**Cotton:** 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

**Acrylic:** 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

**Metallic:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size:

**Cotton:** Weight Category 2: Sport Weight

#### MATERIALS

- 601-670 [Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn: Jingle Bells](#)  
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size G-6 \(4 mm\)](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



#### GAUGE:

19 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

**beg-CI (beginning cluster)** Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (3 loops rem on hook) yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

**CI (3 double crochet cluster)** Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up

a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 2 times (4 loops rem on hook) yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

**picot** Ch 3, sl st in top of last sc made.

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

**triple-picot** Ch 3, (sl st, ch 4, sl st, ch 3, sl st) in 3rd ch from hook.

## NOTES:

1. Each Motif is worked separately using specified colors or colors of your choice.
2. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

## COLORS

Scarlet with Red Sparkle (A)

White with Red Sparkle (B)

White with Silver Sparkle (C)

White with Green Sparkle (D)

Green with Emerald Sparkle (E)

White (F)

Medium Red (G)

Cool Green (H)

## HOLIDAY TREE

Beg at top of Tree, with E, H or color of your choice, ch 2.

**Row 1 (RS):** Work 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook - 2 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in last st - 3 sc.

**Rows 3-5:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to end of row - 6 sc.

**Rows 6 and 7:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st - 10 sc at the end of Row 7.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 3 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem 3 sts unworked - 5 sc.

**Row 9:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts - 6 sc.

**Row 10-13:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st - 14 sc at the end of Row 13.

**Row 14:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; leave rem 4 sts unworked - 7 sc.

**Row 15:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in next 6 sts - 8 sc.

**Rows 16-18:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in first st, sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st - 14 sc.

Fasten off.

**Trunk Row 19:** From RS, with a complimentary color of your choice, join yarn with sc in 6th st of Row 18, sc in next 3 sts; leave rem 5 sts unworked - 4 sc.

**Rows 20-22:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With a contrast color of your choice, embroider French Knots over the Tree for ornaments.

Weave in ends.

## CANDY CANE

With F or color of your choice, ch 20.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 13 ch, 2 sc each of next 3 ch, sc in next 2 ch - 22 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 5 sts, sc in last 14 sts - 27 sc.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first 16 sts, 2 sc in each of next 5 sts, sc in last 6 sts - 32 sc.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With A, G or color of your choice, join yarn with sl st in lower corner of Candy Cane, \*insert hook from RS to WS through Candy Cane a short distance from previous st, yarn over and draw loop through Candy Cane and loop on hook; rep from \* to add stripes to Candy Cane. To end, remove hook from loop and take hook to WS. Insert hook from WS to RS, return loop to hook and draw loop to WS. Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Draw tail through final loop and pull tight. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## **SNOWMAN**

### **Body**

With F or color of your choice, ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 6 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc - 6 sc.

**Note:** Work first st of each rnd in the same st as joining.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc - 12 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, \*2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** Ch 1, \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** Ch 1, \*2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 30 sc.

Fasten off.

### **Head**

With F or color of your choice, ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnds 1-3:** Work same as Rnds 1-3 of Body - 18 sc.

Fasten off.

### **Hat**

With D or color of your choice, ch 8.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 7 sc.

Change to E, H or color of your choice.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Rows 3-6:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each st across - 3 sc at the end of Row 6.

Cut yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through rem sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

### **Scarf**

With G or color of your choice, ch 25.

**Row 1:** Sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Sew Head to Body. Sew Hat to Head. Tie Scarf around neck. Weave in ends.

## **HOLIDAY PACKAGE**

### **Package**

With B or color of your choice, ch 12.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across - 11 sc.

**Rows 2-6:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change to G or color of your choice.

**Rows 7 and 8 (Band around Package):** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Change back to B or color of your choice (use same color as used for Rows 1-6).

**Rows 9-14:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

### **Bow**

With G or same color you used on Rows 7 and 8 of Package, make a chain about 8 in. (20.5 cm) long.

Fasten off. Weave in ends. Tie chain into a Bow.

## **FINISHING**

With G or color of your choice (use same color as used for Rows 7 and 8 of Package), join yarn with sl st in center top of Package, \*insert hook from RS to WS through Package a short distance from previous st, yarn over and draw loop through Package and loop on hook; rep from \* to add a Band around the Package at right angles to the Band worked in Rows 7 and 8 of Package. To end, remove hook from loop and take hook to WS. Insert hook from WS to RS, return loop to hook and draw loop to WS. Cut yarn. Draw tail through final loop and pull tight.

Fasten off.

Sew Bow to center of Package. Weave in ends.

## WREATH

With E, H or color of your choice, ch 12; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 18 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc - 18 sc.

**Note:** Work first st of each rnd in same st as joining.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc - 36 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*ch 2, sk next st, sc in next st; rep from \* to last st, ch 2, sk last st; join with sl st in first sc - 18 sc and 18 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 4:** (Sl st, 3 dc) in each ch-2 sp around; join with sl st in first sl st.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

With A, G or color of your choice, make a chain about 12 in. (30.5 cm) long. Weave the chain in and out through the ch-2 sps of Rnd 3 and tie ends in a bow. Weave in ends.

## HOLIDAY ORNAMENT

With A, G or color of your choice, ch 3; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 6 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc - 6 sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc - 12 sc.

Change to F or color of your choice.

**Rnd 3:** Beg-Cl in same st as joining, Cl in each st around; join with sl st in top of beg-Cl - 12 clusters.

Fasten off.

**Rnd 4:** With E, H or color of your choice, join yarn with sc in top of any Cl, 2 sc in same Cl, 3 sc in top of each Cl around; join with sl st in first sc - 36 sc.

### Top of Ornament

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in first 4 sts; leave rem sts unworked - 4 sc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 sts.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) twice - 2 sts.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

## HOLLY

### Leaves (make 2)

With E, H or color of your choice, ch 10.

**Rnd 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, (sc, ch 2, sc) in last ch; working across opposite side of foundation ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, hdc in next ch, dc in next ch, hdc in next ch, sc in last ch, ch 2; join with sl st in first sc - 18 sts and 2 ch-2 sps.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, sc in next st, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc, sc in next 3 sts, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc, sc in next 2 sts, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-2 sp, sc in next 2 sts, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc, sc in next 3 sts, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next dc, sc in next 2 sts, (sc, ch 3, sc) in last ch-2 sp; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

### Berry (make 3)

With A, G or color of your choice, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Sew the 2 Leaves together. Sew Berries to Leaves. Weave in ends.

## SNOWFLAKE

With F or color of your choice, ch 3.

**Rnd 1:** Sc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch counts as sc, ch 1), (ch 1, sc in same ch) 8 times, ch 1; join with sl st in beg ch - 10 sc and 10 ch-1 sps.

**Rnd 2:** (Sl st, sc) in beg ch-sp, \*ch 3, sc in next ch-sp; rep from \* 8 more times, ch 3; join with sl st in first sc - 10 sc and 10 ch-3 sps.

**Rnd 3:** (Sl st, sc, picot) in first ch-sp, (3 dc, triple picot, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, \*sc in next ch-3 sp, picot, (3 dc, triple-picot, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc.  
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
