SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 60 in. (152.5 cm), Poncho will stretch to fit a range of sizes Each Panel = about 16 x 29 in. (40.5 x 73.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 640-608 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Wool-Ease Thick & Ouick</u> <u>Yarn: Checkerboard</u> 5 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting <u>Needles- Size 13 [9 mm]</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u> Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*<u>Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick®</u> (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds:6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m) Prints (Sequoia, Mesquite, Granite): 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)



GAUGE:

10 stitches + 13 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.


When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Poncho is made from 2 Panels that are sewn together following a diagram.

Steps for putting Poncho together



PANELS (make 2)
Cast on 63 stitches.
Rows 1-4: Knit.
Rows 5, 7, 9 and 11: Knit 3, *purl 2, knit 3; repeat from * across row.
Rows 6, 8 and 10: Knit 3, *knit 2, purl 3; repeat from * across to last 5 stitches, knit 5.
Rows 12: Knit.
Rows 13-48: Repeat Rows 1-12.
Rows 49-51: Knit.
Bind off.

FINISHING

Following Diagram, sew Panels together to make Poncho. Weave in ends.
