

Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Heartland Thick & Quick® Capelet and Hat Pattern Number: L32235



Knit this capelet and hat in Heartland Thick & Quick® for a soft and comfy set to wear on a cool spring morning on your way to work or class.

SKILL LEVEL – Easy+

SIZES

One Size

Capelet

Finished Circumference About 40 in. (101.5 cm) at lower edge Finished Length About 11 1/2 in. (29 cm)

Hat

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes. **Finished Length** About 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland Thick & Quick® (Art. #137)
 - 174 Joshua Tree 3 balls
- Brittany Birchwood double pointed needles size 11
- Lion Brand® circular knitting needles size 11 (8 mm)
- Lion Brand® stitch markers
- Lion Brand® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

10 sts + 16 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds (over an even number of sts)

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd. Rep Rnd 1 for K1, p1 rib worked in rnds. Note: The following corrections have been incorporated into the pattern below. We are highlighting the corrections separately here so that if you have printed out an earlier version of the pattern you'll know what was changed.

CORRECTIONS (applied June 7th, 2018)

HAT

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Shape Crown (top of Hat)

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P1, p2tog, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, p1, p2tog, p1 – 43 sts at the end of this rnd.

Purl one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P1, p2tog, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, p2tog – 24 34 sts.

Purl one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd): *P1, p2tog, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2tog – 25 sts. Purl one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P1, k2tog; rep from * around to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2tog – 16 sts.

Work in K1, p1 rib for one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P2 tog; rep from * around – 8 sts.

Purl one rnd.

HAT

With double pointed needles, cast on 52 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles with 13 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts. **Rnds 1-6:** Work in K1, p1 rib worked in rnds.

Rnds 7-12: Purl.

Rnds 13 and 14: Work in K1, p1 rib worked in rnds.

Rnds 15-22: Rep Rnds 7-14. Shape Crown (top of Hat)

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P1, p2tog, p3; rep from * to last 4 sts, p1, p2tog, p1 – 43 sts at the end of this rnd.

Purl one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P1, p2tog, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, p1, p2tog – 34 sts. Purl one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd): *P1, p2tog, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2tog – 25 sts. Purl one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P1, k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, p2tog, k2tog – 16 sts. Work in K1, p1 rib for one rnd.

Next (Decrease) Rnd: *P2 tog; rep from * around – 8 sts.

Purl one rnd.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail through remaining sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

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FINISHING

Weave in ends.

CAPELET

Notes

- 1. Body of Capelet is worked as a flat rectangle, back and forth in rows on circular needle.
- 2. The rectangle is seamed to make a tube, then sts are picked up and worked along one edge for lower edge and along opposite edge for collar.

Body

With circular needle, cast on 20 sts.

Row 1 (RS): P2, k1, p14, k1, p2.

Row 2: K2, p1, k14, p1, k2.

Row 3: P2, k1 through back loop, p14, k1 through back loop, p2.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beg. Bind off all sts in pattern.

Sew cast-on and bound-off ends together.

Lower Edge

From RS, with circular needle, pick up and k 94 sts evenly spaced along one long edge of seamed Capelet. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts. **Rnds 1-6:** Work in K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds.

Bind off in rib.

Collar

From RS, with circular needle and beg 5 in. (13 cm) from seam on opposite long edge of Capelet, pick up and k 63 sts evenly spaced around.

Do not join, work back and forth in rows on circular needle.

Row 1: Sl 1, *p1, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Row 2: Sl 1, k the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 until collar measures about 6 in. (15 cm).

Bind off in pattern.

FINISHING

Sew ends of collar together for about 1 in. (2.5 cm), beg at neck edge. Weave in ends.

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ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)
dec = decreas(e)(s)(ing)
k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
p = purl
p2tog = purl 2 together
rep = repeat(s)(ing)
rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = right side
sl = slip
st(s) = stitch(es)
WS = wrong side
