# Free Knit & Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Country® Cozy Spiral Hat

Finished Circumference About 20 in. (51 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

Finished Height About 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm).

134-230 <u>Lion Brand</u>
 <u>Country: Adirondack Green</u>
 1 Ball

\*Country (Article #134). 100% acrylic; package size: 5.00oz/141.75 gr. (156yds/143m) pull skeins

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook</u> -Size N-13 (9 mm)
- Brittany Birchwood Double Pointed Needles - Size 13
- <u>Lion Brand Split Ring</u>
   <u>Stitch Markers</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u>
   Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### **GAUGE:**

12 sc worked through back loops = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### **PATTERN STITCH**

K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds (multiple of 2 sts)

Rnd 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end of rnd. Rep Rnd 1 for K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds.

#### NOTES:

- 1. Hat is worked in knit and crochet in the rnd, beg at top.
- 2. Sts are picked up along edge of Hat to work the ribbed band.

#### HAT

With A, ch 6, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 8 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in first st for beg of rnd.

Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

- Rnd 2: Working through back loops only, 2 sc in each st around 16 sc at the end of this rnd.
- Rnd 3: Working through back loops only, \*sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around 24 sc.
- Rnd 4: Working through back loops only, \*sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around 32 sc.
- Rnd 5: Working through back loops only, \*sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around 40 sc.
- Rnd 6: Working through back loops only, \*sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around 48 sc.
- Rnd 7: Working through back loops only, \*sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around 56 sc.
- Rnd 8: Working through back loops only, \*sc in next 13 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around 60 sts.

Rnds 9-14: Working through back loops only, sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

### **Ribbed Band**

From RS with double pointed knitting needles, pick up and k 60 sts evenly spaced around lower edge of Hat, with 15 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

Work in K1, p1 rib worked in rnds for 18 rnds.

Bind off in rib.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
