### Ribbed Mug Cozy

**SKILL LEVEL:** Beginner (Level 1)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 3 1/2 x 9 1/2 in. (9 x 24 cm), to fit a standard coffee or tea mug

#### MATERIALS

- 860-151 [Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Charcoal Grey](#)  
1 Ball

- [Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 \(6 mm\)](#)

- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

- Additional Materials  
One small button  
Sewing needle and thread

*\*Vanna's Choice® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic*

**400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon  
**402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

**Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g), 145 yards (133 meters)

**Twists:** 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



#### MATERIALS NOTE

Yarn amount is sufficient to make 4-5 Cozies.

#### GAUGE:

13 single crochet through back loop + 14 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### COZY

Chain 12.

**Row 1:** Single crochet in 2nd chain from hook and in each chain across - 11 stitches.

**Row 2:** Chain 1, turn.

Working through back loops only, single crochet in each stitch across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm), when slightly stretched.

Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Sew short sides of Cozy together for about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm) at top and at bottom, leaving remaining 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) open for mug handle.

With sewing needle and thread, sew button, centered, onto one edge of handle opening. Use spaces between stitches as buttonhole.
