SKILL LEVEL: Easy + (Level 3)

SIZE: One Size

About 18 x 64 in. (45.5 x 162.5 cm), at longest and widest points

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jun 28, 2014)

Pattern has been edited and updated.

Rows 64, 66, 68 and 70: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 3 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 3 times, ~~pm, yo, k1, yo, pm,~~ **sm, yo, k to next marker, yo, sm,** (ssk, k8, yo) 3 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 3 times, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 145 sts at the end of Row 70.

Row 71 (WS): Knit.

Rows 72, 74, 76, 78 and 80: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 3 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 3 times, ~~pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, sm,~~ **yo, k to next marker, yo, sm,** (ssk, k8, yo) 3 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 3 times, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 165 sts at the end of Row 80.

Row 81: Knit, removing markers.

Row 82: K1, yo, k1, pm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 4 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 4 times, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, (ssk, k8, yo) 4 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 4 times, pm, k1, yo, k1 – 169 sts.

Rows 84, 86 and 88: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 4 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 4 times, ~~pm, yo, k1, yo, pm,~~ **sm, yo, k to next marker, yo, sm,** (ssk, k8, yo) 4 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 4 times, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 181 sts at the end of Row 88.

MATERIALS

- 755-206 Lion Brand Unique Yarn: Potpourri
3 Balls
- Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 29 inches
Size 9
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Unique (Article #755). 100% Acrylic;
package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr.
(109yds/100m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

11 sts + 16 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS rows, p on WS rows).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog - 1 st decreased.

Yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES:

1. Shawl is worked from center top to lower edge and shaped by increasing sts on every RS row.
2. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts.
3. When you see '- 12 sts' in the instructions, this lets you know how many sts you will have at the end of that specific row.
4. Take note that while the majority of the WS rows are worked same as Row 3, there are a few WS rows that are exceptions. Read through the pattern carefully before beginning.

SHAWL

Cast on 5 sts.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2: K1, *yo, k1; rep from * across – 9 sts.

Row 3 and all WS Rows Unless Otherwise Noted: K1, p to last st, k1, slipping markers (sm) as you come to them.

Row 4: K1, yo, k2, place marker (pm), yo, k3, yo, pm, k2, yo, k1 – 13 sts.

Rows 6, 8, 10: K1, yo, k to marker, sm, yo, k to next marker, yo, sm, k to last st, yo, k1 – 25 sts at the end of Row 10.

Row 11 (WS): Knit.

Rows 12, 14, 16, 18 and 20: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, yo, knit to next marker, yo, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 45 sts at the end of Row 20.

Row 21 (WS): Knit, removing markers.

Row 22: K1, yo, k1, pm, yo, k2tog, k8, yo, k8, k2tog, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, ssk, k8, yo, k8, ssk, yo, pm, k1, yo, k1 – 49 sts.

Rows 24, 26, 28 and 30: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, yo, k2tog, k8, yo, k8, k2tog, sm, yo, knit to next marker, yo, sm, ssk, k8, yo, k8, ssk, yo, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 65 sts at the end of Row 30.

Row 31 (WS): Knit.

Rows 32, 34, 36, 38 and 40: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, yo, k2tog, k8, yo, k8, k2tog, sm, yo, knit to next marker, yo, sm, ssk, k8, yo, k8, ssk, yo, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 85 sts at the end of Row 40.

Row 41 (WS): Knit, removing markers.

Row 42: K1, yo, k1, pm, yo, (k2tog, k8, yo) twice, k8, k2tog, yo, k8, k2tog, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, ssk, k8, yo, ssk, k8, (yo, k8, ssk) twice, yo, pm, k1, yo, k1 – 89 sts.

Rows 44, 46, 48 and 50: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) twice, (yo, k8, k2tog) twice, sm, yo, knit to next marker, yo, sm, (ssk, k8, yo) twice, (k8, ssk, yo) twice, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 105 sts at the end of Row 50.

Row 51 (WS): Knit.

Rows 52, 54, 56, 58 and 60: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) twice, (yo, k8, k2tog) twice, sm, yo, knit to next marker, yo, sm, (ssk, k8, yo) twice, (k8, ssk, yo) twice, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 125 sts at the end of Row 60.

Row 61 (WS): Knit, removing markers.

Row 62: K1, yo, k1, pm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 3 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 3 times, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, (ssk, k8, yo) 3 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 3 times, pm, k1, yo, k1 – 129 sts.

Rows 64, 66, 68 and 70: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 3 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 3

times, sm, yo, k to next marker, yo, sm, (ssk, k8, yo) 3 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 3 times, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 145 sts at the end of Row 70.

Row 71 (WS): Knit.

Rows 72, 74, 76, 78 and 80: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 3 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 3 times, yo, k to next marker, yo, sm, (ssk, k8, yo) 3 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 3 times, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 165 sts at the end of Row 80.

Row 81: Knit, removing markers.

Row 82: K1, yo, k1, pm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 4 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 4 times, pm, yo, k1, yo, pm, (ssk, k8, yo) 4 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 4 times, pm, k1, yo, k1 – 169 sts.

Rows 84, 86 and 88: K1, yo, knit to marker, sm, (yo, k2tog, k8) 4 times, (yo, k8, k2tog) 4 times, sm, yo, k to next marker, yo, sm, (ssk, k8, yo) 4 times, (k8, ssk, yo) 4 times, sm, knit to last st, yo, k1 – 181 sts at the end of Row 88.

Picot Bind-Off: *Cast on 2 sts, bind off 5 sts; rep from * across to last st, cast on 2 sts, bind off rem sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
