### Scalloped Lace Cowl

Pattern Number: L32442

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference at Lower Edge** About 36 in. (91.5 cm)

**Finished Height** About 10 in. (25.5 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- 864-205 Lion Brand Vanna's Tapestry: Iceland 2 Balls *\*Vanna's Tapestry (Article #864). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (145yds/133m) pull skeins*
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### **GAUGE:**

2 shell patterns = about 6 in. (15 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### **COWL**

Ch 98.

**Rnd 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, (ch 3, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch, ch 3, sk 1 ch, sc in next ch, ch 3, sk 2 ch, in next ch) 12 times; join with sl st (being careful not to twist sts) to first sc to work in rnds.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 4 (counts as sc, ch 3), sc in first ch-sp, \*8 dc in next ch-sp (8-dc shell made), sc in next ch-sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-sp; rep from \* 10 more times, 8 dc in next ch-sp; join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 12 shells.

**Rnd 3:** Sc in same st as joining, \*(ch 3, sk 2 dc of shell, sc in next dc) twice, ch 3, sc in next ch-sp; rep from \* 10 more times, (ch 3, sk 2 dc of shell, sc in next dc) twice, ch 3; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnds 4-11:** Rep Rnds 2 and 3.

**Rnd 12:** Rep Rnd 2.

**Rnd 13 (Increase):** Sc in same st as joining, \*(ch 4, sk 2 dc of shell, sc in next dc) twice, ch 4, sc in next ch-sp; rep from \* 10 more times, (ch 4, sk 2 dc of shell, sc in next dc) twice, ch 4; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 14:** Ch 5 (counts as sc, ch 4), sc in first ch-4 sp, \*10 dc in next ch-sp (10-dc shell made), sc in next ch-sp, ch 4, sc in next ch-sp; rep from \* 10 more times, 10 dc in next ch-sp; join with sl st to 4th ch of beg ch-5.

**Rnd 15:** Sc in same st as joining, \*(ch 4, sk 3 dc of shell, 1 sc in next dc) twice, ch 4, sc in next ch-sp; rep from \* 10 more times, (ch 4, sk 3 dc of shell, 1 sc in next dc) twice, ch 4; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnds 16-19:** Rep Rnds 14 and 15.

Fasten off.

### Neck trim

**Rnd 1:** From RS, join yarn with sl st in beg ch and work 2 sc in each ch-sp around; join with sl st in first sc, turn.

**Rnd 2 (WS):** Work 1 hdc in each st around; join with sl st in first hdc.

Fasten off.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
