 134-247 <u>Lion Brand Country:</u> <u>Mystic Purple</u> 1 Ball

• Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch

\*<u>Country</u> (Article #134). 100% acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/141.75 gr. (156yds/143m) pull skeins

- <u>Markers</u>
  <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials Circular knitting needle size 11 (8 mm), 24 in. (61 cm) long



## GAUGE:

14 sts + 16 rnds = 4 in. (10 cm) in K2, p2 Rib worked in rnds.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH K2, p2 Rib worked in rnds (multiple of 4 sts) Rnd 1: \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end of rnd. Rep Rnd 1 for K2, p2 Rib worked in rnds.

## COWL

Cast on 100 sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd and join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Work in K2, p2 Rib worked in rnds until piece measures about 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) from beg. Bind off.

# FINISHING

Weave in ends.
