SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 8 1/2 x 60 in. (21.5 x 152.5 cm), not including fringe

- 861-149 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Vanna's Glamour Yarn:</u> <u>Moonstone</u> 2 Balls (A)
- 861-150 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Vanna's Glamour Yarn:</u> <u>Platinum</u> 2 Balls (B)
- *<u>Vanna's Glamour®</u> (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins



- Lion Brand Crochet <u>Hook - Size F-5 (3.75</u> <u>mm)</u>
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

16 sts + 14 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked lengthwise, changing color on every other row.

To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.
Fringe is added to both short ends of Scarf.

SCARF

With A, ch 244.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beg ch counts as first dc) and in each ch across – 242 dc. **Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *sl st in next 10 sts, ch 10, sk next 10 sts; rep from * to beg ch, sc in top of beg ch – at the end of this row you will have 12 ch-10 sps.

Change to B.

Row 3: With B, ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, *10 dc in next ch-10 sp, dc in next 10 sts; rep from * to last st, dc in last st – 242 dc.

Row 4: With B, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 10, sk next 10 sts, sl st in next 10 sts; rep from * to turning ch, sc in top of turning ch – at the end of this row you will have 12 ch-10 sps. Change to A.

Row 5: With A, ch 3, turn, *dc in next 10 sts, 10 dc in next ch-10 sp; rep from * to last st, dc in last st – 242 dc.

Row 6: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *sl st in next 10 sts, ch 10, sk next 10 sts; rep from * to turning ch, sc in top of turning ch – at the end of this row you will have 12 ch-10 sps. Change to B.

Rows 7-26: Rep Rows 3-6. **Rows 27-29:** Rep Rows 3-5. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fringe

Join A with sl st in one short edge of Scarf at end of first A-colored stripe and, ch 41, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, sl st again into edge of Scarf. Fasten off.

Continue to add one matching color Fringe to each end of each stripe. Rep on opposite short edge. Weave in ends.
