**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size:

Solids: 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)

**Vanna's Palettes (Article #865). 100% Acrylic; package size: 0.35oz/10.00 gr. (17yds/16m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

11 sc + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stripe pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

picot Ch 3, sl st in 3rd ch from hook.

NOTES:

1. Poncho is worked from top to lower edge.

2. Rnds 1-19 are turned; remaining rnds are not turned.
3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Proceed with new color.

PONCHO

With A, ch 80, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring, being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1(RS): Ch 1, turn, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc – 80 sc.

Rnd 2 (Crossed DC): Ch 3 (counts as dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), turn, working in front of beg ch-3 just made, dc in st before joining (first crossed-dc made); * sk 1 st, dc in next st, dc in sk st; rep from * around, join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 40 crossed dc at the end of this rnd.

Change to J.

Rnd 3 (Increase Rnd): With J, ch 1, turn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 7 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 90 sc.

Rnd 4: Rep Rnd 2 – 45 crossed dc.

Change to I.

Rnd 5 (Increase Rnd): With I, ch 1, turn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 8 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 100 sc.

Rnd 6: Rep Rnd 2 – 50 crossed dc.

Change to H.

Rnd 7 (Increase Rnd): With H, ch 1, turn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 9 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 110 sc.

Rnd 8: Rep Rnd 2 – 55 crossed dc.

Change to G.

Rnd 9 (Increase Rnd): With G, ch 1, turn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 10 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 120 sc.

Rnd 10: Rep Rnd 2 – 60 crossed dc.

Change to F.

Rnd 11 (Increase Rnd): With F, ch 1, turn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 11 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 130 sc.

Rnd 12: Rep Rnd 2 – 65 crossed dc.

Change to E.

Rnd 13 (Increase Rnd): With E, ch 1, turn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 12 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 140 sc.

Change to D.

Rnd 14: With D, rep Rnd 2 – 70 crossed dc.

Change to E.

Rnd 15 (Increase Rnd): With E, ch 1, turn, *2 sc in next st, sc in next 13 sts; rep from * around; join with sl st in first sc – 150 sc.

Change to C.

Rnd 16: With C, rep Rnd 2 – 75 crossed-dc.

Change to E.

Rnd 17: With E, rep Rnd 1, join with sl st in first sc.

Change to A.

Rnd 18: With A, rep Rnd 2.

Rnd 19: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 50 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 74 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each st to end

of rnd; join with sl st in first sc – 152 sc.

Note: Work continues with A only and in continuous rnds, do not turn at end of rnd.

Rnd 20: Ch 3, (dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in same st, ch 2, sk 1 st, sc in next st, *ch 2, sk next st, (2dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in next st, ch 2, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from * to last st, ch 2, sk last st; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 21: Sl st into next ch-1 sp, (sc, ch 3, sc) in same ch-1 sp, *ch 5, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-1 sp; rep from * around, ch 5; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 22: Sl st in next ch-3 sp, (ch 3, dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in same ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, *ch 2, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * around, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnds 23-30: Rep last 2 rnds 4 more times.

Rnd 31: Rep Rnd 21.

Rnd 32: Sl st in next ch-3 sp, (ch 3, 2 dc, picot, 3 dc) in same ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, *ch 2, (3dc, picot, 3dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * around, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
