 135-149 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Hometown USA Yarn:</u> <u>Dallas Grey</u> <u>3</u> Balls

- Lion Brand Knitting <u>Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]</u>
- Lion Brand Cable Needles (Set of 2)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*<u>Hometown USA</u>® (Article #135). **Solids and Multis:** 100% Acrylic **Tweeds:** 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m) **Multis and Tweeds:** 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)



GAUGE:

12 sts + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Cable pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross) Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

SCARF
Cast on 24 sts.
Row 1 (RS): SI 1 * k4, p2; rep from * to last 5 sts k4, p1.
Row 2: SI 1 * p4, k2; rep from * to last 5 sts, p5.
Row 3: SI 1 *2/2 LC, p2; rep from * to last 5 sts 2/2 LC, p1.
Row 4: Rep Row 2.
Rep Rows 1-4 until piece measures about 65 in. (165 cm) from beginning.
Bind off.

FINISHING
