Pattern Number: L32362

SKILL LEVEL: Beginner (Level 1)

SIZE: One Size

About 3 1/2 x 9 1/2 in. (9 x 24 cm), to fit a standard coffee or tea mug

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jan 27, 2014)

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm), ~~when slightly stretched.~~ **3 1/2 in. (9 cm).**

MATERIALS

- 136-105 Lion Brand Heartland Yarn: Glacier Bay
1 Ball

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

- Additional Materials
One small button
Sewing needle and thread

**Heartland (Article #136). 100% Acrylic;
package size: 5.00oz/142.00 gr.
(251yds/230m) pull skeins*



MATERIALS NOTE

Yarn amount is sufficient to make 4-5 Cozies.

GAUGE:

12 half double crochet + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

COZY

Chain 32.

Row 1: Half double crochet in 3rd chain from hook and in each chain across.

Row 2: Chain 2, turn. Half double crochet in each stitch across - 29 stitches at the end of this row. Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm).

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew short sides of Cozy together for about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm) at top and at bottom, leaving remaining 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) open for mug handle.

With sewing needle and thread, sew button, centered, onto one edge of handle opening. Use spaces between stitches as buttonhole.
