56 sts. Fasten off.
Row 5: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 1, sc in next 21 sts, hdc in next 20 sts, dc in next 28 sts, hdc in next 20 sts, sc in next 21 sts - 110 sts.
Fasten off.

## Strip 12

## Shape Left Shoulder

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 63 and 65 together.
Row 1: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Motif 63 along top long edge, ch 1, sc in same st, work 4 sc, 5 hdc, 24 dc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs - 34 sts. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, sk first 10 sts of Row 1, join A with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 5 sts, dc in next 15 dc - 24 sts. Fasten off.
Row 3: From RS, sk first 8 sts of Row 2, join B with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 4 sts, dc in next 8 sts - 16 sts. Fasten off.
Row 4: From RS, sk first 8 sts of Row 3, join A with sl st in next st, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 2 sts - 8 sts rem. Fasten off.
Row 5: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 1, sc in same st, sc in next 15 sts, hdc in next 10 sts, dc in next 8 sts. Fasten off.

## Strip 13

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 54, 24 and 33 together.
Row 1: From RS, join B with sl st in first st of Motif 33 along lower long edge, ch 3, work 33 dc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif 54-34 dc. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3, dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.

## Strip 14

Using matching yarn and following assembly diagram, sew Motifs 75, 16 and 24 together.
Row 1: From RS, join D with sl st in first st of Motif 24 along top long edge, ch 3, work 33 dc evenly spaced along long edge of joined motifs, end at last st of Motif $75-34 \mathrm{dc}$. Fasten off.
Row 2: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Row 1, ch 3, dc in each dc to end of row. Fasten off.
Following diagram, sew motifs together to form Body, Sleeve and Collar pieces. Sew shoulder seams. Sew Sleeve in Armholes, fitting Motif 73 of Left Sleeve into empty space on Left Front.

## Coat Edging

Row 1: From WS, join B with sl st in first st at front neck edge of Right Front, ch 1, sc evenly spaced down front edge to lower edge, work 3 sc in last st, turn to work along lower edge, sc evenly spaced along lower edge to Left Front, turn to work along front edge of Left Front, work 3 sc in first st, sc evenly spaced along front edge to neck edge.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each sc to end of row, working ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each corner sc. Cut B.
Row 3: Change to A, ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to end of row, working 3 sc in each corner $\mathrm{ch}-1 \mathrm{sp}$.
Row 4: Rep Row 2.
Row 5: Rep Row 3.
Row 6: With A, work in rev sc in each st to end of row.
Fasten off.

## Collar Stand

Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Motif 50 at lower diagonal edge, ch 1, work 110 sc evenly spaced around neck opening to last st of opposite Motif 66-110 sts.
Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 12 sc , sc in each sc to last 12 sts, leave rem 12 sts unworked - 86 sts.
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 7 sc , ch 1 , sc in each st to last 7 sts , leave rem sts unworked to end of row - 72 sts.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 8 sts, ch 1, sc in each st to last 8 sts, leave rem sts unworked - 56 sts.
Row 5: Ch 1, sl st in first 14 sts, ch 1, sc in each st to last 14 sts, leave rem sts unworked - 28 sts. Fasten off.

With RS of Collar facing WS of Coat so RS will show on RS when Collar is folded over, sew Collar around neck of Coat with collar stand on outside.

## Collar Edging

Row 1: From RS, join A with sl st in first st of Collar at front neck edge of Left Front, ch 1, sc evenly spaced along front edge to long edge, work 3 sc in last st, turn to work along long edge, sc evenly spaced along edge, turn to work along front edge of Collar, work 3 sc in first st, sc evenly spaced along front edge to neck edge.
Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each sc to end of row, working ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) in each corner sc.
Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc to end of row, working 3 sc in each corner ch-1 sp.
Row 4: Work in rev sc in each st to end of row.
Fasten off.
Sew 5 corresponding sides of snaps evenly spaced along front edges of Coat Edging with first at neck edge and last 9 in . $(23 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) from lower edge.
Weave in ends.
