SKILL LEVEL: Intermediate (Level 3)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 19 in. (48 cm) slightly stretched, will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

- 863-146 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Vanna's Sequins Yarn:</u> <u>Merlot</u>
 - 2 Balls
- <u>Lion Brand Double-</u>
 <u>Pointed Needles -</u>
 <u>Size 6</u>
- Boye Aluminum
 Circular Knitting
 Needles 16 inches
 Size 6
- <u>Lion Brand Split Ring</u>
 Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*Vanna's Sequins (Article #863). 93% Acrylic, 7% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (157yds/144m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

20 sts + 24 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (K on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog - 1 st decreased

Yo (yarn over) An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

sk2p (slip-k2tog-pass slipped st over)

A double decrease worked as follows:

- 1. Insert right needle as if to knit, and slip the next st from the left needle to the right needle.
- 2. Knit the next 2 sts together.

3. With tip of left needle, lift the slipped st (the 2nd st on right needle) up and over the k2tog (first st on right needle) and off the needle - you have decreased 2 sts.

NOTES:

- 1. Beret is worked in rounds from the top down.
- 2. Beret is worked in the rnd with double pointed needles, changing to a circular needle when sts have been sufficiently increased.

BERET

With double pointed needles and leaving a long yarn tail, cast on 12 sts and divide onto 4 needles placing 3 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rnd 2: *Yo, k1; rep from * 12 times around - 24 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3 and all odd numbered rnds: Knit.

Rnd 4: *K2, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, k1; rep from * around - 36 sts.

Rnd 6: *K3, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, k2; rep from * around - 48 sts.

Rnd 8: *K4, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, k3; rep from * around - 60 sts.

Rnd 10: *K5, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, k4; rep from * around - 72 sts.

Rnd 12: *K6, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, k5; rep from * around - 84 sts.

Rnd 14: *K7, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, k6; rep from * around - 96 sts.

Rnd 16: *K1, yo, ssk, k11, k2tog, yo; rep from * around - 96 sts.

Rnd 18: *(K1, yo) twice, ssk, k9, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from * around - 108 sts.

Change to circular needle.

Rnd 20: *K1, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k7, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1, yo; rep from * around - 120 sts.

Rnd 22: *K1, yo, (k2tog, yo) twice, k1 yo, ssk, k5, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k1, yo; rep from * around - 132 sts

Rnd 24: *K1, yo, (k2tog, yo) 3 times, k1, yo, ssk, k3, (k2tog, yo) 4 times, k1 yo; rep from * around -144 sts.

Rnd 26: *K1, yo, (k2tog, yo) 4 times, k1, yo, ssk, k1, (k2tog, yo) 5 times, k1, yo; rep from * around - 156 sts.

Rnd 28: *K1, yo, (k2tog, yo) 5 times, k1, yo, s2kp, yo, (k2tog, yo) 5 times, k1, yo; rep from * around - 168 sts.

Rnd 29: *P2tog, p2; rep from * around - 126 sts.

Rnds 30 and 31: Purl.

Shape Beret

Rnds 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9: *K2, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rnd 2 and all even numbered rnds: Knit.

Rnds 11, 13, 15, 17 and 19: *K2, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1, yo; rep from * around.

Rnds 21-30: Rep Rows 1-10.

Dec Rnd: *K2, k2tog, k1, k2tog; rep from * around - 90 sts.

Next Dec Rnd: *K7, k2tog; rep from * around - 80 sts.

Ribbing

Rnds 1-9: *K1tbl, p1; rep from * around.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave beginning yarn tail through sts at top of Beret, pull to gather and knot securely. Weave in ends.
