GAUGE:

19 sts + 39 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Slip St pattern.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from

person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Four Panels are worked, then sewn together to make Afghan.
- 2. Each Panel is worked in alternating blocks of Slip st and Basketweave.
- 3. The Slip st blocks are all worked the same 2 colors. When working the Slip st blocks, carry color not in use along side edge of piece.
- 4. An edging is worked along each side of the completed Afghan.



PANEL I

With A, cast on 44 sts.

Slip st Block

Rows 1 and 2: With A, knit.

Row 3 (RS): With B, k1, *sl 2 wyib, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, sl 2 wyib, k1.

Row 4: With B, k1, *sl 2 wyif, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, sl 2 wyif, k1.

Row 5: With A, k3, *sl 2 wyib, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 6: With A, k1, *p2, sl 2 wyif; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Rows 7 and 8: With A, knit.

Rows 9-86: Rep Rows 3-8 thirteen more times.

Basketweave Block

Row 1 (RS): With E, knit.

Row 2: *P4, k4; rep from * to last 4 sts, p4.

Row 3: *K4, p4; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 6: *K4, p4; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4.

Row 7: *P4, k4; rep from * to last 4 sts, p4.

Row 8: Rep Row 6.

Rows 9-56: Rep Rows 1-8. **Rows 57-60:** Rep rows 1-4.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

Basketweave Block

With D, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

PANEL II

With C, cast on 44 sts.

Basketweave Block

With C, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

Basketweave Block

With F, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

Basketweave Block

With C, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block. Bind off.

PANEL III

With A, cast on 44 sts.

Slip st Block

Work Rows 1-86 of Slip St Block.

Basketweave Block

With D, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

Basketweave Block

With E, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

Bind off.

PANEL IV

With F, cast on 44 sts.

Basketweave Block

With F, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

Basketweave Block

With C, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block.

Slip st Block

Rep Rows 1-86 of Slip st Block.

Basketweave Block

With F, rep Rows Rows 1-60 of Basketweave Block. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew Strips together in order, I, II, III, IV.

Top and Bottom Edging

From RS with A, pick up and k 168 sts evenly spaced across one short end of Afghan.

Row 1: Knit.

Row 2 (RS): With B, k1, *sl 2 wyib, k2; rep from * to last 3 sts, sl 2 wyib, k1.

Row 3: With B, k1, *sl 2 wyif, p2; rep from * to last 3 sts, sl 2 wyif, k1.

Row 4: With A, k3, *sl 2 wyib, k2; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 5 With A, k1, *p2, sl 2 wyif; rep from * to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Rows 6 and 7: With A, knit.

Bind off.

Rep edging across opposite short end of Afghan.

Side Edging

From RS with A, pick up and k 220 sts evenly spaced across one long side of Afghan, including ends of top and bottom edgings.

Rep Rows 1-8 of top and bottom edging.

Bind off.

Rep on opposite long side of Afghan.

Weave in ends.
