

MATERIALS

- 601-680 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Bonbons Yarn:</u> <u>Crayons</u> 2 Balls
- <u>The Pom (Single):</u> 2 <u>Tangerine Dream</u>
- <u>The Pom (Single):</u> 2 <u>Pink Lady</u>
- <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Knitting Needles-</u>
 <u>Size 6 [4.00 mm]</u>
- Lion Brand Split <u>Ring Stitch</u> <u>Markers</u>

Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene. Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. Care: Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene. Metallic: 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. Care: Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size: Cotton: Weight Category 2: Sport Weight 8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 28yd/26m

Cotton: 100% Cotton. Care: Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle,



Acrylic: Weight Category 3: DK Weight 8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 28yd/26m

Metallic: Weight Category 2: Sport Weight 8 x .35oz/10g 8 x 38.3 yd/35m

GAUGE:

20 sts + 40 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION

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Cable Cast On
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Transfer needle with sts to left hand. With empty needle in right hand, *insert right needle

between first 2 sts on left needle; wrap yarn and pull through (as if knitting a st); transfer new st to left needle. Repeat from * for desired number of sts.

NOTES:

1. A strip of mitered squares is worked first, then sts are picked up across one long edge to work stripes.

2. The Squares are added in a modular fashion; sts are picked up across the edge of the previous Square to beg the next Square.

3. Each Square is worked back and forth in rows with decreases worked in the center of every other row to form a miter. 4. Work Squares in colors of your choice.

5. To change color, cut the old color leaving a long yarn tail then beg working with new color leaving a beg yarn tail. You may knot the old and new yarn tails together, if desired. When you have finished knitting, unknot the yarn tails and weave them in.

SCARF

Square 1

With color of your choice, cast on 23 sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: K10, k3tog, k10 - 21 sts.

Row 3 and all WS rows: Knit. Row 4: K9, k3tog, k9 - 19 sts.

Row 6: K8, k3tog, k8 - 17 sts.

Row 8: K7, k3tog, k7 - 15 sts.

Row 10:K6, k3tog, k6 - 13 sts.

Row 12: K5, k3tog, k5 - 11 sts.

Row 14: K4, k3tog, k4 - 9 sts.

Row 16: K3, k3tog, k3 - 7 sts.

Row 18: K2, k3tog, k2 - 5 sts.

Row 20: K1, k3tog, k1 - 3 sts.

Row 21 (RS): K3tog - 1 st.

Fasten off.

Note: With RS of Square facing, Row 1 forms the left side and lower edge of the Square.

Squares 2-28

From RS of previous Square, with color of your choice, pick up and k12 sts evenly spaced across top edge of previous Square, using Cable Cast On technique, cast on 11 sts as follows: transfer needle with sts to left hand. With empty needle in right hand, *insert right needle between first 2 sts on left needle; wrap yarn and pull through (as if knitting a st); transfer new st to left needle. Repeat from * to cast on 11 sts - 23 sts.

Rows 1-21: Work same as Rows 1-21 of Square 1. Fasten off.

Side Stripes

Note: Work one stripe in each of the 8 colors, in any order desired. From RS, pick up and k336 sts evenly spaced across one long edge of Scarf. Knit 3 rows.

*Change to next color and knit 4 rows; rep from * 6 more times for a total of 8 stripes. Bind off.

FINISHING

Tie a Pom to each corner of Scarf. Weave in ends.
