Finished Bust 36 (38, 40, 43) in. (91.5 (96.5, 101.5, 109) cm)

Finished Length 22 (22 1/2, 25, 26) in. (56 (57, 63.5, 66) cm), from back neck

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

GAUGE:

1 Granny Square for sizes S and M = 11 x 11 in. (28 x 28 cm) square.

1 Granny Square for sizes L and 1X = 12 x 12 in. (30.5 x 30.5 cm) square.

14 sts + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in (3-dc, ch 1) pattern.

16 sts + 22 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) using larger knitting needles.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a

smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop - 1 st increased.

sk2p Slip 1 as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over - 2 sts decreased.

PATTERN STITCHES

K1, p1 Rib worked in rows (over an odd number of sts)

Row 1: P1, *k1, p1; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for K1, p1 Rib worked in rows.

K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds (over an even number of sts)

Rnd 1: *K1, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep Rnd 1 for K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds.

NOTES:

1. Pullover is worked in 4 pieces: Front, Back, and 2 Sleeves.
2. Front of Pullover is made by first crocheting a Granny Square.
3. Front is shaped by crocheting around outside edges of the Granny Square, then ribbing is worked along lower edge.
4. Back and Sleeves are worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

COLORS FOR VANNA'S PALETTES

Burgundy (C)

Nutmeg (D)

Rust (E)

Teal (F)

Fuchsia (G)

Pink (H)

Brown (I)

Red (J)

COLOR SEQUENCE FOR GRANNY SQUARE

Work *1 rnd with C, 1 rnd with D, 1 rnd with E, 1 rnd with F, 1 rnd with G, 1 rnd with A, 1 rnd with H, 1 rnd with I, and 1 rnd with J; rep from * as needed for Color Sequence.

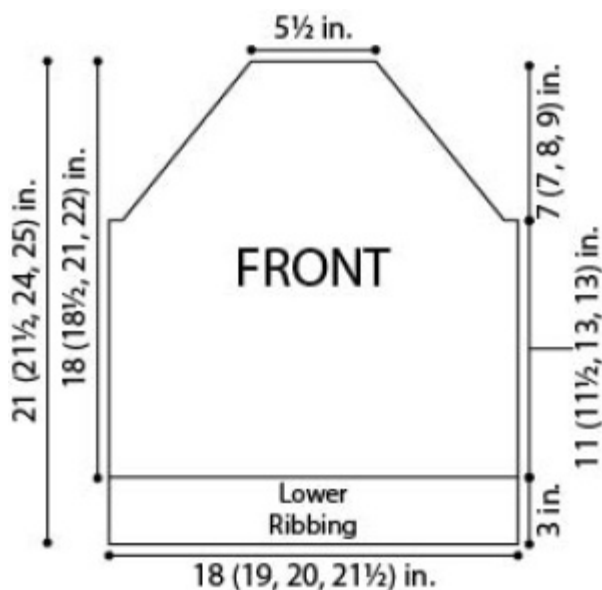
FRONT

Granny Square

With C, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and in all following rnds), 2 dc in ring, (ch 2, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 12 dc (four 3-dc groups) and 4 ch-2 sps. Fasten off C.

Rnd 2: From RS, join D with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp (first corner made), *ch 1, (3



dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 24 dc (eight 3-dc groups), 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 4 ch-1 sps. Fasten off D.

Rnd 3: From RS, join E with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 36 dc (twelve 3-dc groups), 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 8 ch-1 sps. Fasten off E.

Rnd 4: From RS, join F with sl st in any corner ch-2 sp, ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch – 48 dc (sixteen 3-dc groups), 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 12 ch-1 sps. Fasten off F.

Rnds 5-9 (9, 10, 10): Rep Rnd 4 and continue to change color as in Color Sequence – 108 (108, 120, 120) dc (36 (36, 40, 40) 3-dc groups), 4 corner ch-2 sps, and 32 (32, 36, 36) ch-1 sps at the end of Row 9 (9, 10, 10). Fasten off.

Shape Top of Front

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join next color with sl st in first ch-1 sp following any corner ch-2 sp of Granny Square, ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across to next corner ch-2 sp; leave corner ch-2 sp and rem sts unworked – 8 (8, 9, 9) 3-dc groups and 7 (7, 8, 8) ch-1 sps. Fasten off. Place a marker in the corner ch-2 sp at beg and at end of this row.

Rows 2-4 (4, 5, 5): From RS, join next color with sl st in first ch-1 sp of previous row, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across – Five 3-dc groups and 4 ch-1 sps at the end of Row 4 (4, 5, 5).

Even Edges: From RS, join A with sl st in first dc following first marked ch-2 sp, sc in same st, remove marker; working up side edge of top, *ch 2, sc in first dc of first 3-dc group at beg of next row; rep from * to top; working across top edge, **ch 2, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** to last 3-dc group of top edge, ch 2, sc in last dc of last 3-dc group; working down other side edge of top, ***ch 2, sc in last dc of last 3-dc group at end of next row; rep from *** to marked corner ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in last dc before marked corner ch-2 sp, do not remove marker. Fasten off.

Shape Side and Lower Edge of Front

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join same color as used for Row 1 of Shape Top with sl st in first ch-1 sp following rem marked corner ch-2 sp, remove marker, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from * once more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp; leave corner ch-2 sp unworked – 28 (28, 31, 31) 3-dc groups, 2 corner ch-2 sps, and 25 (25, 28, 28) ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Rows 2-6 (6, 6, 7): From RS, join next color with sl st in first ch-1 sp of previous row, ch 3, 2 dc in same ch-1 sp,

*(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from * once more, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to end – 33 (33, 36, 37) 3-dc groups, 2 corner ch-2 sps, and 30 (30, 33, 34) ch-1 sps at the end of Row 6 (6, 6, 7). Fasten off.

Shape Sides/Underarms and Lower Edge of Front

Row 7 (7, 7, 8): From RS, join A with sl st in first dc of previous row, ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, *(dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next 3 dc) to next corner ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from * once more, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next 3 dc) to end – 137 (137, 149, 153) dc and 2 corner ch-2 sps. Fasten off.

Next 0 (1, 1, 1) Rows: From RS, join A with sl st in first dc of previous row, ch 3, *dc in each dc across to next corner ch-2 sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from * once more, dc in each dc to end – 137 (145, 157, 161) dc and 2 corner ch-2 sps. Fasten off. **Note:** When you see '0' repeats in an instruction, this means that you should not perform that particular instruction, just skip to the next part of the instruction.

Finish lower edge of Front

Row 1 (RS): From RS, join A with sl st in corner ch-2 sp at beg of lower edge, ch 3, dc in next dc, dc2tog, *dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog; rep from * across to next corner ch-2 sp – 48 (51, 54, 57) sts. Fasten off.

Lower Ribbing

From WS (to create a ridge on the RS) with smaller knitting needles and A, pick up and k 51 (54, 57, 62) sts evenly spaced across lower edge.

Row 1 (RS): *P1, k1, (p1, k1) in next st; rep from * 15 (16, 17, 18) more times, p1, **k1, p1; rep from ** to end of row – 67 (71, 75, 81) sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib worked in rows for 3 in. (7.5 cm).

Bind off loosely in rib.

BACK

Note: Rib at lower edge is worked after Back has been completed.

Beg at lower edge, with larger needles and A, cast on 64 (68, 72, 78) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Increase Row: K1, M1, k to last st, M1, k1 – 66 (70, 74, 80) sts.

Work even in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 3 rows.

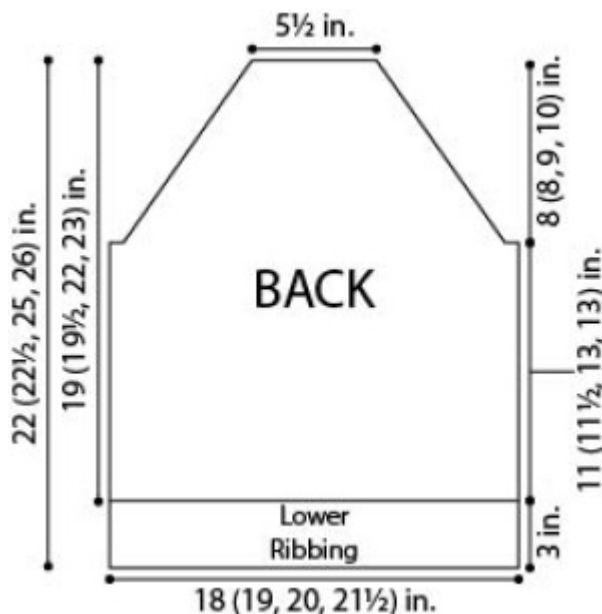
Rep Increase Row – 68 (72, 76, 82) sts.

Rep last 4 rows 2 more times 72 (76, 80, 86) sts.

Work even in St st until piece measures same as Front from just above lower ribbing of Front to underarms, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Raglan Armholes

Row 1 (RS): Bind off 3 (5, 5, 5) sts, k to end of row – 69 (71, 75, 81) sts.



Row 2: Bind off 3 (5, 5, 5) sts, p to end of row – 66 (66, 70, 76) sts.

Row 3: Bind off 2 (2, 2, 3) sts, k to end of row – 64 (64, 68, 73) sts.

Row 4: Bind off 2 (2, 2, 3) sts, p to end of row – 62 (62, 66, 70) sts.

Work even in St st for 2 rows.

Decrease Row (RS): K2, k3tog, k to last 5 sts, sk2p, k2 – 58 (58, 62, 66) sts.

Work even in St st for 3 rows.

Rep Decrease Row – 54 (54, 58, 62) sts.

Rep last 4 rows 8 (8, 9, 10) more times – 22 sts rem.

Work even in St st for 2 (2, 2, 4) rows.

Bind off.

Lower Ribbing

From WS (to create a ridge on the RS) with smaller needles and A, pick up and k 63 (67, 71, 77) sts evenly spaced across lower edge.

Row 1 (RS): *(P1, k1) 6 (7, 7, 8) times, (p1, k1) in next st; rep from * 3 more times, p1, **k1, p1; rep from ** to end of row – 67 (71, 75, 81) sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib worked in rows for 3 in. (7.5 cm).

Bind off loosely in rib.

LEFT SLEEVE

Note: Rib at lower edge is worked after Sleeve has been completed.

Beg at lower edge, with larger needles and A, cast on 37 (39, 41, 43) sts.

Beg with a RS row, work in St st for 8 rows.

Increase Row (RS): K1, M1, k to last st, M1, k1 – 39 (41, 43, 45) sts.

Work even in St st for 7 rows.

Rep Increase Row – 41 (43, 45, 47) sts.

Rep last 8 rows 5 (6, 3, 0) more times – 51 (55, 51, 47) sts.

Work even in St st for 5 rows.

Rep Increase Row – 53 (57, 53, 49) sts.

Rep last 6 rows 0 (0, 4, 9) more times – 53 (57, 61, 67) sts.

Work even in St st until piece measures 15 in. (38 cm) from beg, end with WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Raglan Cap Row 1 (RS): Bind off 3 (5, 5, 5) sts, k to end of row – 50 (52, 56, 62) sts.

Row 2: Bind off 3 (5, 5, 5) sts, p to end of row – 47 (47, 51, 57) sts.

Row 3: Bind off 2 (2, 2, 3) sts, k to end of row – 45 (45, 49, 54) sts.

Row 4: Bind off 2 (2, 2, 3) sts, p to end of row – 43 (43, 47, 51) sts.

Work even in St st for 2 rows.

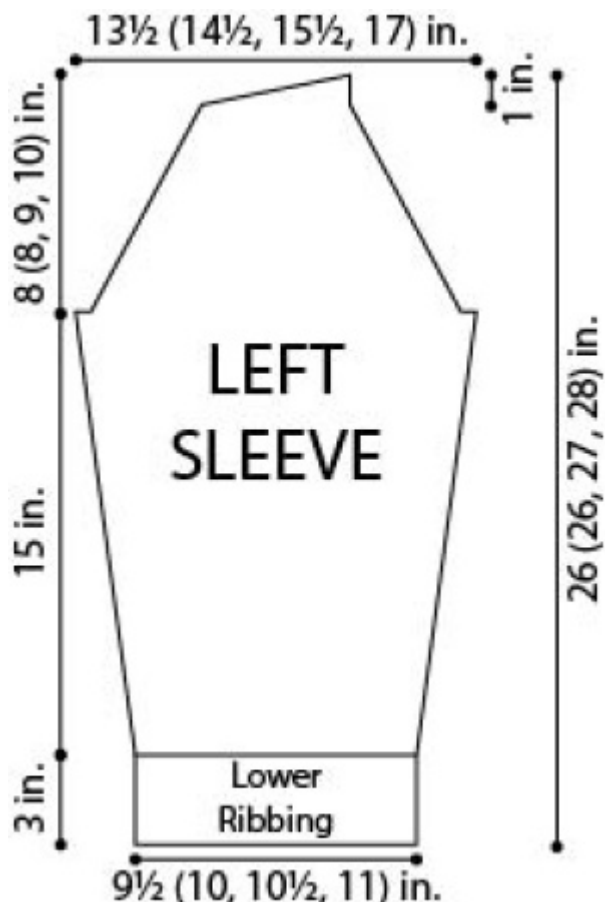
Decrease Row (RS): K2, k3tog, k to last 5 sts, sk2p, k2 – 39 (39, 43, 47) sts.

Work even in St st for 5 rows.

Rep Decrease Row – 35 (35, 39, 43) sts.

Rep last 6 rows 4 (4, 5, 6) more times – 19 sts.

Work even in St st for 0 (2, 0, 0) rows.



Next Row (WS): Bind off 5 sts, p to end of row – 14 sts.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows 2 more times – 4 sts.

Bind off rem 4 sts.

Lower Ribbing

From WS (to create a ridge on the RS) with smaller needles and A, pick up and k36 (38, 40, 42) sts evenly spaced across lower edge.

Row 1 (RS): *(P1, k1) 4 (4, 5, 5) times, (p1, k1) in next st; rep from * 2 more times, p1, **k1, p1; rep from ** to end of row – 39 (41, 43, 45) sts.

Work in K1, p1 Rib worked in rows for 3 in. (7.5 cm).

Bind off loosely in rib.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Work same as Left Sleeve until last Decrease Row is worked and 19 sts rem.

Work even in St st for 1 (3, 1, 1) rows.

Next Row (RS): Bind off 5 sts, k to end of row – 14 sts.

Next Row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows 2 more times – 4 sts.

Bind off rem 4 sts.

Lower Ribbing

Work same as lower ribbing of Left Sleeve.

FINISHING

From WS, sl st the raglan cap of Sleeves into the raglan armholes. From WS, sl st the side and Sleeve seams.

Neckband

From RS with circular needle and A, pick up and k 20 sts evenly spaced across back neck edge, 19 sts evenly spaced across top of Left Sleeve, 18 sts evenly spaced across front neck edge, 19 sts evenly spaced across top of Right Sleeve – 76 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

Work in K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds for 7 rnds.

Bind off loosely in rib.

Weave in ends.
