MATERIALS

- 860-110 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Navy
3 Balls (A)

- 860-105 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Silver Blue
3 Balls (B)

- 860-134 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Terracotta
2 Balls (C)

- 860-133 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Brick
2 Balls (D)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook
- Size J-10 (6 mm)

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon
402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



GAUGE:

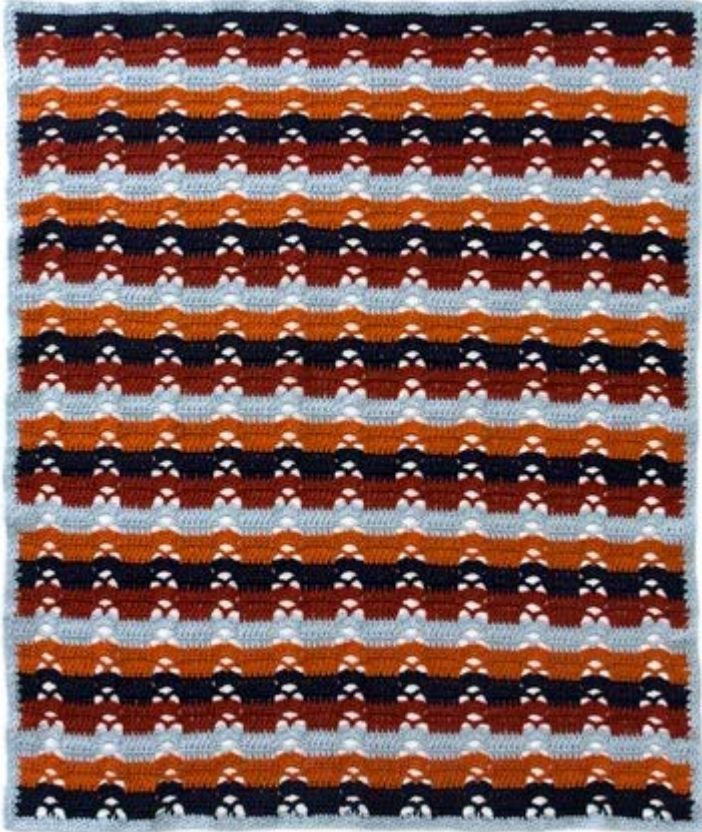
1 pattern rep = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm); 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Throw is worked back and forth in rows.
2. Color is changed every 3 rows following the Color Sequence. To change color, fasten off old color, turn piece and join new color in first st as instructed.
3. A border is worked around the outside edge of completed Throw.



COLOR SEQUENCE

*Work 3 rows with A, 3 rows with C, 3 rows with B, 3 rows with D; rep from * 6 more times for a total of 84 rows.

THROW

With A, ch 147.

Row 1 (RS): Working in back bars only of chs, dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as first dc), dc in next 2 ch, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch, *ch 3, sk next 3 ch, dc in next 6 ch, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * to last 7 ch, ch 3, sk next 3 ch, dc in last 4 ch - 11 pattern reps (consisting of 68 dc, 11 sc, and 22 ch-3 sps) .

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in next 3 sts, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-3 sp, *dc in next 6 sts, sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from * 9 more times, dc in next 3 dc, dc in top of beg ch - 68 dc, 22 sc, and 11 ch-5 sps.

Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in next 3 sts, sk next sc, 7 dc in next ch-5 sp, *sk next sc, dc in next 6 sts, sk next sc, 7 dc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * 9 more times, sk next sc, dc in next 3 dc, dc in top of beg ch - 145 dc (Eleven 7-dc shells, ten 6-dc groups, and two 4-dc groups). Fasten off.

Row 4: From WS, draw up a loop of C in first dc, ch 3, dc in next 3 sts, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st (center dc of next shell), *ch 3, sk next 3 sts, dc in next 6 sts, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st (center dc of next shell); rep from * 9 more times, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, dc in next 3 dc, dc in top of beg ch - 68 dc, 11 sc, and 22 ch-3 sps.

Rows 5 and 6: With C, rep Rows 2 and 3. Fasten off.

Row 7: From RS, draw up a loop of B in first dc, ch 3, dc in next 3 sts, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st (center dc of next shell), *ch 3, sk next 3 sts, dc in next 6 sts, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in next st (center dc of next shell); rep from * 9 more times, ch 3, sk next 3 sts, dc in next 3 dc, dc in top of beg ch - 68 dc, 11

sc, and 22 ch-3 sps.

Rows 8 and 9: With B, rep Rows 2 and 3. Fasten off.

Rows 10-12: With D, rep Rows 4-6. Fasten off.

Rows 13-84: Rep Rows 7-12, and continue to change color as in Color Sequence, until all 84 rows of Color Sequence have been worked.

Rows 85 and 86: With A, rep Rows 7 and 8.

Row 87: With A, ch 3, turn, dc in next 3 sts, tr in next sc, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp, *tr in next sc, dc in next 6 sts, tr in next sc, 5 dc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * 9 more times, tr in next sc, dc in next 3 dc, dc in top of beg ch- 145 sts (Eleven 5-dc shells, 22 tr, ten 6-dc groups, and two 4-dc groups). Fasten off.

FINISHING

Border

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sc in last dc of Row 87, ch 2, sc in same dc (first corner made); working in ends of rows down long side edge, sc in end of first row, 2 sc in end of each remaining row across; working across opposite side of foundation ch and working in 2 free loops of each ch, (sc, ch 2, sc) in first ch (at base of dc), sc in next 3 ch, (2 sc, hdc) in next ch-sp, sc in next ch (at base of sc), (hdc, 2 sc) in next ch-sp, *sc in next 6 ch (each at base of a dc), (2 sc, hdc) in next ch-sp, sc in next ch, (hdc, 2 sc) in next ch-sp; rep from * 9 more times, sc in next 3 ch (each at base of a dc), (sc, ch 2, sc) in next ch (at base of beg ch); working in ends of rows across next long side edge, 2 sc in end of each row to last row, sc in end of last row; working in sts of Row 87, (sc, ch 2, sc) in first dc, sc in each st across; join with sl st in first sc. **Note:** You should have an odd number of sts across each side between ch-2 corner sps.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in next st, *(ch 1, sk next st, sc in next st) to 1 st before next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, sk next st, (sc, ch 2, sc) in corner ch-2 sp; rep from * 3 more times, ch 1, sk next st; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in each ch-1 sp and sc around, working (sc, ch 2, sc) in each corner ch-2 sp; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
