SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 3 1/2 x 9 1/2 in. (9 x 24 cm), to fit a standard coffee or tea mug

 136-173 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Heartland Yarn:</u> <u>Everglades</u> 1 Ball

<u>Lion Brand Knitting</u>
 <u>Needles- Size 8 [5 mm]</u>

 Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

Additional Materials
 One small button
 Sewing needle and
 thread

*<u>Heartland</u> (Article #136). 100% Acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/142.00 gr. (251yds/230m) pull skeins



MATERIALS NOTE

Yarn amount is sufficient to make 4-5 Cozies.

GAUGE:

19 sts + 26 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Beaded Rib.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Yo (yarn over)

A way to create a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCH

Beaded Rib

Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from * across row.

Row 2: Purl.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Beaded Rib.

COZY

Cast on 47 sts.

Beg with Row 1, work in Beaded Rib until piece measures about 1 3/4 in. (4.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Next (Buttonhole) Row: K2tog, yo, work in pattern as established to end of row.

Continue to work in pattern as established until piece measures about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm) from beg. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew sides of Cozy together for about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm) at top and at bottom, leaving remaining 2 1/2 in. (6.5 cm) open for mug handle.

With sewing needle and thread, sew button onto edge of handle opening, opposite buttonhole.
